## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The X-PRO X19 125cc Dirt Bike is designed for off-road riding, featuring a reliable Zongshen brand engine and a 4-speed semi-automatic transmission. It is equipped with large 17-inch front and 14-inch rear wheels for improved ground clearance and handling on varied terrain.

### Key Features:

- **Engine:** 125cc Zongshen Brand Engine, known for reliability and power.
- **Transmission:** 4-Speed Semi-Automatic, allowing gear changes without a clutch.
- **Starting System:** Kick Start.
- **Wheels:** Large 17-inch front and 14-inch rear wheels for enhanced off-road capability.
- **Suspension:** Dual suspension system for a smoother ride.
- **Brakes:** Disc brakes for effective stopping power.

### 3. SETUP & ASSEMBLY

---

The X-PRO X19 Dirt Bike requires some assembly upon arrival. This typically includes attaching the handlebars, front wheel, front fender, and number plate. Brake adjustments may also be necessary.

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the dirt bike from its shipping crate and packaging. Inspect for any shipping damage.
2. **Handlebars:** Attach the handlebars to the triple clamps. Ensure they are centered and tightened securely.

3. **Front Wheel:** Install the front wheel, ensuring the axle is properly aligned and tightened. Verify brake caliper alignment.
4. **Front Fender & Number Plate:** Mount the front fender and number plate according to the provided hardware.
5. **Fluid Checks:** Before starting, check engine oil levels and ensure the fuel tank is filled with appropriate fuel.
6. **Pre-Ride Inspection:** Perform a thorough inspection of all fasteners, cables, and controls before the first ride.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Starting the Engine:

1. Ensure the fuel petcock is in the "ON" position.
2. If the engine is cold, engage the choke.
3. Locate the kick start lever on the right side of the bike.
4. With firm and consistent pressure, push the kick start lever down through its full stroke. Repeat until the engine starts.
5. Once the engine starts, gradually disengage the choke as the engine warms up.

### Shifting Gears (4-Speed Semi-Automatic):

The X-PRO X19 features a 4-speed semi-automatic transmission, meaning you can shift gears without manually operating a clutch lever. The shift pattern is typically 1-N-2-3-4 (all up or 1 down, N, then 2,3,4 up).

- To shift up, gently lift the shift lever with your foot.
- To shift down, press the shift lever down with your foot.
- Practice shifting at low speeds in a safe, open area until you are comfortable with the operation.

### Riding:

- Always maintain control and be aware of your surroundings.
- Adjust your speed to the terrain and your skill level.
- Use both front and rear brakes smoothly for effective stopping.
- Avoid sudden acceleration or braking, especially on loose surfaces.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

Regular maintenance is crucial for the longevity and safe operation of your X-PRO X19 Dirt Bike.

- **First Oil Change:** It is highly recommended to change the engine oil after the first hour of operation to remove any manufacturing debris. Subsequently, follow the manufacturer's recommended oil change intervals.
- **Engine Oil:** Use the recommended type and viscosity of engine oil. Regularly check the oil level and top up as needed.
- **Chain Maintenance:** Keep the drive chain clean, lubricated, and properly tensioned.
- **Brakes:** Inspect brake pads for wear and check brake fluid levels (if applicable). Ensure brakes are functioning correctly.
- **Tires:** Check tire pressure before each ride. Inspect tires for wear and damage.
- **Fasteners:** Periodically check and tighten all nuts, bolts, and fasteners, as vibrations from riding can loosen them.
- **Air Filter:** Clean or replace the air filter regularly, especially when riding in dusty conditions.
- **Idle Adjustment:** The idle adjustment screw is typically located beneath a small, black rubber cap on the right side of the bike. Adjust as necessary to maintain a stable idle speed.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Engine does not start	No fuel, choke not engaged (cold engine), spark plug issue, fuel petcock off.	Check fuel level, engage choke, inspect spark plug, turn fuel petcock ON.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Engine runs poorly or stalls	Clogged air filter, improper idle adjustment, stale fuel.	Clean/replace air filter, adjust idle screw, drain and replace fuel.
Brakes feel spongy or ineffective	Air in brake lines, worn brake pads, low brake fluid.	Bleed brake lines, replace brake pads, top up brake fluid.
Excessive vibration	Loose fasteners, unbalanced wheels.	Check and tighten all fasteners, inspect wheels for damage.
