1. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all safety instructions carefully before using your television and retain them for future reference. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or damage to the product.

- **Power Source:** Connect the TV only to a 220 VAC, 50 Hz power supply. Ensure the power cord is not damaged or pinched.
- **Ventilation:** Do not block ventilation openings. Allow adequate space around the TV for proper airflow to prevent overheating.
- **Water and Moisture:** Do not expose the TV to rain, moisture, or place objects filled with liquids on or near the TV.
- **Cleaning:** Unplug the TV before cleaning. Use a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosol cleaners.
- **Mounting:** Ensure the TV is installed on a stable surface or a VESA-compatible wall mount (200 x 200 mm) that can support its weight.
- **Lightning:** During lightning storms or when unused for long periods, unplug the TV from the power outlet.

- Generic 32-inch LED TV (Model: CV338H A32)
- Remote Control
- Power Cable
- Table Stand (if included)
- User Manual (this document)

3. SETUP

3.1 Mounting the TV

Your TV supports both table mount and wall mount installations.

Table Mount Installation:

1. Carefully place the TV screen-down on a soft, flat surface to prevent scratches.
2. Attach the provided stand to the bottom of the TV using the screws as indicated in the separate stand assembly guide (if applicable).
3. Place the TV on a stable, level surface, ensuring it is not easily tipped over.

Wall Mount Installation:

This TV is compatible with VESA 200 x 200 mm mounting standards. Use a wall mount bracket designed for this standard and suitable for the weight of your TV. Follow the instructions provided with your wall mount bracket.

3.2 Connecting Power

1. Connect the power cable to the AC input port on the back of the TV.
2. Plug the other end of the power cable into a 220 VAC, 50 Hz wall outlet.

3.3 Connecting External Devices

Your TV supports various input connections:

- **HDMI:** For high-definition video and audio from devices like Blu-ray players, gaming consoles, or set-top boxes. Use an HDMI cable to connect to the HDMI ports on the TV.
- **3.5mm Auxiliary:** For analog audio input from devices with a 3.5mm audio output.

4. OPERATING

4.1 Power On/Off

Press the **POWER** button on the remote control or on the TV to turn the TV on or off.

4.2 Remote Control Overview

The remote control uses infrared technology. Point the remote directly at the TV's IR sensor for optimal response.

- **Power Button:** Turns the TV on or off.
- **Input/Source Button:** Selects the input source (HDMI, AV, etc.).
- **Volume Up/Down:** Adjusts the sound level.
- **Channel Up/Down:** Changes TV channels.
- **Menu Button:** Accesses the main menu for settings adjustments.
- **Navigation Buttons (Up/Down/Left/Right):** Navigates through menu options.
- **OK/Enter Button:** Confirms selections.
- **Exit/Back Button:** Returns to the previous screen or exits the menu.

4.3 Menu Navigation and Settings

Press the **MENU** button on your remote to access the TV's settings. Use the navigation buttons to browse options and the **OK** button to select. Common settings include:

- **Picture Settings:** Adjust brightness, contrast, color, sharpness, and picture mode.
- **Sound Settings:** Adjust volume, bass, treble, balance, and sound mode.
- **Channel Settings:** Scan for channels (if using an antenna) or manage channel lists.
- **Time Settings:** Set time, date, and sleep timer.
- **Language:** Select the display language (English is available).

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the TV

Always unplug the TV before cleaning.

- **Screen:** Gently wipe the screen with a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a specialized screen cleaner (do not spray directly on the screen).
- **Cabinet:** Wipe the TV cabinet with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.

5.2 Storage

If storing the TV for an extended period, disconnect it from power, pack it in its original packaging (if possible), and store it in a dry, dust-free environment.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting support, try these common troubleshooting steps:

Problem	Possible Solution
No power	Check if the power cable is securely connected to both the TV and the wall outlet. Ensure the outlet is working.
No picture, but sound is present	Verify the correct input source is selected. Check cable connections (e.g., HDMI) to external devices.
No sound, but picture is present	Increase the volume. Check if the TV is muted. Verify audio cable connections.
Remote control not working	Replace the batteries. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR sensor.
Poor picture quality	Adjust picture settings (brightness, contrast, sharpness). Check the quality of the input signal or source device.
