1. Introduction

3. SETUP

3.1 Monitor Assembly

The VG245 monitor features a quick-deploy toolless stand for easy assembly. Follow these steps:

- 1. Carefully remove the monitor and stand components from the packaging.
- 2. Attach the stand base to the stand column. Secure it by tightening the captive screw on the underside of the base.
- 3. Align the stand column with the mounting slot on the back of the monitor.
- 4. Gently push the monitor onto the stand until it clicks into place.

3.2 Connecting to a Device

The VG245 offers multiple connectivity options. Choose the appropriate cable for your device:

- **USB-C:** For Microsoft Surface devices or other compatible laptops, connect the provided USB Type-C cable from your device to the USB-C port on the monitor. This single cable provides video, audio, data, and up to 60W power delivery.
- HDMI: Connect an HDMI cable from your computer's HDMI output to the HDMI input on the monitor.
- **DisplayPort:** Connect a DisplayPort cable from your computer's DisplayPort output to the DisplayPort input on the monitor.
- VGA: Connect a VGA cable from your computer's VGA output to the VGA input on the monitor.
- **USB Hub:** Utilize the integrated USB Type-A ports on the monitor to connect peripherals such as a keyboard, mouse, or USB storage devices.

4. OPERATING THE MONITOR

4.1 Ergonomic Adjustments

The VG245 monitor is designed with advanced ergonomic features to enhance user comfort and productivity. You

can adjust the monitor in the following ways:

- Height Adjustment: Raise or lower the monitor to achieve an optimal viewing height.
- Tilt: Adjust the screen's vertical angle (forward or backward) to reduce glare and improve viewing comfort.
- **Swivel:** Rotate the monitor horizontally on its base to share your screen or adjust your viewing angle without moving the entire stand.
- **Pivot:** Rotate the screen 90 degrees to switch between landscape and portrait orientations, ideal for coding or document viewing.

4.2 Display Settings (ViewMode)

The monitor includes various ViewMode presets to optimize display performance for different content types:

- Game: Enhances visibility in dark scenes and reduces input lag for gaming.
- Movie: Optimizes color and contrast for cinematic viewing.
- Web: Provides balanced settings for general web browsing.
- Text: Adjusts brightness and contrast for comfortable reading.

• Mono: Displays content in grayscale.

Access these settings through the On-Screen Display (OSD) menu using the buttons located on the bottom right bezel of the monitor.

4.3 Eye Care Features

To reduce eye strain during prolonged use, the VG245 incorporates:

- Blue Light Filter: Reduces harmful blue light emissions.
- Flicker-Free Technology: Eliminates screen flickering at all brightness levels.

These features can be enabled or adjusted via the OSD menu.

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your monitor, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Cleaning the Screen: Gently wipe the screen with a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive screen cleaner. Avoid using alcohol, ammonia, or abrasive cleaners.
- Cleaning the Casing: Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the monitor casing.
- Ventilation: Ensure the ventilation openings on the monitor are not blocked to prevent overheating.
- Power Off: Always power off the monitor when not in use for extended periods.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your ViewSonic VG245 monitor, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
No Power	Ensure the power cable is securely connected to both the monitor and a working power outlet. Check the power indicator light.
No Image on Screen	Verify the video cable (USB-C, HDMI, DisplayPort, VGA) is securely connected to both the monitor and your computer. Ensure the correct input source is selected on the monitor via the OSD menu. Check if your computer is powered on and not in sleep mode.
Image is Blurry or Distorted	Adjust the display resolution on your computer to the monitor's native resolution (1920x1080). Check the video cable for damage or loose connections.
No Sound	Ensure the audio output on your computer is directed to the monitor. Adjust the volume settings on both the monitor and your computer. If using HDMI or DisplayPort, ensure the cable supports audio transmission.


