Strong SRT 7040 DTT Tuner User Manual

Digital Satellite HD Receiver

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Strong SRT 7040 Digital Satellite HD Receiver. Please read this manual carefully before using the device to ensure proper functionality and to prevent damage.

The Strong SRT 7040 is a Full HD digital satellite receiver designed for Free-To-Air (FTA) channels. It features a USB port for multimedia playback and software updates, and supports Dolby Audio for enhanced sound quality.

1. SETUP

1.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure the following items are present:

- Strong SRT 7040 DTT Tuner
- Remote Control (with 2 AAA batteries)
- Power Adapter
- User Manual

1.2 Connecting the Device

Follow these steps to connect your SRT 7040 receiver:

1. **Satellite Input:** Connect your satellite dish cable to the **SAT IN** port on the back of the receiver.
2. **Video Output (HDMI):** Connect an HDMI cable from the **HDMI** port on the receiver to an HDMI input on your television.
3. **Video Output (SCART):** Alternatively, for older televisions, connect a SCART cable from the **TV SCART** port on the receiver to the SCART input on your television.
4. **Audio Output (Digital):** For digital audio, connect a coaxial cable from the **COAXIAL S/PDIF** port to your digital audio amplifier.
5. **Audio Output (Analog):** For analog audio, connect RCA cables from the **AUDIO R/L** ports to your audio Hi-Fi amplifier.
6. **USB Device:** If desired, connect a USB storage device to the **USB** port for multimedia playback or software updates.
7. **Power:** Connect the power adapter to the **12V === 1.5A** input on the receiver, then plug the adapter into a wall outlet.

1.3 First-Time Installation and Channel Scan

Upon first power-on, the receiver will guide you through an initial setup wizard. Follow the on-screen prompts to select your language, country, and perform an automatic channel scan. This process will detect and store all available satellite channels.

2. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Remote Control Overview

The included remote control allows you to access all functions of the SRT 7040. Insert the two AAA batteries into the remote control, ensuring correct polarity.




Image: The remote control for the Strong SRT 7040 DTT Tuner, showing buttons for power, numbers, volume, channel, menu, and special functions.

2.2 Basic Functions

- **Power:** Press the **POWER** button to turn the receiver on or off (standby mode).
- **Channel Selection:** Use the **CH+ / CH-** buttons to change channels sequentially, or use the numeric keypad to enter a channel number directly.
- **Volume Control:** Use the **VOL+ / VOL-** buttons to adjust the audio volume.
- **Mute:** Press the **MUTE** button to temporarily silence the audio.

2.3 Menu Navigation

Press the **MENU** button to access the main menu. Use the arrow keys (**UP**, **DOWN**, **LEFT**, **RIGHT**) to navigate through options and **OK** to confirm selections. Press **EXIT** to return to the previous screen or live TV.

2.4 Special Features

- **Timers:** The receiver supports programming timers for recording or switching to specific channels at scheduled times. Access this feature via the menu.

- **Favorite Lists:** Create customized lists of your preferred channels for quick access.
- **Subtitles:** Enable or disable subtitles for compatible broadcasts using the **SUB** button on the remote.
- **Electronic Program Guide (EPG):** Press the **EPG** button to view program information for upcoming broadcasts.
- **Dolby Audio:** The receiver supports Dolby Audio for a high-quality sound experience.

3. MAINTENANCE

3.1 Cleaning

To clean the receiver, disconnect it from the power supply. Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the exterior. Do not use liquid cleaners, aerosols, or abrasive materials, as these can damage the finish or internal components.

3.2 Software Updates

Periodically check the manufacturer's website for available software updates. Updates can improve performance, add new features, or resolve issues. Software updates are typically performed via the USB port following specific instructions provided with the update file.

3.3 Safety Information

- Do not open the receiver casing. There are no user-serviceable parts inside. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel.

- Keep the receiver away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and moisture.
- Ensure adequate ventilation around the device to prevent overheating.
- Only use the provided power adapter.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter problems with your SRT 7040, consult the following table before contacting support.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power adapter not connected; Power outlet faulty	Check power adapter connection; Try a different power outlet
No signal / Black screen	Satellite cable loose or disconnected; Incorrect input selected on TV; Satellite dish alignment issue	Check SAT IN cable connection; Ensure TV is on correct HDMI/SCART input; Perform a channel scan; Consult a professional for dish alignment if necessary
Remote control not working	Batteries depleted or incorrectly inserted; Obstruction between remote and receiver	Replace batteries; Ensure correct polarity; Remove any obstructions; Point remote directly at receiver
Poor picture quality	Weak satellite signal; Incorrect display settings	Check satellite signal strength in menu; Adjust TV display settings; Ensure Full HD content is being broadcast
