- Keep hands, hair, and loose clothing away from moving parts.
- Store the cleaners in a cool, dry place when not in use.
- Only use the original charger provided with the product.

## XTROJET 320 ROBOTIC POOL CLEANER

The XTROJET 320 is a cordless robotic pool cleaner designed for efficient cleaning of large debris such as sand, twigs, and leaves up to 5 inches in size. It offers strong suction power and a wide cleaning range.

## Setup

1. **Charging:** Before first use, fully charge the XTROJET 320 according to the charging instructions in the separate charging guide.
2. **Deployment:** Gently lower the XTROJET 320 into the pool. Ensure it is fully submerged before activation.

## Operation

Once submerged, the XTROJET 320 will begin its automatic cleaning cycle. It is designed to navigate the pool floor, collecting debris into its internal filter system.

- **Cleaning Cycle:** The XTROJET 320 operates for approximately 90 minutes per cycle.
- **Debris Collection:** It effectively picks up large debris, including leaves, sand, and small twigs.




Image: The XTROJET 320 robotic pool cleaner partially submerged in water, demonstrating its operation.

## Types of Debris





## Maintenance

- Filter Cleaning:** After each use, remove and clean the internal filter to maintain optimal suction. Rinse thoroughly with a garden hose.
- Storage:** Store the XTROJET 320 in a dry, shaded area when not in use. Ensure it is clean and fully charged before long-term storage.

## XTROVAC 210 HANDHELD POOL VACUUM

The XTROVAC 210 is a cordless handheld pool vacuum ideal for spot cleaning and removing small debris. Its adjustable pole design allows access to hard-to-reach areas.

### Setup

1. **Assembly:** Attach the pole sections to the XTROVAC 210 unit. Ensure all connections are secure. The 5-section pole extends from 2.25ft to 5.5ft.
2. **Charging:** Fully charge the XTROVAC 210 before initial use. Refer to the separate charging instructions.

### Operation

Submerge the XTROVAC 210 into the pool and activate it using the waterproof magnetic switch. Guide the vacuum over areas requiring spot cleaning, such as steps, corners, and small debris concentrations.

- **Working Time:** Provides approximately 40 minutes of continuous cleaning.
- **Debris Capacity:** Features a transparent debris canister with a capacity of 0.21 gallons.





## Maintenance

- **Debris Canister:** Empty the transparent debris canister after each use.
- **Filter Cleaning:** Remove and rinse the stainless steel filter and fine filter sock thoroughly.
- **Storage:** Store the XTROVAC 210 in a dry, cool place, ensuring it is clean and charged.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cleaner not turning on.	Low battery; magnetic switch not engaged (XTROVAC 210).	Charge the battery fully. Ensure the magnetic switch is properly activated.
Poor suction.	Clogged filter/debris canister; large obstruction.	Clean the filter and empty the debris canister. Check for and remove any large obstructions.
Cleaner moving slowly or erratically.	Low battery; wheels/brushes obstructed.	Recharge the cleaner. Inspect and clear any debris from wheels or brushes.
