INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your SUPERJARE Bakers Rack with Power Outlet. Please read all instructions carefully before assembly and use to ensure safe and proper functionality. Keep this manual for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Do not step on the rack.** This product is designed for storage and display, not as a step stool or climbing apparatus.
- Ensure all connections are secure before placing items on the rack.
- Do not overload shelves. Refer to specifications for weight limits if available.
- Keep children and pets away from the assembly area.
- Use the anti-tip device provided to secure the rack to a wall, preventing accidental tipping.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the SUPERJARE Bakers Rack is designed to be straightforward. Follow the numbered steps in the provided instruction booklet. All necessary tools are included.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging. Lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches.
2. **Identify Parts:** Match each component to the numbered labels in the instruction manual.
3. **Assemble Frame:** Begin by connecting the main metal frame pieces according to the diagrams. Ensure all screws are finger-tightened initially.
4. **Attach Shelves:** Secure the engineered wood shelves to the frame. Pay attention to the orientation of each shelf as indicated in the manual.
5. **Install Power Outlet:** Integrate the power strip into its designated slot on the rack. Ensure the power cord is routed safely and not pinched.
6. **Attach Accessories:** Install the wire basket and S-shaped hooks in their respective positions.
7. **Adjust Feet:** Screw in the adjustable feet at the bottom of the rack. Adjust them to ensure the rack is stable and level on uneven floors.
8. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place, systematically tighten all screws and bolts using the provided tools. Do not overtighten.
9. **Install Anti-Tip Device:** Secure the rack to a wall using the included anti-tip device to prevent accidental tipping, especially in households with children or pets.

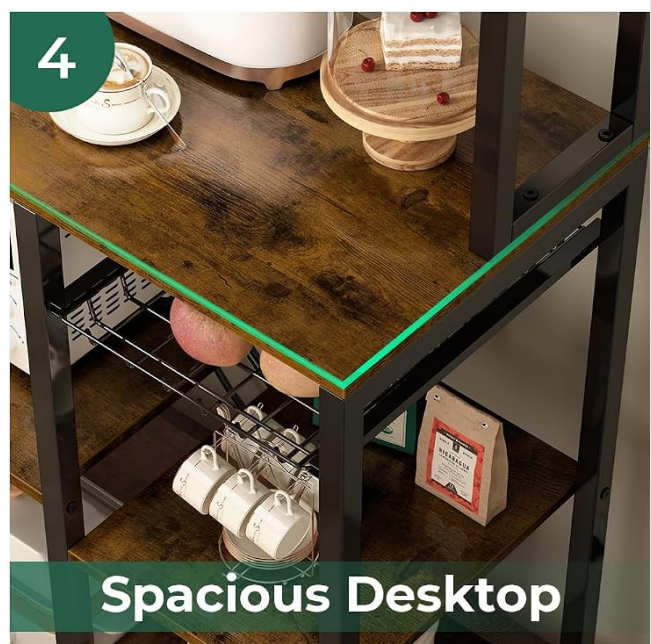

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The SUPERJARE Bakers Rack is designed for versatile storage and convenience, particularly with its integrated power outlet.

Using the Power Outlet

- The rack includes a power strip with 3 AC outlets (125V 15A) and an on-off switch.
- Plug the rack's 6.6-foot power cord into a standard wall outlet.
- To activate the outlets, press the on-off switch located on the power strip. The switch will illuminate when power is active.
- Plug your kitchen appliances (e.g., coffee maker, microwave, toaster) directly into the AC outlets.
- Always turn off the switch when appliances are not in use or when leaving the area for extended periods to ensure safety and conserve energy.

Storage and Organization

- **Upper Shelves:** Utilize the two upper shelves for storing lighter items such as spice jars, seasoning bottles, or decorative items.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life and appearance of your bakers rack.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the surfaces with a dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- **Spills:** Immediately wipe up any spills to prevent staining or damage to the engineered wood.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically check all screws and bolts to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary.
- **Power Outlet:** Ensure the power outlet area remains dry and free of debris. Do not immerse the power strip in water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your bakers rack, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Rack is Unstable/Wobbly:**
 - Ensure all assembly screws and bolts are fully tightened.
 - Adjust the leveling feet at the bottom of the rack to compensate for uneven floor surfaces.
 - Verify the anti-tip device is correctly installed and secured to the wall.
- **Power Outlet Not Working:**
 - Check if the rack's main power cord is securely plugged into a functional wall outlet.
 - Ensure the on-off switch on the power strip is in the 'ON' position (illuminated).
 - Test the wall outlet with another appliance to confirm it is supplying power.
 - If the issue persists, discontinue use of the power strip and contact customer support.
- **Missing Parts During Assembly:**
 - Double-check all packaging materials to ensure no small parts were overlooked.
 - Refer to the package contents list and contact customer support for assistance with missing components.
