2. SETUP

2.1 Unboxing

Carefully remove the watch and its accessories from the packaging. Inspect all components for any signs of damage. The package typically includes the watch, a charging cable (if applicable for connected features), and this instruction manual.

The 316L stainless steel strap features a folding snap closure. To adjust the strap length, it may be necessary to remove or add links. This procedure often requires specialized tools and is best performed by a qualified jeweler or watch technician to avoid damaging the strap or clasp.

4. MAINTENANCE

Always ensure the crown is pushed in completely to maintain water resistance.

5.2 Connected Features Not Working

- **Bluetooth Connection:** Verify Bluetooth is enabled on your phone and the watch is within range.
- **App Status:** Ensure the JAGUAR Connected app is open and running in the background.
- **Software Update:** Check if there are any pending firmware updates for your watch or app updates.
- **Reset:** As a last resort, try resetting the watch (refer to app instructions) or unpairing and re-pairing it with your phone.
