INSTRUCTION MANUAL

Important Safety Instructions

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- Read all instructions before operating the appliance.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against electrical shock, do not immerse cord, plugs, or the appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner. Return appliance to the nearest authorized service facility for examination, repair, or adjustment.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.

Product Overview

The Uncanny Brands Harry Potter Hogwarts Waffle Maker is designed to create delicious waffles with a unique Hogwarts crest imprint. This appliance features non-stick cooking plates for easy release and cleaning.

Components:

- Waffle Maker Unit with Non-Stick Plates
- Measuring Spoon

Setup

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the waffle maker and all accessories from the packaging. Retain packaging for future storage or transport.
2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wipe the non-stick cooking plates with a damp cloth or sponge. Dry thoroughly. The exterior can be wiped with a soft, damp cloth. Do not immerse the unit in water.
3. **Placement:** Place the waffle maker on a stable, heat-resistant, and dry surface. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the unit.
4. **First Use (Seasoning):** For optimal non-stick performance, it is recommended to lightly brush or spray the cooking plates with a small amount of cooking oil before the very first use. Close the lid and allow the unit to preheat. A slight odor or smoke may be present during the first use; this is normal and will dissipate.

Operating Instructions

- 1. Preheating:** Close the lid of the waffle maker. Plug the power cord into a standard 120V AC electrical outlet. The red indicator light will illuminate, indicating the unit is powered on. The green indicator light will illuminate when the waffle maker has reached its optimal cooking temperature.
- 2. Prepare Batter:** While the unit is preheating, prepare your favorite waffle batter.
- 3. Add Batter:** Once the green light illuminates, carefully open the lid. Pour approximately 1/2 to 3/4 cup of waffle batter onto the center of the lower cooking plate. Use the included measuring spoon for consistent portions. Do not overfill, as batter may overflow when the lid is closed.
- 4. Close Lid:** Gently close the lid. Do not force it shut. The green light may turn off during cooking as the unit maintains temperature.
- 5. Cooking Time:** Cook for approximately 3-5 minutes, or until the waffle is golden brown and crispy to your preference. Cooking time may vary depending on the batter type and desired crispness.
- 6. Remove Waffle:** Once cooked, carefully open the lid. Use a heat-resistant, non-metallic utensil (e.g., plastic or wooden spatula) to remove the waffle. Do not use metal utensils, as they can damage the non-stick coating.
- 7. Repeat:** Close the lid to allow the unit to reheat for the next waffle. The green light will illuminate again when ready.
- 8. Finish:** When finished cooking, unplug the waffle maker from the outlet.

Tips for Best Results:

- Ensure the waffle maker is fully preheated before adding batter.
- Do not open the lid too early during cooking, as this can cause the waffle to tear.
- For crispier waffles, cook for a slightly longer duration.
- Avoid using spray oils that contain lecithin, as they can leave a sticky residue on the non-stick plates over time.

Cleaning & Maintenance

Proper cleaning and maintenance will extend the life of your waffle maker.

1. **Unplug and Cool:** Always unplug the waffle maker from the electrical outlet and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
2. **Clean Cooking Plates:** Once cooled, gently wipe the non-stick cooking plates with a damp cloth or sponge. For

stubborn batter residue, a small amount of mild dish soap can be used, but ensure to wipe thoroughly with a clean, damp cloth afterward to remove all soap residue. Do not use abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or metal brushes, as these will damage the non-stick coating.

- Clean Exterior:** Wipe the exterior of the waffle maker with a soft, damp cloth. Do not immerse the unit in water or any other liquid.
- Storage:** Store the cleaned and dried waffle maker in a cool, dry place. The cord can be wrapped around the base for compact storage.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Waffle maker does not heat up.	Not plugged in; power outlet issue; unit malfunction.	Ensure unit is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check household circuit breaker. If problem persists, contact customer support.
Waffles are not crispy.	Insufficient cooking time; batter too thin; not fully preheated.	Increase cooking time. Ensure unit is fully preheated (green light on). Adjust batter consistency if too thin.
Waffles stick to plates.	Plates not seasoned; too little oil; damaged non-stick coating.	Lightly brush plates with cooking oil before each use. Ensure plates are clean. Avoid using metal utensils.
Batter overflows.	Too much batter added.	Reduce the amount of batter. Use the included measuring spoon as a guide.
