This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the safe operation, assembly, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Powr-Flite Newton Compact Canister Vacuum Cleaner. Please read all instructions carefully before using the appliance to ensure proper function and to prevent injury or damage.

The Powr-Flite Newton is a versatile and portable vacuum cleaner designed for dry messes on various surfaces, including hardwood floors and rugs. It features a 3-stage HEPA filtration system for improved air quality and a powerful yet quiet motor for efficient cleaning.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always unplug the vacuum cleaner from the electrical outlet before servicing or cleaning.

- Do not use the vacuum cleaner to pick up flammable or combustible liquids, hot ashes, or sharp objects.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of the body away from openings and moving parts.
- Do not operate the vacuum cleaner with a damaged cord or plug. If the cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or a qualified service agent.
- Use only as described in this manual. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- This appliance is for dry pick-up only. Do not use on wet surfaces.

## SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all items from the packaging. Verify that all included components are present.
2. **Install HEPA Vacuum Bag:** Open the canister lid. Insert the HEPA vacuum bag into the designated compartment, ensuring it is securely seated and sealed. Close the canister lid firmly.

3. **Attach Hose:** Connect the anti-static hose to the suction inlet on the front of the canister unit. Ensure it clicks into place securely.
4. **Assemble Wand and Floor Tool:** Attach the telescopic wand to the end of the hose. Then, attach the combo carpet/hardwood floor tool to the end of the telescopic wand. Ensure all connections are tight.
5. **Store Accessories:** Utilize the onboard tool storage for the crevice tool and dusting brush for easy access during operation.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

## General Operation

1. **Power Connection:** Unwind the power cord and plug it into a suitable electrical outlet. The vacuum features a 90-foot cleaning range.
2. **Power On/Off:** Press the power button located on the top of the canister to turn the vacuum cleaner on or off. The unit operates at a quiet 65 dBA.
3. **Adjusting Wand Length:** Use the telescopic wand to adjust the length for comfortable cleaning and to reach high areas, up to a 10-foot vertical reach.
4. **Using the Floor Tool:** The combo floor tool can be adjusted for different floor types. Use the appropriate setting for hardwood floors or rugs.

## Versatile Cleaning Applications

- **Hardwood Floors and Rugs:** Use the combo floor tool. Adjust the setting as needed for optimal performance on each

surface.

- **Above-Floor Cleaning:** Attach the dusting brush for cleaning shelves, blinds, and delicate surfaces.
- **Crevices and Tight Spaces:** Use the crevice tool to reach narrow gaps, corners, and upholstery seams.
- **High Reach:** Extend the telescopic wand to clean walls, curtains, and ceilings.
- **Under Furniture:** The compact design and maneuverability allow for easy cleaning under furniture.

## MAINTENANCE

### HEPA Bag Replacement

The Powr-Flite Newton uses a 3-stage filtration system with a disposable HEPA vacuum bag. Replace the bag when it is full or when suction power noticeably decreases. The 2.6-gallon capacity ensures less frequent changes.

1. Unplug the vacuum cleaner from the power outlet.
2. Open the canister lid.

3. Carefully remove the full HEPA bag, ensuring the self-sealing mechanism is engaged to contain dust.
4. Dispose of the full bag according to local regulations.
5. Insert a new HEPA vacuum bag, ensuring it is properly seated and sealed.
6. Close the canister lid securely.

## General Cleaning and Care

- Wipe the exterior of the vacuum with a damp cloth. Do not use harsh cleaners or solvents.
- Periodically check the hose and attachments for blockages and remove any debris.
- Inspect the power cord for any signs of damage. If damage is found, discontinue use and contact customer support.
- Store the vacuum in a dry, safe place when not in use.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vacuum does not turn on	No power to the unit; power cord damaged; power button malfunction.	Check if the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Inspect the power cord for visible damage. If damaged, discontinue use and contact support.
Loss of suction	Full HEPA bag; clogged hose or attachments; obstruction in the floor tool.	Check and replace the HEPA bag if full. Inspect the hose, wand, and attachments for any blockages and clear them. Ensure the floor tool is free of debris.
Unusual noise during operation	Obstruction in the fan or motor area; worn motor components.	Immediately turn off and unplug the vacuum. Check for any visible obstructions. If the noise persists or is severe, contact customer support.
Dust escaping from vacuum	HEPA bag not installed correctly or damaged; canister lid not sealed properly.	Ensure the HEPA bag is correctly seated and sealed. Check the bag for tears or damage and replace if necessary. Make sure the canister lid is closed and latched securely.
