INTRODUCTION

The TPOB X Digital Brushless Hair Trimmer is a professional-grade, cordless, and rechargeable grooming tool designed for precision hair cutting and edging. Featuring a powerful 7200rpm brushless motor and a specialized Psycho Blade, this trimmer offers efficient and reliable performance for both personal and professional use.

SAFETY INFORMATION

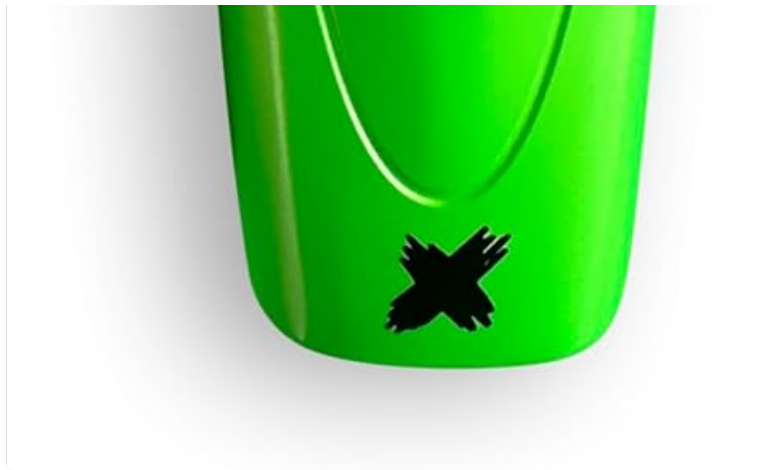
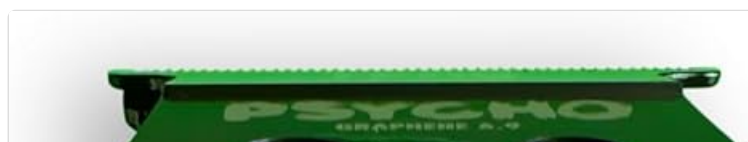


Image: Front view of the TPOB X Trimmer, highlighting the blade and main body.

- **Blade Assembly:** Precision-engineered Psycho Blade for sharp, clean lines.
- **Power Switch:** Located on the side for easy on/off operation.
- **Charging Port:** At the bottom of the unit for connecting the charging cable.
- **Indicator Light:** Displays charging status and battery level.
- **Ergonomic Body:** Designed for comfortable grip and control during use.

SETUP

Before using your TPOB X Trimmer for the first time, follow these setup instructions.

Charging the Trimmer

1. Connect the charging cable to the trimmer's charging port.
2. Plug the power adapter into a standard electrical outlet.
3. Allow the trimmer to charge for approximately 90 minutes for a full charge. The indicator light will show charging status.
4. Once fully charged, disconnect the trimmer from the power source.

Blade Adjustment (Zero-Gapping)

The Psycho Blade can be adjusted for a closer cut (zero-gapping). This procedure should be performed with caution.

1. Ensure the trimmer is turned off and disconnected from any power source.
2. Carefully remove the blade assembly from the trimmer body if necessary (refer to maintenance section for blade removal).
3. Use the provided small screwdriver to loosen the screws on the blade.
4. Gently align the moving blade with the stationary blade to achieve the desired zero-gap setting. Ensure the moving blade does not extend beyond the stationary blade to prevent skin irritation.
5. Tighten the screws securely.
6. Reattach the blade assembly to the trimmer body.

OPERATION

Follow these steps for effective and safe operation of your TPOB X Trimmer.

1. Ensure the trimmer is fully charged.
2. If desired, apply shaving cream or oil to the area to be trimmed for a smoother experience.
3. Turn on the trimmer using the power switch.
4. Hold the trimmer firmly and place the blade flat against the skin or at a slight angle, depending on the desired cut.
5. Move the trimmer slowly and steadily against the direction of hair growth for optimal results.
6. For detailing and edging, use the corner of the blade for precise lines.

- After use, turn off the trimmer.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your trimmer.

Cleaning the Trimmer

- After each use, turn off and unplug the trimmer.
- Use the provided cleaning brush to remove hair clippings from the blade and trimmer head.
- For a more thorough cleaning, carefully remove the blade assembly. Brush away any trapped hairs.
- Wipe the trimmer body with a clean, dry cloth. Do not rinse the trimmer under water unless it is specifically designed for wet use (this model is not).
- Reattach the blade assembly securely.

Oiling the Blades

To maintain blade sharpness and smooth operation, oil the blades regularly.

- Apply 1-2 drops of blade oil (or light machine oil) across the top of the blades.
- Turn on the trimmer for a few seconds to allow the oil to distribute evenly.
- Wipe off any excess oil with a clean cloth.

Note: Regular oiling helps prevent rust and reduces friction, extending the life of your blades.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TPOB X Trimmer, refer to the following common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Trimmer does not turn on.	Battery is depleted.	Charge the trimmer for 90 minutes.
Blades pull hair or cut poorly.	Blades are dull, dirty, or not oiled.	Clean and oil the blades. If dull, consider blade replacement.
Trimmer makes unusual noise.	Blades need oiling or are misaligned.	Oil the blades. Check blade alignment and adjust if necessary.
Short battery life.	Battery not fully charged or aging.	Ensure full charge cycle. If issue persists, battery may need service.

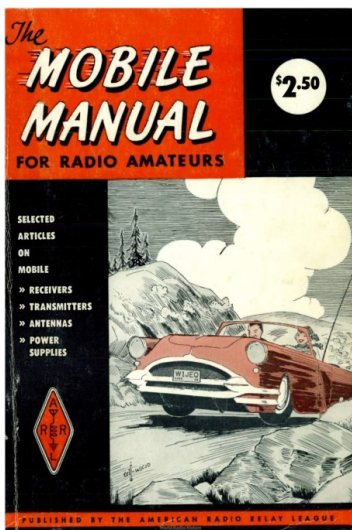
