SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Before beginning installation, ensure your TV and wall space meet the necessary criteria for the MantelMount MM815. Detailed instructions are provided in the official installation manual.

- TV Compatibility: Supports TVs from 45" to 90" (diagonally) and weighing between 20-115 lbs (including soundbar).
- VESA Compliance: Up to 600 x 600mm.
- Wood Studs: Requires wood studs for mounting, maximum 28" apart. Wall covering maximum 5/8".
- Mantel Depth: Maximum 16" mantel depth. For TVs shorter than 24", the mount will be visible in the top position.
- Wall Space: Verify adequate wall space height based on TV height and mantel depth.



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The MM815 offers advanced features for effortless TV positioning and optimal viewing.

Automated Drop and Swivel

Utilize the included RF remote control to lower and swivel your TV. The patented, proprietary software and precision electronic actuators ensure smooth and silent operation.

- Vertical Travel: The mount can drop up to 26 inches vertically, bringing your TV from high-level to eyelevel.
- **Swivel:** Once lowered, the TV can swivel up to 30 degrees left or right, allowing for optimal viewing from various seating positions.
- Automatic Straightening: Patented centering cams automatically swivel the TV to a centered position when raised, preventing contact with the mantel or wall.

RF Remote Control and Presets

The RF remote control does not require direct line-of-sight to the mount. You can program two memory presets to quickly recall your preferred viewing positions with a single button press.

Safety Features

- **Soft & Hard Travel Stops:** Vertical and horizontal travel limits are configured through both software and hardware, creating a virtual safety shield to prevent the TV from touching the wall or mantel.
- Visual Temperature Sensor: An integrated heat sensor changes to a red color at temperatures above 110°F (43°C) to warn users if the fireplace heat is too high for the safety of electronics.
- Swivel Safety Clutch: A friction clutch automatically disengages during horizontal movement to prevent damage if the mount swivels into an object.

Additional Features

- Built-in Soundbar Attachment: Allows for seamless integration of a soundbar with your TV.
- Integrated Wire Management: Helps keep cables organized and out of sight for a clean installation.

- Paintable Wall Plate Covers: The wall plate covers can be painted to match your wall color, ensuring a sleek and integrated appearance.
- **Post-Installation Leveling:** Allows for fine-tuning of the screen position after the mount has been installed.

MAINTENANCE
