1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the GIANTEX Elevated Metal Raised Garden Bed. This planter box is designed to provide a convenient and efficient way to cultivate various plants, including flowers, herbs, vegetables, and fruits. Its elevated design and durable construction make it suitable for both indoor and outdoor use, enhancing your patio, garden, balcony, or greenhouse.

This manual contains important information regarding the assembly, setup, operation, and maintenance of your new garden bed. Please read it thoroughly before assembly and retain it for future reference.

2. Safety Information

- Always assemble the product on a flat, stable surface to prevent tipping or injury.
- Ensure all screws and connections are securely tightened before use. Periodically check and retighten as necessary.
- Do not overload the planter box. The maximum weight capacity is 44 lbs.
- Exercise caution when moving the assembled unit, especially after it has been filled with soil and plants. Moving a filled planter can cause damage or injury. It is recommended to place the unit in its desired location before filling.
- Keep small parts away from children during assembly to prevent choking hazards.
- Wear appropriate safety gear, such as gloves, during assembly to protect hands from sharp edges.

3. Parts List

4. Assembly Instructions

Follow these steps carefully to assemble your raised garden bed.

- Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and lay them out on a clean, flat surface. Verify against the parts list.
- Assemble Planter Box Sides:** Connect the four side panels (two long, two short) together using the provided screws. Ensure the rolled edges are facing outwards for safety and aesthetics.
- Attach Bottom Panel:** Insert the bottom panel into the assembled side frame.**Important:** Ensure the side of the bottom panel with the drainage hole is facing downwards to allow for proper water drainage. Secure the bottom panel to the side panels with screws.
- Attach Legs:** Connect each of the four legs to the corners of the assembled planter box using the screws. Ensure the legs are firmly attached and stable.
- Install Anti-slip Footpads:** Place the anti-slip footpads onto the bottom of each leg. These help prevent slipping and protect surfaces.
- Final Check:** Once assembled, gently shake the unit to ensure all connections are secure and the structure is stable. Tighten any loose screws.

5. Setup

Proper setup ensures the best environment for your plants and the longevity of your garden bed.

- **Location:** Choose a suitable location for your garden bed. Consider sunlight requirements for your plants, accessibility for watering and maintenance, and stability of the ground. The planter is suitable for patios, gardens, balconies, and greenhouses.
- **Surface:** Place the garden bed on a level, stable surface. The anti-slip footpads will help prevent movement.
- **Soil Preparation:** Fill the planter with high-quality potting mix or garden soil suitable for the plants you intend to grow. Ensure the soil is well-draining.

6. Operating

- **Watering:** Water plants regularly, ensuring the soil remains moist but not waterlogged. The integrated drainage hole at the bottom facilitates the removal of excess water, preventing root rot and promoting healthy growth.
- **Monitoring:** Regularly check your plants for signs of growth, pests, or disease. The elevated design makes it easier to access and care for your plants.

7. Maintenance

Regular maintenance will help preserve the appearance and functionality of your garden bed.

- Cleaning:** Wipe down the exterior of the planter with a damp cloth to remove dirt and debris. Avoid abrasive cleaners that could damage the powder-coated finish.
- Drainage Hole:** Periodically check the drainage hole to ensure it is clear of obstructions.
- Seasonal Care:** If using outdoors in harsh winter conditions, consider emptying the planter and storing it in a sheltered area to prolong its lifespan, although the powder-coated metal is designed for outdoor use.
- Rust Prevention:** While the planter is rustproof, prolonged exposure to standing water or highly acidic soil can affect the finish over time. Ensure good drainage and avoid harsh chemicals.

8. Troubleshooting

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

- **Wobbly Planter:** If the planter feels wobbly after assembly, ensure all screws are fully tightened. Check that it is placed on a completely level surface. Uneven ground can cause instability.
- **Poor Drainage:** If water is pooling in the planter, check that the drainage hole is clear of soil or debris. Ensure the bottom panel was installed with the drainage hole facing downwards.
- **Fading Color:** Over extended periods of direct sunlight, the color of the powder coating may fade slightly. This is normal wear and tear and does not affect the structural integrity of the planter.
- **Difficulty Moving When Full:** The planter is designed to be sturdy when stationary. Moving it once filled with soil and plants is not recommended as it can strain the connections. If relocation is necessary, empty the planter first.

