## 1. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read this manual thoroughly before operating your TYTUS Fresno Island Grill. Failure to follow these instructions could result in property damage, bodily injury, or death. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Outdoor Use Only:** This grill is designed for outdoor use only. Do not operate indoors or in an enclosed area.
- **Clearance:** Maintain proper clearance from combustible materials.
- **Gas Leaks:** Check for gas leaks before each use. Never use an open flame to check for leaks.
- **Children and Pets:** Keep children and pets away from the grill at all times.
- **Hot Surfaces:** Grill surfaces become hot during operation. Use heat-resistant gloves and appropriate tools.
- **Fuel Type:** This grill is designed for use with LP Gas (Propane) and is convertible to Natural Gas with an optional kit. Ensure the correct fuel type is used.

## 2. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The TYTUS Fresno Island Grill features a patented no-tool assembly process, designed for quick setup. Two people can typically assemble the grill in 10-20 minutes.

### 2.1 Unboxing and Initial Steps

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. It is recommended to unbox the grill on a flat, stable surface.

## 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The TYTUS Fresno Island Grill is equipped with 5 burners (4 main, 1 side) providing a total of 60,000 BTUs of heating power. It features a spacious cooking surface and porcelain-enameled cast iron grates for even heat distribution.

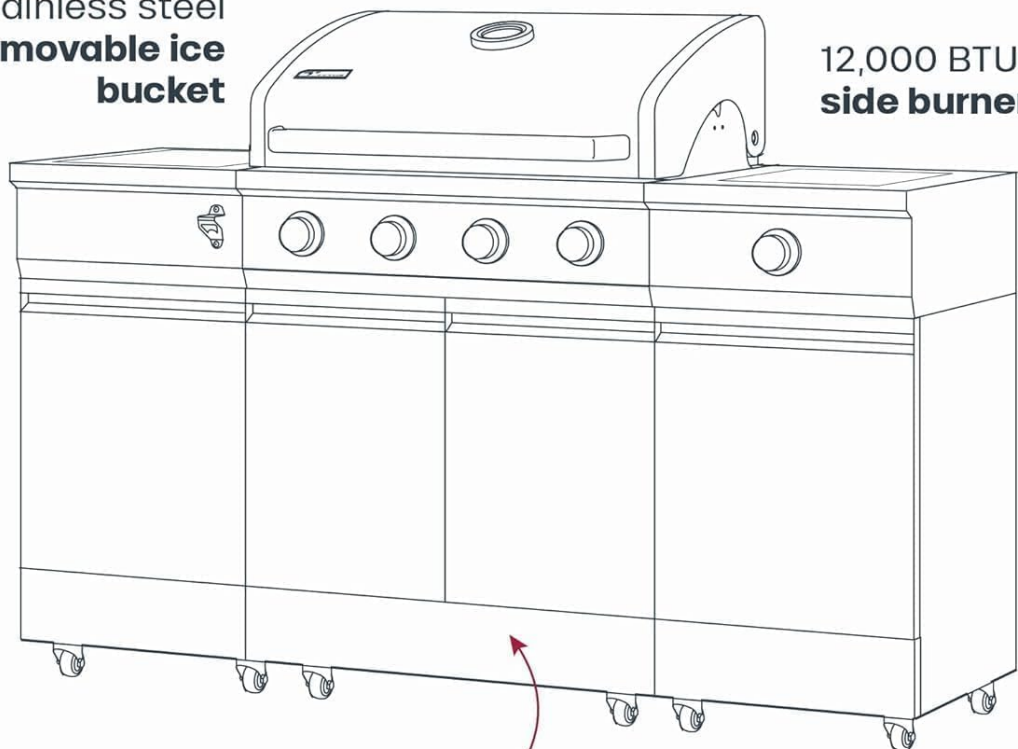

### 3.2 Lighting the Grill

1. Ensure the gas supply is connected and turned on.
2. Open the grill lid.
3. Push and turn a main burner control knob to the HIGH position.
4. Press the electronic igniter button (if applicable) or use a long-stem lighter to ignite the burner.
5. Once lit, turn on adjacent burners as needed.
6. For the side burner, follow similar steps, ensuring the side burner lid is open before lighting.

### 3.3 Cooking Surface and Heat Management

The grill offers 864 sq. in. of total cooking space, including a 510 sq. in. main grill and a 209 sq. in. warming rack. The double-walled hood helps maintain consistent temperatures up to 650°F.

