1. INTRODUCTION

The tectake Vivara 6x3m Garden Gazebo is designed to provide refreshing shade and protection from wind and light rain for your outdoor events. This versatile gazebo features a robust powder-coated steel frame and five removable side panels with large viewing windows. Its simple interlocking system allows for quick assembly and compact storage. Please read this manual carefully before assembly and use to ensure safe and proper operation.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Ensure all frame connections are securely fastened before and during use.
- Do not use the gazebo in strong winds, heavy rain, or snowy conditions. Disassemble and store the gazebo during adverse weather to prevent damage or injury.
- Keep the gazebo away from open flames, heaters, and other heat sources.
- Supervise children around the gazebo to prevent accidents.
- Regularly inspect the frame, tarp, and side panels for any signs of wear, tear, or damage. Replace damaged parts immediately.
- Ensure the gazebo is anchored firmly to the ground using the provided guy ropes and pegs.
- Do not hang heavy objects from the frame.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before assembly, verify that all components listed below are present:

- 1x Gazebo frame (powder-coated steel poles and connectors)

- 1x Roof tarp (polyethylene)
- 5x Removable side panels (polyethylene with Velcro fasteners and windows)
- 6x Guy ropes (polypropylene)
- 12x Pegs
- 1x Assembly instructions (this manual)

4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for proper assembly:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully unpack all parts and lay them out on a clean, flat surface. Refer to the package contents list to ensure all items are present.
2. **Assemble the Frame:** Begin by connecting the steel poles using the interlocking system to form the base and roof structure. Ensure each pole is fully inserted into its connector.

3. **Attach the Roof Tarp:** Drape the roof tarp over the assembled frame. Secure it to the frame using any integrated fasteners or ties. Ensure the tarp is taut to prevent water pooling.
4. **Install Side Panels:** Attach the five removable side panels to the frame using the practical Velcro fasteners. Position them as desired, aligning the Velcro strips for a secure fit.

5. **Secure to Ground:** Use the provided guy ropes and pegs to firmly anchor the gazebo to the ground. Attach the ropes to the designated points on the frame and secure the pegs into the soil. Ensure ropes are taut for maximum stability.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- The tectake Vivara gazebo is intended for temporary outdoor use. It is suitable for garden parties, events, or as a temporary shade structure.
- The five side panels can be easily removed or adjusted using the Velcro fasteners to adapt to changing weather conditions, provide privacy, or allow for more open space.
- Ensure adequate ventilation, especially on warm days, by adjusting or removing side panels.
- Always monitor weather conditions. If strong winds, heavy rain, or storms are forecast, disassemble the gazebo immediately to prevent damage.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Clean the polyethylene tarp and side panels with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not use abrasive cleaners, bleach, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the material and its UV protection. Rinse thoroughly with water.

- **Frame Care:** Inspect the powder-coated steel frame periodically for any signs of rust or damage. Clean any dirt or debris from the frame.
- **Fasteners:** Ensure all Velcro fasteners are clean and functional for secure attachment of the side panels.
- **Storage:** When not in use, especially during off-season or prolonged periods of bad weather, disassemble the gazebo and store all components in a dry, protected area. Ensure all parts are clean and completely dry before storage to prevent mold or rust.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Gazebo is unstable or wobbly.	Frame connections are loose; guy ropes are not taut; pegs are not securely anchored.	Check and tighten all frame connections. Ensure guy ropes are pulled taut and pegs are firmly driven into the ground. Consider additional anchoring in windy conditions.
Water pooling on the roof.	Roof tarp is not stretched tightly enough or incorrectly installed.	Re-adjust the roof tarp to ensure it is taut and properly secured to the frame, allowing water to run off.
Side panels do not attach securely.	Velcro fasteners are dirty or misaligned.	Clean any debris from the Velcro fasteners. Ensure the panels are aligned correctly before pressing the Velcro strips together.
Frame components do not fit together.	Incorrect orientation of poles or connectors; manufacturing defect.	Double-check the assembly instructions for correct orientation. If parts are still not fitting, contact customer support.
