INTRODUCTION

The Mcbazel PhotoFast 247 Dual Auto Catcher is an accessory designed to enhance your gameplay experience by automating certain in-game actions. This device supports simultaneous connection to two mobile phones, offering features such as automatic Pokémon catching, PokéStop spinning, and an auto-tap function for raids and gyms. It is compatible with both iOS and Android devices.

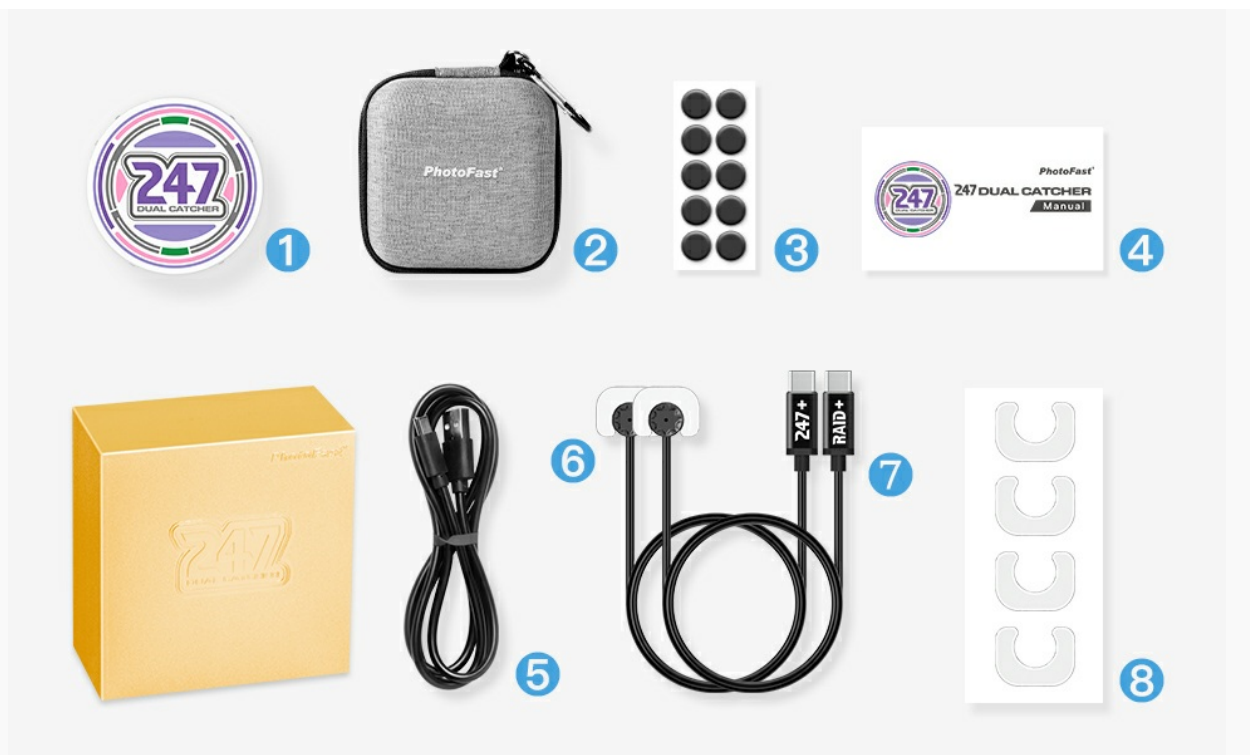

HARDWARE AND SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

To ensure proper functionality, your smartphone must meet the following specifications:

- **For iOS:** iPhone 7 or newer models, running iOS 13 or later.
- **For Android:** Android 7.0 or higher, with 4 GB RAM or more, and Bluetooth 4.0 or later.

SETUP

Connecting to iOS (Player 1)

1. Turn on the 247 Dual Catcher using the POWER 1 switch.
2. Open the Pokémon Go application on your iPhone.
3. Tap the Poké Ball button, then navigate to SETTINGS → Connected Devices and Services → Accessory Devices.
4. Tap the "Pokémon Go Plus - Not Paired" button.
5. Tap "Pair" when prompted. The device should now be connected.

Connecting to Android (Player 2)

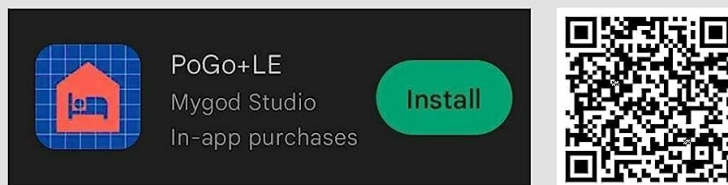
1. Turn on the 247 Dual Catcher using the POWER 2 switch.
2. Open the Pokémon Go application on your Android phone.
3. Tap the Poké Ball button, then navigate to SETTINGS → Connected Devices and Services → Accessory Devices.
4. Tap the "Pokémon Go Plus - Not Paired" button.
5. Tap "Pair & Connect" then "Pair" when prompted. The device should now be connected.

For Android users, to avoid the pairing dialogue, you may consider downloading the PoGo+LE app from [Google Play Store](#). Note that PoGo+LE is not developed by PhotoFast and compatibility may vary.

Resetting the Device

How to reset

All the instructions are using Account 1 to demonstrate


1

Go to the "Settings" on your Go app, tap GO Plus eject icon to disconnect the pairing.




2

Once the pairing is disconnected, the 247 Catcher's blue light starts to blink and beep 3 times.




3

Press the "Reset" button on the side. (Long press for 3 sec)



4

The 247 Catcher's rainbow light starts to blink to indicate that it is preparing to get into the re-pair process. (It will blink for 10- 20 sec before it is ready to be paired again.)



