1. INTRODUCTION

The BuzzTV HD5 is a high-performance Android 11 TV Box designed to transform your television into a smart media hub. It offers 4K UHD streaming capabilities, ensuring clear and sharp visuals. Equipped with 4GB of RAM and 32GB of internal storage, the device provides responsive performance for applications and media playback. Connectivity options include HDMI output for easy television integration and stable Wi-Fi for seamless streaming and browsing.

2. SETUP GUIDE

2.1 Package Contents

- BuzzTV HD5 Streaming Media Player
- BT-400 Smart Remote Control
- HDMI Cable
- Power Adapter (USB 5V 2A)
- User Manual (this document)

2.2 Connecting Your Device

1. **Connect to TV:** Plug one end of the HDMI cable into the HDMI port on the BuzzTV HD5 and the other end into an available HDMI input on your television.
2. **Connect Power:** Insert the USB power cable into the 'PWR 5V 2A' port on the BuzzTV HD5 and connect the other end to the provided power adapter. Plug the adapter into a wall outlet.
3. **Power On:** The device should automatically power on. If not, press the power button on the remote control.
4. **Select Input:** Use your TV's remote control to select the correct HDMI input source that corresponds to where you connected the BuzzTV HD5.

2.3 Initial Setup Wizard

Upon first boot, the BuzzTV HD5 will guide you through an initial setup wizard. Follow the on-screen prompts to:

- Select your preferred language.
- Connect to your Wi-Fi network by selecting your network name and entering the password.
- Sign in with your Google Account to access the Google Play Store and other Google services.
- Accept terms and conditions.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Remote Control Overview

The BuzzTV HD5 comes with a BT-400 Smart Remote. Familiarize yourself with its buttons for optimal navigation.

- **Power Button:** Turns the device on or off.
- **Navigation Pad (Up/Down/Left/Right/OK):** Used to navigate menus and select items.
- **Back Button:** Returns to the previous screen.
- **Home Button:** Returns to the main Android TV home screen.
- **Volume Buttons:** Adjusts the audio volume.
- **Playback Controls:** Play, Pause, Fast Forward, Rewind.
- **Numeric Keypad:** For direct channel input or other numeric functions.

3.2 Navigating the Android 11 Interface

The BuzzTV HD5 runs on Android 11, providing a user-friendly interface. The home screen typically displays recommended content, installed apps, and access to settings.

- Use the **Navigation Pad** on your remote to move between apps and sections.
- Press **OK** to launch an app or select an option.
- Access the **Google Play Store** to download and install additional streaming services and applications.

3.3 Streaming 4K UHD Content

To enjoy 4K UHD content, ensure your television supports 4K resolution and that you are using a high-speed internet connection. Many streaming apps will automatically adjust quality based on your internet speed and TV capabilities.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure optimal performance, security, and access to the latest features. You can usually find this option in the device's settings menu under 'About' or 'System Update'.

4.2 Cleaning the Device

Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the BuzzTV HD5 and its remote control. Avoid using liquid cleaners or abrasive materials, as these can damage the device.

4.3 Storage Management

The device has 32GB of internal storage. If you experience performance issues, consider uninstalling unused applications or clearing cache data from apps in the settings menu to free up space.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Power:** Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to the device and a working power outlet. Try a different outlet if necessary.
- **No Signal on TV:** Verify that the HDMI cable is properly connected to both the BuzzTV HD5 and your television. Confirm that your TV is set to the correct HDMI input source.
- **Remote Control Not Responding:** Check the batteries in the remote control and replace them if needed. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the device. For Bluetooth remotes, re-pairing might be necessary via device settings.
- **Apps Freezing or Crashing:** Try restarting the BuzzTV HD5. If the issue persists, clear the cache of the problematic app via Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Clear Cache. If still unresolved, consider uninstalling and reinstalling the app.
- **Poor Wi-Fi Connection:** Ensure the device is within range of your Wi-Fi router. Restart your router and the BuzzTV HD5.



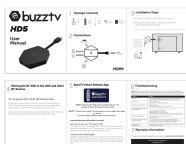



2 Connection

AV Connection

Connect the AV cable to the AV port on the back of the set-top box and the TV. Connect the other end of the AV cable to the AV port on the back of the TV. Connect the power cable to the power port on the back of the set-top box and the power outlet. Connect the remote control to the remote control port on the back of the set-top box.

HDMI Connection

Connect the HDMI cable to the HDMI port on the back of the set-top box and the HDMI port on the back of the TV. Connect the power cable to the power port on the back of the set-top box and the power outlet. Connect the remote control to the remote control port on the back of the set-top box.

3 Installation Steps

1. Unpack the set-top box and the remote control.

2. Connect the set-top box to the TV using the AV or HDMI cable.


3. Connect the power cable to the power port on the back of the set-top box and the power outlet.

4. Turn on the set-top box and the TV.

4 Troubleshooting



Problem	Solution
The set-top box does not power on.	Check the power cable connection.
The set-top box does not output video.	Check the AV or HDMI cable connection.
The set-top box does not output audio.	Check the audio cable connection.
The set-top box does not respond to the remote control.	Check the remote control battery.
The set-top box does not respond to the power button.	Check the power button location.

6 BT-250 Remote - Learning Function

The learning function on the BT-250 remote is used to control your TV. To use this function, you must first learn the TV's remote control. To do this, you must use the learning function on the BT-250 remote.







7 BT-250 Remote - Bluetooth Pairing

1. On your BuzzTV device, navigate to Settings > Remote > Bluetooth.

2. On the BT-250 remote, press and hold the [BT] button for 5 seconds.

3. Select the BT-250 remote on your BuzzTV device.

4. The remote is now paired with your BuzzTV device.

8 BT-250 Remote - Bluetooth Pairing

1. On your BuzzTV device, navigate to Settings > Remote > Bluetooth.

2. On the BT-250 remote, press and hold the [BT] button for 5 seconds.

3. Select the BT-250 remote on your BuzzTV device.

4. The remote is now paired with your BuzzTV device.
