# 1. Introduction

This manual provides detailed instructions for the Dyzeryk MP3 Player, Model JS-01. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device to ensure proper operation and to maximize your user experience.

# 1.1 Package Contents

- 1 x Dyzeryk MP3/MP4 Player (Model JS-01)
- 1 x 16GB Micro SD Card
- 1 x USB Cable
- 1 x Earphone
- 1 x User Manual (this document)

# 2. PRODUCT FEATURES

The Dyzeryk MP3 Player offers a range of features designed for portable entertainment:

- Storage Capacity: Includes a 16GB Micro SD card and supports expansion up to 128GB (Micro SD card not included for expansion).
- Audio Quality: Features HIFI lossless sound quality with a professional intelligent digital noise reduction chip and optimized circuit technology.
- Integrated Speaker: Built-in speaker for direct audio playback without earphones.
- Long Battery Life: Provides up to 10 hours of music playback on a full charge, which takes approximately 2-3 hours.
- **Multi-functional Device:** Supports music, video, and photo playback, FM radio, voice recording, and ebook reading.
- Portable Design: Lightweight and compact for easy carrying.

# 3. SETUP

# 3.1 Charging the Device

- 1. Connect the small end of the included USB cable to the MP3 player's USB port.
- 2. Connect the larger end of the USB cable to a computer's USB port or a compatible USB wall adapter (not included).
- 3. The battery icon on the screen will indicate charging status. A full charge typically takes 2-3 hours.

*Note:* Ensure the device is fully charged before first use for optimal battery performance.

# 3.2 Inserting the Micro SD Card

- 1. Locate the Micro SD card slot on the side of the MP3 player.
- 2. Gently insert the included 16GB Micro SD card into the slot with the gold contacts facing down until it clicks into place.
- 3. To remove, gently push the card inward until it clicks, then release, and it will eject.

# 3.3 Connecting Earphones

- 1. Plug the 3.5mm jack of the included earphones into the earphone port on the MP3 player.
- 2. Adjust the volume to a comfortable level before placing earphones in your ears.

### 3.4 Powering On/Off

- To power on, slide the power switch (usually located on the side or bottom) to the 'ON' position.
- To power off, slide the power switch to the 'OFF' position.

### 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 4.1 Basic Navigation

The MP3 player features a central control pad with several buttons:

- **M (Menu):** Press to enter the main menu or return to the previous menu. Long press to access settings or exit current application.
- Play/Pause (Center Button): Press to play or pause media. In menus, press to confirm selection.
- Previous/Next (Left/Right Arrows): Press to skip tracks, navigate menu items, or fast-forward/rewind during playback (long press).
- Volume Up/Down (VOL button, Up/Down Arrows): Press to adjust volume. In menus, these may also function as up/down navigation.

### 4.2 Music Playback

- 1. From the main menu, select 'Music'.
- 2. Navigate through your music library (e.g., 'All Songs', 'Artists', 'Albums').
- 3. Select a song and press the Play/Pause button to begin playback.
- 4. Use the Previous/Next buttons to change tracks.
- 5. Use the VOL button to adjust the volume.

# 4.3 Video Playback

- 1. From the main menu, select 'Videos'.
- 2. Navigate to the desired video file (supported formats: AMV, AVI).
- 3. Press the Play/Pause button to start playback.

# 4.4 Photo Viewing

- 1. From the main menu, select 'Picture'.
- 2. Browse your image files (supported formats: JPEG, BMP, GIF).

3. Select an image to view it. Use Previous/Next buttons to cycle through images.

# 4.5 FM Radio

- 1. From the main menu, select 'FM Radio'.
- 2. The device will automatically scan for available stations (87.5MHz~108MHz).
- 3. Use the Previous/Next buttons to tune to different stations.
- 4. You can save up to 30 channels. Refer to the on-screen menu for saving options.




Image 4.2: The FM Radio function allows you to listen to broadcasts.

# 4.6 Voice Recorder

- 1. From the main menu, select 'Record'.
- 2. Choose 'Start Voice Recording' to begin.
- 3. Press the Play/Pause button to stop and save the recording (WAV or MP3 format).

### 4.7 E-Book Reader

- 1. From the main menu, select 'EBook'.
- 2. Navigate to your TXT format e-book files.
- 3. Select a file to open and read.

# 5. MAINTENANCE

# 5.1 Cleaning

- Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to clean the device's screen and body.
- Do not use liquid cleaners, aerosols, or harsh chemicals, as these may damage the device.

### **5.2 Battery Care**

- Avoid exposing the device to extreme temperatures (hot or cold), as this can affect battery life.
- If storing the device for an extended period, ensure it has at least a 50% charge.
- Do not attempt to replace the built-in Li-ion battery yourself. Contact support if battery issues arise.

# 5.3 Storage

- Store the MP3 player in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and moisture.
- · Keep the device away from strong magnetic fields.

### 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

### 6.1 Device Does Not Turn On

- Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the device to a power source and allow it to charge for at least 30 minutes.
- · Verify the power switch is in the 'ON' position.

### 6.2 No Sound

- Check the volume level. Increase it using the VOL button.
- Ensure earphones are properly connected. Try another pair of earphones to rule out faulty earphones.
- If using the built-in speaker, ensure earphones are unplugged.
- Check if the audio file format is supported (MP3, WMA, OGG, APE, FLAC, WAV, AAC-LC, ACELP).

### 6.3 Cannot Transfer Files

- Ensure the USB cable is securely connected to both the player and the computer.
- Verify the computer recognizes the device as a removable disk.
- · Check if the Micro SD card is properly inserted and not full.
- Try a different USB port on your computer.

# 6.4 Device Freezes or Becomes Unresponsive

- Press and hold the 'M' button for several seconds to attempt a soft reset.
- If unresponsive, slide the power switch to 'OFF', wait a few seconds, then slide it back to 'ON'.
