1. INTRODUCTION

Officially licensed for PlayStation 5, PlayStation 4, and Windows PC, this arcade stick provides precise control and responsiveness. It features high-quality Sanwa components and offers extensive customization options to enhance your gaming experience.

2. KEY FEATURES

- **Sanwa Joystick & Action Buttons:** Equipped with industry-standard Sanwa components for durability and precise input.
- **Full Button Mapping:** Buttons are fully configurable using dedicated software on PC and Mac, allowing for personalized game profiles.
- **Comfort & Precision:** Features a textured palm rest for stable and comfortable support during extended gaming sessions. Includes two different joystick heads for optimal control.
- **Lock Function:** An integrated button lock feature prevents accidental presses during critical gameplay moments.
- **Customizable Front Plate:** The arcade stick allows for customization of its appearance with interchangeable faceplate options.
- **Audio & Chat:** Includes a 3.5mm audio jack port for direct connection of a headset.
- **All-in-One Package:** Comes with a 3-meter detachable USB-A to USB-C cable, two joystick heads, and tools for customization.




Image 2.5: Screenshot of the dedicated application for button mapping and profile management.

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Unpack the Device:** Carefully remove the NACON Daija Arcade Fight Stick and all accessories from its packaging.

2. **Connect the USB Cable:** Use the provided 3-meter detachable USB-A to USB-C cable. Connect the USB-C end to the port on the arcade stick and the USB-A end to an available USB port on your PlayStation console (PS4 or PS5) or Windows PC.
3. **Platform Recognition:** The device should be automatically recognized by your console or PC. For PC, ensure necessary drivers are installed, which may occur automatically or require a visit to the NACON support website.
4. **Initial Test:** Verify functionality by navigating system menus or launching a compatible fighting game.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Basic Controls

The NACON Daija Arcade Fight Stick features a standard arcade layout. The large joystick controls directional movement, while the eight main action buttons are used for attacks, special moves, and other in-game actions. Additional buttons for system functions (e.g., PlayStation button, Share, Options) are located on the side or top panel.

4.2 Lock Function

To prevent accidental pauses or menu navigation during intense gameplay, utilize the lock function switch. Locate the switch on the top panel of the arcade stick. Moving the switch to the 'Lock' position will disable certain system buttons, ensuring uninterrupted gameplay. Return the switch to the 'Unlock' position to re-enable these buttons.

4.3 Audio Connection

Connect a compatible 3.5mm headset to the audio jack located on the arcade stick for in-game audio and voice chat.

5. CUSTOMIZATION

The Daija Arcade Fight Stick offers several customization options to tailor it to your preferences.

5.1 Button Mapping and Game Profiles

For advanced customization, download the dedicated NACON Daija Arcade Stick software for PC and Mac from the official NACON website. This software allows you to:

- Remap any button to a different function.
- Create and save multiple game profiles for different fighting games or play styles.
- Adjust other settings as available within the software.

5.2 Joystick Head Replacement

The arcade stick comes with two different joystick heads (e.g., ball top and bat top). To change the joystick head:

1. Open the top panel of the arcade stick.
2. Use the provided tool to unscrew the current joystick head from the shaft.
3. Screw on the desired new joystick head until secure.
4. Close the top panel.

5.3 Faceplate Customization

The top faceplate of the arcade stick can be customized. The package includes multiple faceplate options, and a template may be available on the NACON website to create your own designs. To change the faceplate:

1. Open the top panel of the arcade stick.
2. Carefully remove the existing faceplate.
3. Place the new faceplate into position.
4. Close the top panel, ensuring it is securely latched.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your NACON Daija Arcade Fight Stick.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the surface of the arcade stick. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Component Care:** The Sanwa joystick and buttons are designed for durability. Avoid excessive force or impact. If components require replacement, use genuine Sanwa parts or compatible alternatives.

- **Storage:** Store the arcade stick in a clean, dry environment away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Disconnect the USB cable when not in use.
- **Cable Management:** Handle the detachable USB-C cable with care. Avoid sharp bends or kinks that could damage the cable or its connectors.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your NACON Daija Arcade Fight Stick, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Device Not Recognized:**

- Ensure the USB-C cable is securely connected to both the arcade stick and your console/PC.
- Try connecting the cable to a different USB port.
- Test with a different USB-C cable if available, as some users have reported issues with the stock cable or port.
- Restart your console or PC.
- For PC, check Device Manager for driver issues or visit the NACON website for driver downloads.

- **Buttons or Joystick Unresponsive:**

- Verify that the lock function switch is in the 'Unlock' position.
- Ensure the arcade stick is in the correct mode for your platform (if applicable, though not explicitly detailed for this model).
- If using custom button mappings, check your software profiles for errors.
- Perform a factory reset if the issue persists (refer to the full user guide for specific instructions).

- **Audio Issues:**

- Ensure your headset is fully plugged into the 3.5mm audio jack.
- Check audio settings on your console or PC to ensure the arcade stick is selected as the audio input/output device.
- Test the headset with another device to rule out headset malfunction.
