Charging Your Device

Before first use, fully charge your Fire HD 10 tablet. Connect the USB-C cable to the tablet's USB-C port and the 9W power adapter to a wall outlet. A full charge takes approximately 4 hours with the included adapter. For faster charging (under 3 hours), a 15W adapter and USB-C to C cable (sold separately) can be used.

Powering On and Initial Configuration

Press and hold the power button located on the side of the tablet until the Amazon logo appears. Follow the onscreen prompts to:

- Select your language.
- 2. Connect to a Wi-Fi network. The tablet supports dual-band 802.11a/b/g/n/ac standards. Wi-Fi 6 (802.11 ax) is not supported.
- 3. Register your device with an Amazon account.

4. Set up parental controls via Amazon Kids, if desired.

Display and Navigation

The 10.1" 1080p Full HD display offers a resolution of 1920 x 1200 pixels. Navigate by tapping, swiping, and pinching.

Performance

The octa-core processor (2x Arm Cortex-A76 up to 2.05 Ghz and 6x Arm Cortex A55 up to 2Ghz) and 3 GB RAM ensure smooth performance for various tasks.

Storage

Your tablet comes with either 32 GB (24 GB available) or 64 GB (54.3 GB available) of internal storage. Expand storage up to 1 TB using a micro-SD card (sold separately).

Camera Usage

The tablet features 5 MP front and rear-facing cameras capable of 1080p HD video recording. Use them for video calls or capturing photos.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Device Not Powering On

Ensure the tablet is sufficiently charged. Connect it to the power adapter and wait a few minutes before attempting to power on again.

Wi-Fi Connectivity Issues

Verify your Wi-Fi network is active and you have entered the correct password. Try restarting your router and the tablet.

Slow Performance

Close unused applications. Clear cache for frequently used apps. Consider freeing up internal storage space.

Battery Draining Quickly

Reduce screen brightness, disable Wi-Fi or Bluetooth when not in use, and close background applications.