5

Factory reset completes when the rainbow blinking has stopped and beeps 1 time.

When the 247 Catcher's white light starts to blink, please follow the user manual pairing on your smartphone.

1. Go to the "Settings" on your Pokémon Go app, tap the GO Plus eject icon to disconnect the pairing.
2. Once disconnected, the 247 Dual Catcher's blue light will blink and beep 3 times.
3. Press the "Reset" button on the side of the device (long press for 3 seconds).
4. The 247 Dual Catcher's rainbow light will blink for 10-20 seconds, indicating it is preparing for re-pairing.
5. Factory reset is complete when the rainbow blinking stops and the device beeps once. When the white light blinks, follow the user manual for a new Bluetooth pairing.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Auto Catch and Spin

The 247 Dual Auto Catcher automatically catches Pokémon and spins PokéStops. Ensure the Pokémon

Go app is updated to the latest version for optimal performance.

24/7 Connection Function

The device features an auto-reconnect function that extends beyond the typical one-hour connection limit, allowing for continuous play. To utilize this feature, connect the provided 247 cable to the device, ensuring the "247+" side is facing up. Place the auto-tap holder accurately on your screen, centered over the Go+ item icon.

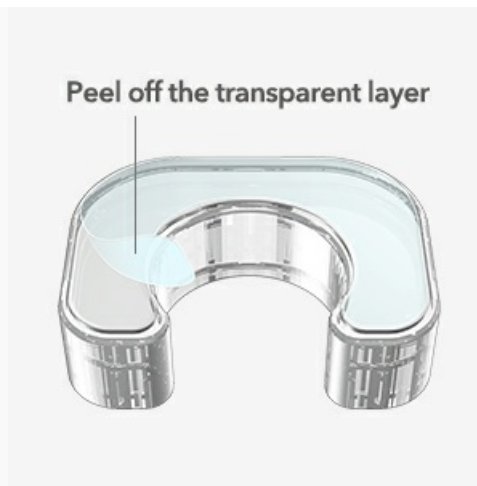

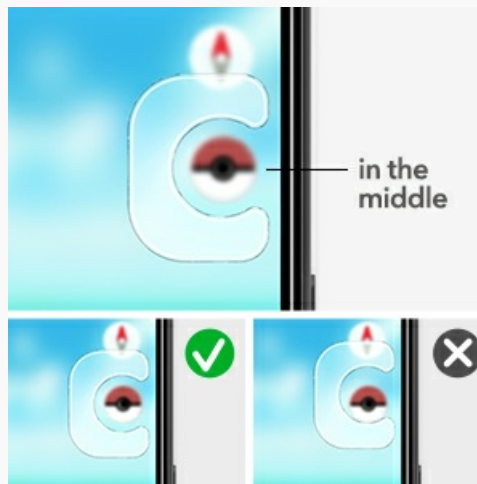


Image: A visual guide demonstrating the correct placement of the auto-tap holder, centered over the Go+ item icon on the screen.

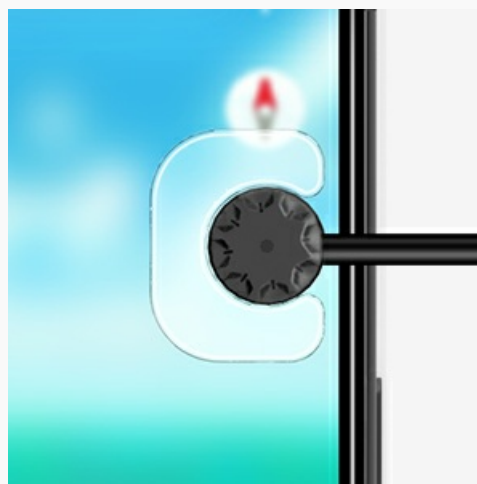


Image: The auto-tap cable connected to the holder, which is positioned on the phone screen for continuous tapping.

Auto-Tap for Raids and Gyms

For raid and gym battles, connect the provided 247 cable with the "RAID+" side facing up. This will enable continuous auto-tapping on your screen, simulating human finger input.

Using with One or Two Phones

The 247 Dual Auto Catcher is designed to work with either one or two phones simultaneously. Each side of the device (Power 1 and Power 2) can be connected to a separate phone.

User Notifications

The device includes a built-in LED indicator to show the catch status. It also features vibrating and beeping functions that can be toggled on or off according to user preference.

MAINTENANCE

Charging the Device

The 247 Dual Auto Catcher is rechargeable via a USB Type-C cable. A full charge can provide up to 120 hours of operation. Do not use the device while it is charging.

Replacing Conductive Patches

After extended use, the conductive patch on the auto-tap holder may wear out. Replace it with one of the additional conductive patches included in the package.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Important Notes

✓ Use the Right Charger:

Please do not use the device while it is charging. Keep it away from extreme temperatures and moisture.

Troubleshooting:

If you encounter any charging issues, please try a different USB cable and power source (like a computer USB port) to identify the problem.

- **Connection Problems:** Ensure your Pokémon Go app is updated to the latest version. Try deleting paired Bluetooth connections in your phone's settings and in Pokémon Go, then reset your 247 Catcher.
- **Auto-Tap Accuracy:** Place the auto-tap holder precisely on your screen, then insert the auto-tap into the holder.
- **Auto-Tap Holder Not Working:** The nanogel adhesive can be restored and reused by washing it with water.
- **Charging Issues:** If you encounter charging problems, try a different USB cable and power source (e.g., a computer USB port) to identify the issue.
- **Poké Ball Usage:** The 247 Dual Catcher only uses standard Poké Balls to catch Pokémon. It does not use Great Balls or Ultra Balls.
- **Environmental Factors:** Keep the device away from extreme temperatures and moisture.
