INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your Lenovo ThinkVision T24i-30 monitor. The ThinkVision T24i-30 features a 23.8-inch Full HD (1920x1080) IPS display, designed for clear visuals and comfortable viewing with its Natural Low Blue Light technology. Please read this manual thoroughly before using your monitor.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items listed below are included in your package:

- ThinkVision T24i-30 Widescreen LED Monitor
- Monitor Stand (Base and Neck)
- Power Cable
- HDMI Cable
- USB-A to USB-B Cable

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Monitor Assembly

Follow these steps to assemble the monitor stand and attach it to the display panel:

1. Place the monitor panel face down on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
2. Attach the stand neck to the monitor panel by aligning the tabs and pushing until it clicks into place.
3. Attach the stand base to the stand neck. Secure it with the captive screw located on the underside of the base.
4. Carefully lift the assembled monitor and place it upright on a stable desk or surface.

The monitor also supports VESA mounting (100x100mm) for wall or arm mounting. Refer to the VESA mount instructions provided with your mounting kit for details.

2. Connecting the Monitor

Connect the necessary cables to your monitor and computer:

- 1. Power Connection:** Connect one end of the power cable to the monitor's power input and the other end to a grounded electrical outlet.
- 2. Video Connection:**
 - o For HDMI: Connect one end of the HDMI cable to the monitor's HDMI port and the other end to the HDMI port on your computer.
 - o For VGA: Connect one end of the VGA cable to the monitor's VGA port and the other end to the VGA port on your computer.
- 3. USB Connection (Optional):** Connect the USB-A to USB-B cable from your computer's USB-A port to the monitor's USB-B upstream port to enable the monitor's integrated USB-A ports.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Power On/Off

Press the power button, usually located on the front or bottom right of the monitor, to turn the monitor on or off. The power indicator light will illuminate when the monitor is on.

2. On-Screen Display (OSD) Menu

The OSD menu allows you to adjust various monitor settings. Access the OSD menu by pressing the OSD button (refer to your monitor's physical buttons for exact location, typically near the power button). Use the navigation buttons to:

- Navigate through menu options.
- Select options.
- Adjust values (e.g., brightness, contrast).
- Exit the OSD menu.

Common OSD settings include:

- **Brightness/Contrast:** Adjust the display's luminance and contrast levels.
- **Input Selection:** Manually switch between HDMI and VGA inputs.
- **Color Settings:** Modify color temperature, gamma, and other color-related parameters.
- **Picture Mode:** Select predefined display modes (e.g., Standard, Movie, Gaming).
- **OSD Settings:** Adjust OSD language, transparency, and timeout.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your monitor.

- **Cleaning the Screen:**
 - Turn off the monitor and unplug the power cord.
 - Use a soft, lint-free cloth lightly dampened with water or a specialized screen cleaner.
 - Wipe the screen gently. Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or direct spraying onto the screen.
- **Cleaning the Casing:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the monitor casing.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the monitor's ventilation openings are not blocked to prevent overheating.
- **Storage:** If storing the monitor for an extended period, disconnect all cables and store it in a cool, dry place, preferably in its original packaging.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your monitor, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
No image on screen	<p>Ensure the power cable is securely connected to both the monitor and the power outlet.</p> <p>Verify the video cable (HDMI or VGA) is firmly connected to both the monitor and the computer.</p> <p>Check if the monitor is powered on (power indicator light should be lit).</p> <p>Press the input selection button on the monitor to ensure the correct input source is selected.</p> <p>Restart your computer.</p>
Image is blurry or distorted	<p>Ensure the monitor's native resolution (1920x1080) is set in your computer's display settings.</p> <p>Check the video cable for damage or loose connections.</p> <p>Adjust the monitor's OSD settings for sharpness and clarity.</p>
Colors are incorrect or faded	<p>Adjust the color settings in the OSD menu.</p> <p>Ensure the video cable is properly connected.</p> <p>Update your computer's graphics card drivers.</p>
Monitor does not turn on	<p>Confirm the power cable is connected and the power outlet is functional.</p> <p>Try a different power cable or outlet.</p>
