1. Product Overview

This COSTWAY outdoor chicken coop provides a spacious and secure enclosure for various small animals, including chickens, rabbits, ducks, and dogs. Constructed from galvanized steel with a durable hexagonal mesh, it features a removable Oxford fabric cover with a silver coating for weather protection and temperature regulation. The design includes a lockable door for security and easy access for feeding and cleaning.

Key Features:

- Spacious design (300 cm x 600 cm x 195 cm) suitable for multiple animals.
- Removable Oxford fabric cover with silver coating for waterproofing, sun protection, snow resistance, and temperature regulation.
- Robust galvanized steel frame for durability and rust resistance.
- Includes 10 ground stakes for enhanced wind resistance.
- Secure, lockable door to prevent animals from escaping and deter predators.
- Durable hexagonal mesh resistant to chewing.
- Triangular structure at the base for added stability.
- Easy access for feeding and cleaning through a large door (55 x 160 cm).
- Simple assembly with detailed instructions and included accessories.

2. Safety Information

Please read and understand all instructions before assembly and use. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Ensure all components are securely fastened during assembly to prevent collapse or injury.
- Place the coop on a level, stable surface.
- Use the provided ground stakes to anchor the coop, especially in windy conditions.
- Regularly inspect the coop for any signs of wear, damage, or loose parts. Repair or replace as necessary.
- Keep children away from the assembly area.

- Do not allow children to play inside or climb on the coop.
- Ensure the door is always locked when animals are inside to prevent escape and protect them from predators.
- This product is designed for animal containment. Do not use it for purposes other than its intended use.

3. Package Contents

Verify that all parts are present before beginning assembly. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact customer service.

- 1 x Chicken Coop Frame (Galvanized Steel Tubes)
- 1 x Oxford Fabric Cover
- 10 x Ground Stakes
- 12 x Elastic Cords
- Cable Ties
- Spring Buttons
- Assembly Instructions

4. Assembly Instructions

Follow these steps carefully for proper assembly. It is recommended to have at least two people for assembly.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully unpack all parts and lay them out on a clean, flat surface. Refer to the parts list to ensure everything is present.
2. **Assemble the Frame:** Connect the galvanized steel tubes according to the diagrams in the included instruction manual. Ensure all connections are secure using the spring buttons and any other fasteners. The frame forms a triangular structure at the base for stability.
3. **Attach the Hexagonal Mesh:** Secure the hexagonal mesh to the assembled frame using the provided cable ties. Ensure the mesh is taut and covers all open sides of the enclosure to prevent animals from escaping and predators from entering.
4. **Install the Door:** Attach the door frame and the lockable latch mechanism as per the instructions. Test the door to ensure it opens and closes smoothly and the lock functions correctly.
5. **Install the Oxford Fabric Cover:** Place the Oxford fabric cover over the top of the frame. Secure it using the elastic cords, ensuring it is stretched tightly to prevent water pooling and provide maximum protection. The cover is designed to be waterproof, sun-resistant, and snow-resistant.
6. **Anchor the Coop:** Use the 10 ground stakes to firmly anchor the coop to the ground. Insert the stakes through the designated holes in the metal feet and drive them deep into the soil for excellent wind resistance.

5. Operating Instructions (Daily Use)

This section outlines the daily procedures for using your animal coop.

- **Animal Placement:** Gently introduce your animals to the coop. Ensure they have adequate food, water, and shelter within the enclosure.
- **Feeding and Watering:** Use the large door (55 x 160 cm) for easy access to place and refill food and water containers. Always ensure the door is securely locked after entry.
- **Security:** Always ensure the door is properly closed and the lock is engaged to prevent animals from escaping and to protect them from potential predators.
- **Observation:** Regularly observe your animals and the coop for any issues.

6. Maintenance and Care

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and safety of your animal coop.

- **Regular Cleaning:** Periodically clean the interior of the coop to maintain hygiene for your animals. The large door allows for easy access for cleaning.
- **Frame Inspection:** Regularly check the galvanized steel frame for any signs of rust, bending, or damage. Address any issues promptly to maintain structural integrity.
- **Mesh Inspection:** Inspect the hexagonal mesh for any tears, holes, or loose sections that could allow animals to escape or predators to enter. Repair or reinforce as needed.
- **Cover Care:** Clean the Oxford fabric cover as needed. Ensure it remains taut to prevent water accumulation. In extreme weather conditions (e.g., heavy snow), consider removing the cover to prevent damage from excessive weight.
- **Ground Stakes:** Periodically check that the ground stakes are still firmly in place, especially after strong winds or heavy rain. Re-secure if necessary.

7. Troubleshooting

This section addresses common issues you might encounter.

- **Coop feels unstable:** Ensure all frame connections are tight and the ground stakes are fully inserted into the ground. Verify the coop is on a level surface.
- **Water pooling on the cover:** Check that the cover is stretched tightly and evenly across the frame. Adjust elastic cords if necessary. The peaked roof design is intended to prevent water accumulation.
- **Animals escaping or predators entering:** Inspect the hexagonal mesh for any gaps, tears, or loose sections. Ensure the door is securely closed and locked. Reinforce any weak points with additional cable ties or mesh.
- **Difficulty with door operation:** Check for any obstructions around the door hinges or latch. Ensure the frame is not warped, which could affect door alignment.
