## SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to set up your Polder Over-the-Door Steaming Station:

- Hang the Unit Over the Door:** Place the over-the-door hook securely over the top edge of a standard door (up to 1.5 inches thick). Ensure the padded liner protects the door from marring and reduces noise.




Image: Components of the Polder Over-the-Door Steaming Station, highlighting the over-the-door hook, integrated post, adjustable clips, and pad hooks.

2. **Attach the Steaming Pad:** Simply hang the steaming pad over the hooks on the horizontal bar of the unit. The pad features grommets for easy attachment.

# Protects doors

*aluminum layer acts as a barrier from steam heat*




Image: Step-by-step guide illustrating the assembly process: hanging the unit, attaching the steaming pad, and clipping a garment.

#### **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Polder Over-the-Door Steaming Station is designed for ease of use with your garment steamer or iron.

- **Steaming Garments:** Once the steaming pad is securely attached to the door, hang your garment using the integrated post or secure it with the adjustable clips. Use your preferred garment steamer to remove wrinkles. The aluminum vapor protection layer within the pad acts as a barrier, protecting the door from steam heat.

## Dual padded hooks

- **Versatile Use - Lay Flat:** For items that require ironing or prefer a flat surface, the steaming pad can be removed from the door and laid flat on a countertop or other stable surface.

### MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and effectiveness of your Polder Over-the-Door Steaming Station, follow these general maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the cotton cover with a damp cloth as needed. Do not machine wash or submerge the pad in water.
- **Storage:** When not in use, unhook the steaming pad and fold it closed for compact storage. It can be stored in a closet or drawer.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check the over-the-door hook and pad hooks for any signs of wear or damage.
