## Introduction

The WEEFUN Kids Instant Print Camera (Model IKSC03) is designed for young photographers, offering a fun and safe way to capture and instantly print memories. This digital camera features inkless thermal printing technology, an 8MP lens for HD photos and 1080P video recording, and a variety of creative options like filters, stickers, and DIY coloring. It also includes educational games and an MP3 player for added entertainment.

This manual provides detailed instructions on how to set up, operate, and maintain your WEEFUN Kids Instant Print Camera, ensuring a delightful and creative experience for your child.

# LOVELY STICKERS AND FRAMES TO CHOOSE

## Setup

1. **Charging the Camera:** Connect the camera to a power source (e.g., computer USB port or USB wall adapter) using the provided USB cable. The charging indicator light will illuminate during charging and turn off when fully charged.
2. **Inserting the SD Card:** Locate the SD card slot on the side of the camera. Gently insert the included 32GB TF card with the gold contacts facing down until it clicks into place. To remove, push the card in slightly until it springs out.
3. **Loading Print Paper:** Open the paper compartment cover on the camera. Insert a roll of thermal printing paper, ensuring the paper feeds out from the top of the roll and is aligned correctly. Close the cover firmly.

# TWO STORAGE OPTIONS

## Operating Instructions

1. **Power On/Off:** Press and hold the power button (usually marked with a power symbol) for a few seconds to turn the camera on or off.
2. **Taking Photos:**
  - Switch to photo mode using the mode button.
  - Frame your shot using the 2.4-inch display screen.
  - Press the shutter button to capture the image.
  - If instant print mode is enabled, the photo will print automatically.
3. **Recording Videos:**
  - Switch to video recording mode using the mode button.
  - Press the record button to start recording. Press it again to stop.
4. **Using Digital Zoom:** While in photo or video mode, use the zoom in/out buttons (often marked with '+' and '-') to adjust the 16x digital zoom.
5. **Applying Filters and Stickers:** Navigate through the camera's menu using the directional buttons to find options for scene filters and stickers. Select your desired effect before or after taking a photo



(depending on the camera model's features).

- 6. **Playing Games and MP3:** Access the built-in educational games and MP3 player through the main menu. Use the directional buttons to select and play.
- 7. **Transferring Files:** Connect the camera to a computer using the USB cable. The camera will appear as a removable disk, allowing you to copy photos and videos from the SD card to your computer.

Maintenance

- **Cleaning the Camera:** Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to gently wipe the camera body and lens. Avoid using liquid cleaners, solvents, or abrasive materials, as they can damage the camera's surface or internal components.
- **Replacing Thermal Paper:** When the print quality diminishes or the paper runs out, replace the thermal paper roll as described in the 'Loading Print Paper' section. Ensure the new roll is inserted correctly to prevent paper jams.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the camera regularly, even if not in use for extended periods. Store the camera in a cool, dry place away from extreme temperatures.
- **SD Card Care:** Handle the TF card carefully. Avoid bending or scratching it. Always safely eject the card from the camera or computer before removing it.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Camera does not turn on.	Battery is depleted.	Charge the camera using the provided USB cable.
Cannot print photos.	Thermal paper is not loaded correctly or has run out.	Check paper loading and ensure the compartment cover is closed. Replace paper if empty.
Poor print quality (faint/streaky).	Print density setting is too low; old or damaged paper.	Adjust print density in settings. Try a new roll of thermal paper.
SD card error message.	SD card is not inserted correctly or is corrupted.	Remove and reinsert the SD card. If the issue persists, try formatting the card (this will erase all data).
Camera freezes or becomes unresponsive.	Software glitch.	Press and hold the power button for 10-15 seconds to force a restart.
