INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your domi outdoor living 12x14 ft Cedar Frame Hardtop Gazebo. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference. Proper assembly and care will ensure the longevity and safe use of your gazebo.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure the gazebo is securely anchored to a stable foundation to prevent tipping.
- Do not exceed the recommended occupancy or weight limit. This gazebo is designed to accommodate approximately 10-15 people.
- This gazebo is designed to withstand wind speeds up to 40 mph and snow pressure up to 22 LBS/Square foot.
- Always follow the assembly instructions carefully.
- Keep children and pets away from the assembly area.
- Do not use the gazebo during severe weather conditions such as heavy winds, snowstorms, or thunderstorms.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The domi outdoor living 12x14 ft Cedar Frame Hardtop Gazebo features a robust cedar wood frame and a galvanized steel double roof, designed for outdoor use. It includes integrated netting and curtains for enhanced comfort and privacy.

Key Features:

- **Cedar Wood Frame:** Provides natural resistance to rot, decay, and insect damage, offering durability and a distinct aesthetic. The frame can be stained or painted to match outdoor decor.
- **Galvanized Steel Double Roof:** Engineered to withstand various weather conditions, offering excellent

ventilation and UV protection. The double-layer design promotes airflow and helps regulate temperature.

- **Efficient Drainage System:** The sloped roof design ensures effective water and snow runoff, preventing accumulation.
- **Integrated Netting and Curtains:** Includes screens and privacy curtains with a double-track system for easy adjustment, providing protection from insects and offering privacy.
- **Multifunctional Ceiling Hooks:** Three integrated ceiling hooks are provided for hanging decorative items, fans, or lighting fixtures.
- **Sturdy Construction:** Features 5.5" x 5.5" cedar wood pillars and pre-drilled anchoring plates for enhanced stability.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly of this gazebo requires careful attention to detail and is best performed with at least two to three people. A graphic installation manual is included with your product for step-by-step guidance.

Preparation:

- **Unpack and Organize:** Carefully unpack all boxes. Lay out and organize all parts alphabetically according to their labels. Separate all screws and hardware into labeled containers to avoid confusion.
- **Tools Recommended:** While basic tools are provided, a power drill driver with 4mm and 6mm hex bits is highly recommended to expedite the assembly process. Set impact drivers to the lowest setting to prevent stripping screws.

Assembly Steps:

1. **Initial Frame Assembly:** Begin by assembling the main beams and posts as per the graphic manual. It is crucial not to fully tighten any bolts until the entire structure is assembled and squared. This allows for minor adjustments and proper alignment.

- Standing the Structure:** Once the side assemblies are complete, you will need assistance to lift and connect the main posts and cross beams into a standing position.
- Squaring the Structure:** After the main frame is standing, measure the diagonals between opposite posts. The measurements should be within half an inch of each other to ensure the structure is square. This step is critical for proper roof panel installation.
- Roof Support Installation:** Attach the roof supports. Some plastic tabs may require temporary securing with double-sided tape during installation to keep them in place until the roof panels are secured.
- Roof Panel Installation:** Install the galvanized steel roof panels. Ensure all panels are correctly aligned before tightening screws.
- Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place and aligned, proceed to fully tighten all bolts and screws.
- Anchoring:** Securely anchor the gazebo to your chosen stable foundation using the pre-drilled anchoring plates.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Curtains and Netting:

The gazebo is equipped with a double-track system for both privacy curtains and breathable mesh netting. These can be easily opened or closed by sliding them along the tracks. Use the included ties to secure them when not in use or during windy conditions.

Ceiling Hooks:

Utilize the three ceiling hooks located on the interior roof structure to hang lightweight accessories such as outdoor fans, string lights, or decorative items. Ensure that any hung items do not exceed the weight capacity of the hooks.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help preserve the appearance and structural integrity of your gazebo.

- Frame Care:** The cedar wood frame is naturally resistant to rot and insects. Periodically inspect the wood for any signs of wear or damage. Cleaning with a mild soap and water solution is recommended. If desired, the wood can be stained or painted to maintain its appearance or change its color.
- Roof Care:** The galvanized steel roof requires minimal maintenance. Clean the roof panels periodically to remove leaves, debris, and dirt. Use a soft brush or cloth with water. Avoid abrasive cleaners that could damage the finish.
- Curtains and Netting:** The curtains and netting can be spot cleaned with a mild detergent and water. For deeper cleaning, follow the care instructions on the fabric labels. Ensure they are completely dry before storing or retracting for extended periods to prevent mildew.
- Hardware Inspection:** Annually, check all bolts and screws to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten as necessary. Inspect anchoring points for stability.
- Winterization:** In areas with heavy snowfall, it is advisable to clear snow from the roof to prevent excessive weight accumulation. Consider removing curtains and netting for storage during harsh winter months to extend their lifespan.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Parts Not Aligning:** If parts do not align easily during assembly, ensure that all bolts are only finger-tight until the entire section is assembled. This allows for necessary movement to align holes. Verify that you are using the correct parts as indicated in the manual.
- **Bent Components:** In the event of slightly bent components, gentle manipulation may be possible to correct them. If a part is significantly damaged or cannot be corrected, contact customer support for replacement.
- **Roof Leaks:** Ensure all roof panels are correctly overlapped and all screws are securely tightened. Check for any gaps or damage to the panels.
- **Curtains/Netting Snagging:** Inspect the double-track system for any obstructions or damage. Ensure the fabric is properly inserted into the tracks.
