1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The GOOJODOQ Magnetic Keyboard Case is designed to enhance your iPad experience by providing a full-featured keyboard, a precise trackpad, and a versatile floating cantilever stand. This accessory transforms your iPad into a powerful productivity tool, offering comfortable typing and intuitive navigation.

Key features include a click-anywhere trackpad for accurate gesture recognition, a 7-color backlit keyboard with adjustable brightness, and an integrated LCD display for real-time status updates on battery level, Caps Lock, and Bluetooth connection.

2. COMPATIBILITY

This keyboard case is specifically designed for the following iPad models. To ensure proper fit and functionality, please verify your iPad's model number before use. The model number is typically located on the back of your iPad.

3. SETUP GUIDE

3.1 Attaching Your iPad

1. Align your compatible iPad with the magnetic back panel of the keyboard case.
2. The strong magnetic suction will securely attach the iPad to the case, ensuring proper alignment for the camera and ports.
3. Adjust the floating cantilever stand to your desired viewing angle.

3.2 Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the keyboard case is charged (refer to section 3.3).
2. Turn on the keyboard by pressing the power button. The Bluetooth indicator on the LCD display will begin to flash.
3. On your iPad, go to **Settings > Bluetooth**.
4. Turn on Bluetooth. Your iPad will search for nearby devices.
5. Select the keyboard (e.g., "GOOJODOQ Keyboard") from the list of available devices.
6. Once paired, the Bluetooth indicator on the keyboard's LCD display will become solid.

3.3 Charging the Keyboard Case

The keyboard case is equipped with a built-in rechargeable Lithium Ion battery. Use the provided USB-C cable to charge the device.

1. Connect one end of the USB-C charging cable to the charging port on the keyboard case.
2. Connect the other end to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port.
3. The charging indicator on the LCD display will illuminate during charging and turn off when fully charged.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Keyboard Features

The keyboard features scissor-type buttons for a responsive typing experience and includes a full row of shortcut keys for quick access to iPad functions.

Backlight Control:

The keyboard offers 7-color backlighting with 3 adjustable brightness levels. Use the dedicated backlight keys (often Fn + light icon) to cycle through colors and adjust brightness.

Shortcut Keys:

A dedicated row of function keys provides quick access to common iPad functions such as Home, Search, Brightness adjustment, Media controls, and Volume.

4.2 Trackpad Usage

The precise click-anywhere trackpad supports multi-touch gestures, allowing for intuitive navigation similar to a laptop.

Common Trackpad Gestures:

- **Drag:** Click and drag an item.
- **Open the Dock:** Swipe up from the bottom edge with one finger.
- **Scroll up or down:** Two-finger scroll.
- **Zoom:** Pinch in or out with two fingers.
- **Go to the home screen:** Swipe up with three fingers.

Palm Rejection:

The trackpad features palm rejection technology to prevent accidental touches while typing, ensuring a smooth and uninterrupted workflow.

Palm rejection

When you type on the keyboard, the trackpad activates palm rejection to prevent accidental touches.

4.3 LCD Digital Display Screen

The convenient LCD digital display screen provides real-time information about the keyboard's status.

- **Caps Lock Indicator:** Shows when Caps Lock is active.
- **Residual Power:** Displays the remaining battery percentage.
- **Bluetooth Status Light:** Indicates Bluetooth connection status (flashing for pairing, solid for connected).
- **Charging Indicator:** Illuminates when the device is charging.

4.4 Floating Cantilever Stand

The integrated floating cantilever stand allows for smooth angle adjustment, providing optimal viewing and typing positions for various tasks, whether working or entertaining.

5. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to wipe the surface of the keyboard case. For stubborn marks, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** When not in use, keep the keyboard case closed to protect the screen and keyboard. Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Handling:** Avoid dropping the device or exposing it to excessive force, which could damage internal components or the magnetic attachment system.
- **Liquid Exposure:** Do not expose the keyboard case to liquids. In case of accidental spills, immediately power off the keyboard and allow it to dry completely before attempting to use it again.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

6.1 Keyboard Not Responding

- Ensure the keyboard is powered on.
- Check the battery level on the LCD display. If low, charge the keyboard.
- Verify that Bluetooth is enabled on your iPad and the keyboard is successfully paired. Try unpairing and re-pairing the device.
- Restart your iPad and the keyboard case.

6.2 Bluetooth Connection Issues

- Make sure the keyboard is within the effective Bluetooth range (typically 10 meters or 33 feet).
- Ensure there are no other strong wireless signals interfering with the connection.
- Forget the device on your iPad's Bluetooth settings and attempt to pair again.

6.3 Backlight Not Working

- Press the backlight control keys (Fn + light icon) to ensure the backlight is not turned off or set to the lowest brightness.
- Check the keyboard's battery level. Low battery may disable the backlight feature.

6.4 Trackpad Not Responding

- Ensure the trackpad is not disabled (some keyboards have a function key to toggle the trackpad).
- Clean the trackpad surface to remove any dirt or debris.
- Restart the keyboard and iPad.
