1. INTRODUCTION AND OVERVIEW

This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your INALSA MasterVac 35 Wet and Dry Vacuum Cleaner. Designed for both home and industrial use, this versatile appliance offers powerful cleaning for various environments.

2. PRODUCT FEATURES

The INALSA MasterVac 35 is engineered with several features to enhance your cleaning experience:

- **Wet and Dry Cleaning:** Capable of handling both dry dust and wet spills, making it suitable for diverse cleaning tasks.
- **Powerful Motor:** Equipped with a 1700W motor, delivering a strong suction power of 22 kPa for effective cleaning.
- **Large Capacity:** Features a 35-liter stainless steel tank for extended cleaning sessions without frequent emptying.
- **Blower Function:** An integrated blower function helps clear dust from narrow and hard-to-reach areas.
- **Advanced Filtration:** Includes a HEPA filter for dry vacuuming, capturing 99.97% of particles down to 0.3 microns, and a sponge filter for wet vacuuming.
- **Easy Drainage:** An extra-large drain port simplifies the disposal of collected wet waste.
- **Mobility:** Features 360° swivel wheels and a top carry handle for easy maneuverability.

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Before first use, ensure all components are present and correctly assembled.

3.1 Unpacking and Component Check

Carefully remove all items from the packaging. Verify that the following components are included:

- Main Motor Unit
- Stainless Steel Tank (35L)
- Hose
- Metal Telescopic Tube
- Wet & Dry Squeezing Brush
- Small Round Brush
- Crevice Tool
- HEPA Filter (for dry vacuuming)

- Sponge Filter (for wet vacuuming)
- 360° Swivel Wheels (pre-attached or to be attached)

3.2 Assembly Steps

1. Attach the 360° swivel wheels to the base of the tank if not already assembled.
2. Secure the main motor unit onto the stainless steel tank using the easy locks.
3. Connect the hose to the suction port on the tank for vacuuming, or to the blowing port for the blower function.
4. Attach the metal telescopic tube to the hose, and then attach the desired cleaning accessory (e.g., wet & dry squeezing brush, crevice tool).
5. Ensure the correct filter is installed for your cleaning task (HEPA for dry, Sponge for wet).

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Understand how to use your vacuum cleaner for different cleaning modes.

4.1 Dry Vacuuming

1. Ensure the HEPA filter is securely installed inside the tank.
2. Connect the hose to the suction port.
3. Attach the appropriate dry cleaning accessory (e.g., floor-cum-carpet brush, small round brush, crevice tool).
4. Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.
5. Turn on the vacuum cleaner using the ON/OFF switch.
6. Move the accessory over the dry surface to be cleaned.

4.2 Wet Vacuuming

1. Remove the HEPA filter and install the sponge filter for wet vacuuming.
2. Connect the hose to the suction port.
3. Attach the wet & dry squeezing brush.
4. Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.
5. Turn on the vacuum cleaner using the ON/OFF switch.
6. Move the brush over the wet spills to suction them into the tank.

4.3 Blower Function

1. For effective blowing results, ensure no filter is installed in the vacuum cleaner.
2. Connect the hose to the blowing port.
3. Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.
4. Turn on the vacuum cleaner using the ON/OFF switch.
5. Direct the hose towards the area where you want to blow away dust or debris.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your vacuum cleaner.

5.1 Emptying the Tank

For quick and easy emptying, especially after wet vacuuming:

1. Ensure the vacuum cleaner is turned off and unplugged.
2. Locate the extra-large drain port at the bottom of the tank.
3. Open the drain plug to allow collected liquids to flow out into a suitable container or drain.
4. For dry debris, unlatch the motor unit and carefully lift it off the tank. Dispose of the dry waste.
5. Clean the inside of the tank with water and mild detergent if necessary, then dry thoroughly before reassembly.

5.2 Filter Maintenance

The MasterVac 35 uses different filters for wet and dry applications:

- **HEPA Filter (for dry vacuuming):** Regularly tap the HEPA filter to dislodge accumulated dust. For thorough cleaning, gently brush off debris. Replace the HEPA filter periodically based on usage and condition to maintain optimal filtration.
- **Sponge Filter (for wet vacuuming):** After wet use, rinse the sponge filter thoroughly with water and allow it to air dry completely before storing or reusing.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your vacuum cleaner, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vacuum cleaner does not turn on.	No power supply; ON/OFF switch is off.	Check power cord connection and wall outlet; ensure switch is in 'ON' position.
Low suction power.	Full tank; clogged hose/accessories; dirty filter.	Empty the tank; clear any blockages; clean or replace the filter.
Water leaking during wet vacuuming.	Sponge filter not installed correctly or damaged; drain plug not sealed.	Ensure sponge filter is correctly seated; check drain plug for proper closure.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unusual noise during operation.	Foreign object in hose/motor; loose parts.	Turn off and unplug; inspect hose and motor area for obstructions; tighten any loose parts.