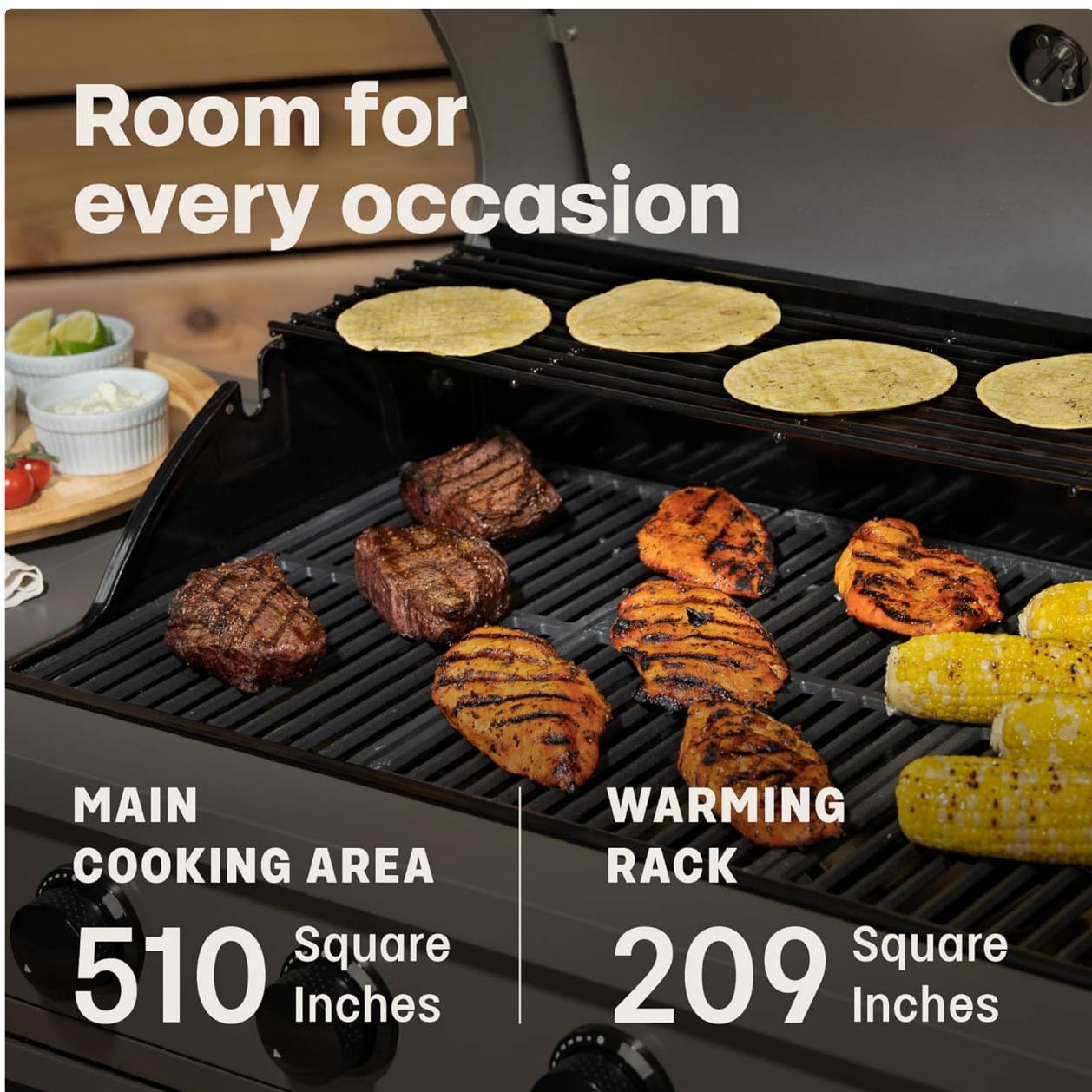

### 3.4 Using the Side Burner

The 12,000 BTU side burner is ideal for preparing sauces, side dishes, or keeping food warm, freeing up the main grates for primary grilling.

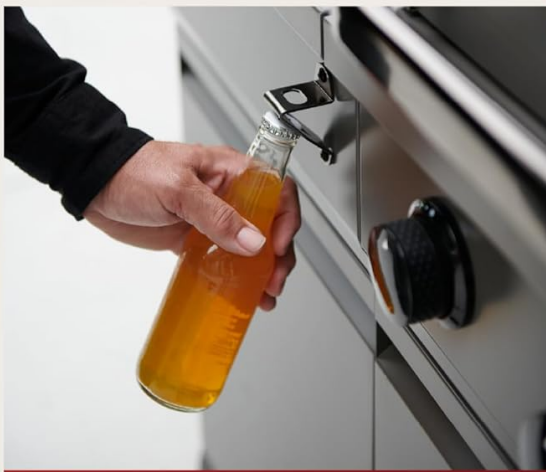
### 3.5 Integrated Accessories

The grill includes a built-in bottle opener, paper towel holder, trash bin, and a 304 stainless steel insulated ice bucket for convenience.

## 4. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your TYTUS Fresno Island Grill.

### 4.1 Cleaning the Grates

The porcelain-enameled cast iron grates should be cleaned after each use. While the grill is still warm, use a grill brush to remove food residue. For deeper cleaning, allow grates to cool, then wash with warm soapy water and rinse thoroughly.

### 4.2 Grease Management

The grill is equipped with an easy-access removable grease tray. Regularly check and clean the grease tray to prevent flare-ups and maintain hygiene.

### 4.3 Exterior Cleaning

Clean exterior surfaces with a mild soap and water solution. Avoid abrasive cleaners that can damage the finish. For stainless steel components, use a stainless steel cleaner.

### 4.4 Storage

The grill features three fully enclosed cabinets (13+ cu. ft.) for storing accessories and keeping them protected from elements and pests.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section provides solutions to common issues you might encounter with your grill.

### 5.1 Burner Not Lighting

- **Check Gas Supply:** Ensure the propane tank valve is fully open or the natural gas line is active.
- **Igniter Check:** Listen for a clicking sound when pressing the igniter. If no click, check the battery or igniter wiring.
- **Clear Burner Ports:** Ensure burner ports are not clogged with debris. Clean if necessary.

### 5.2 Uneven Heating

- **Clean Burners:** Clogged burner ports can cause uneven heat. Clean burners thoroughly.
- **Check Gas Pressure:** Ensure adequate gas pressure. A low propane tank or partially closed valve can affect performance.

- **Flame Tamers:** Verify flame tamers are correctly positioned over the burners.

### 5.3 Flare-Ups

- **Clean Grease Tray:** Excessive grease buildup is a common cause of flare-ups. Clean the grease tray regularly.
- **Trim Excess Fat:** Trim excess fat from meats before grilling.
- **Adjust Heat:** Reduce burner heat if flare-ups occur frequently.
