# Herilary T8 Two-Way Instant Voice Translator User Manual

Model: T8

## 1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Herilary T8 Two-Way Instant Voice Translator. This device is designed to facilitate communication across language barriers with its advanced voice, camera, and offline translation capabilities. Please read this manual carefully to ensure proper use and to maximize the device's potential.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

### 2.1 Key Features

- Two-Way Instant Voice Translation:** Supports real-time conversation in 106 languages.
- Camera Translation:** Translate text from images.
- Offline Translation:** Supports translation for 8 languages without an internet connection (after downloading language packs).
- High Precision:** Advanced recognition and translation technology.
- Connectivity:** Wi-Fi and 4G network compatible.

### 2.2 Device Components

Familiarize yourself with the physical components of your Herilary T8 translator.

- **Touch Screen:** Main interface for navigation and display.
- **Microphone Holes:** For voice input during translation.
- **Camera:** Used for camera translation of text.
- **Volume +/- Buttons:** Adjust the device's audio output.
- **Translation Buttons (Red/Blue):** Initiate two-way voice translation.
- **Return Button:** Navigate back in menus.
- **Strap Hole:** For attaching a wrist strap or lanyard.
- **Charging Port:** Connect the charging cable here.

## 3. SETUP

### 3.1 Charging the Device

Before first use, fully charge your Herilary T8 translator using the provided charging cable and a compatible power adapter.

### 3.2 Wi-Fi Connection

To use online translation features, connect your device to a Wi-Fi network:

1. From the home menu, tap on "Settings".
2. Select "WIFI Settings".
3. Tap the WIFI connection ON/OFF switch to turn Wi-Fi ON.
4. The device will scan for available networks. Select your desired Wi-Fi network.
5. Enter the Wi-Fi password. *Note: When entering alphabets, for example, to type 'c' on a key that also has 'a' and 'b', you may need to tap the key 3 times. For 'b', tap 2 times.*
6. Tap the "√" (OK key) in the lower right corner of the keyboard to connect.

### 3.3 Offline Language Pack Download

To use offline translation, you must first download the necessary language packs while connected to Wi-Fi:

1. Ensure the device is connected to Wi-Fi.
2. Navigate to the offline translation section of the device.
3. From the displayed list of source and target languages, select the languages you wish to use offline.
4. Tap the downward arrow icon next to the selected language pair to initiate the download of the language data.
5. A bucket mark appearing on the right side of the language display indicates that the download is complete.
6. Once both desired language data sets are downloaded, offline translation for that pair can be utilized.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 4.1 Voice Translation (Online)

For real-time voice translation, ensure your device is connected to Wi-Fi or a 4G network.

1. Select the source and target languages on the device's screen.
2. Press and hold the corresponding translation button (e.g., Red for your language, Blue for the other person's language).
3. Speak clearly into the microphone.
4. Release the button when you finish speaking. The device will translate and speak the translation aloud.
5. The other person can then press their designated button and speak.

## 4.2 Camera Translation

Use the camera translation feature to translate text from signs, menus, or documents.

1. Select the "Camera Translation" option from the main menu.
2. Point the device's camera at the text you wish to translate.
3. Ensure the text is well-lit and within the camera's frame.
4. Tap the screen to capture the image.
5. The device will process the image and display the translated text on the screen.

### 4.3 Offline Translation

After downloading language packs (refer to Section 3.3), you can use the device for translation without an internet connection.

1. Select the "Offline Translation" option from the main menu.
2. Choose the downloaded source and target languages.
3. Proceed with voice input as described in Section 4.1. The device will translate using the stored language data.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

### 5.1 Cleaning

- Wipe the device with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosols, as they may damage the device.

### 5.2 Storage

- Store the device in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

- Avoid storing in dusty environments.

## 5.3 Battery Care

- Charge the device regularly, even if not in frequent use, to maintain battery health.
- Avoid fully discharging the battery frequently.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

### 6.1 Device Not Turning On

- Ensure the device is fully charged. Connect it to a power source and wait a few minutes before attempting to turn it on again.
- Press and hold the power button for at least 10 seconds.

### 6.2 Translation Not Working

- **Online Translation:** Check your Wi-Fi or 4G connection. Ensure it is stable and strong.
- **Offline Translation:** Verify that the required language packs have been downloaded (refer to Section 3.3).
- Speak clearly and directly into the microphone. Avoid noisy environments.
- Ensure the correct source and target languages are selected.

### 6.3 Camera Translation Issues

- Ensure the text is well-lit and in focus.
- Hold the device steady to avoid blurry images.
- The text should be clearly visible and not obscured.