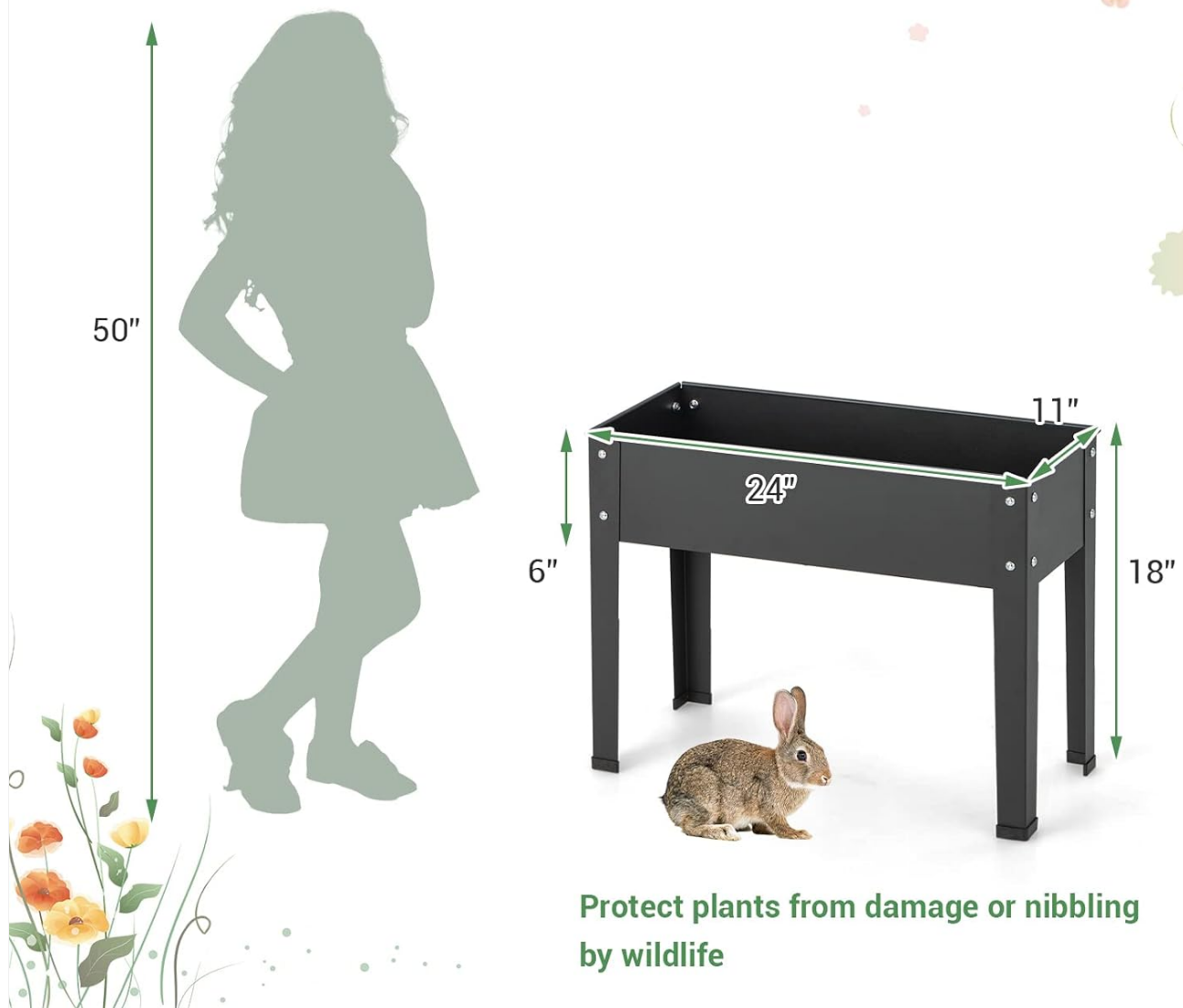


Figure 9.1: Product Dimensions for the GIANTEX Raised Garden Bed.
