Model: Vital 100S, Vital 200S

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The LEVOIT Vital 100S and Vital 200S are advanced air purifiers designed to improve indoor air quality in various room sizes. These models feature an integrated air quality monitor and a multi-stage filtration system to capture airborne particles, allergens, and odors.

Key features include:

- **Air Quality Monitor:** Automatically adjusts fan speed based on detected air quality.
- **3-Stage Filtration System:** Includes a Washable Pre-Filter, H13 True HEPA Filter, and High-Efficiency Activated Carbon Filter.
- **Pet Mode:** Optimizes air cleaning and energy conservation for pet owners.
- **Light Detection:** Automatically turns off display lights and limits fan speeds in dark environments for undisturbed sleep.
- **U-shaped Air Inlet:** Designed for enhanced capture of pet fur and large particles.

2. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to set up your LEVOIT Air Purifier for the first time.

1. **Unpack the Air Purifier:** Carefully remove the air purifier from its packaging. Retain all packaging materials for future transport or storage.

2. **Remove Filter Packaging:** Before first use, open the filter compartment and remove the plastic packaging from the filters.

3. **Install Filters:** Place the filters back into the air purifier in the correct order (Pre-Filter, HEPA, Activated Carbon). Ensure they are securely seated.
4. **Close Compartment:** Close the filter compartment cover securely.
5. **Position the Air Purifier:** Place the air purifier on a firm, level surface. Ensure there is at least 15 inches (38 cm) of clearance on all sides for optimal airflow.

6. **Connect Power:** Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Understand how to use the various functions of your LEVOIT Air Purifier.

3.1 Control Panel

The control panel is located on the top of the air purifier and features touch-sensitive buttons for various settings.

3.2 Power On/Off

- Press the **Power Button** to turn the air purifier on or off.

3.3 Fan Speed Adjustment

- Press the **Fan Speed Button** to cycle through fan speeds (1, 2, 3, Turbo).

3.4 Mode Selection

- **Auto Mode:** Press the **Auto Mode Button**. The air purifier will automatically adjust fan speed based on the detected air quality.
- **Sleep Mode:** Press the **Sleep Mode Button**. The air purifier operates at the lowest fan speed, and display lights are dimmed or turned off.
- **Pet Mode:** Press the **Pet Mode Button**. This mode optimizes air cleaning for pet dander and odors while conserving energy.

3.5 Light Detection Feature

The air purifier features a light sensor. When the room becomes dark, the display lights will automatically turn off, and if in Auto Mode, the fan speed will be limited to the quietest settings to ensure undisturbed sleep.

4. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your air purifier.

4.1 Filter Cleaning and Replacement

- **Washable Pre-Filter:** The pre-filter can be cleaned regularly (e.g., every 2-4 weeks) to remove large particles like pet fur and dust.
 - a. Turn off and unplug the air purifier.
 - b. Open the filter cover and remove the pre-filter.
 - c. Rinse the pre-filter under running water until clean.
 - d. Allow the pre-filter to air dry completely before reinstalling.
- **H13 True HEPA and Activated Carbon Filters:** These filters are not washable and must be replaced. The filter life indicator on the control panel will illuminate when replacement is needed (typically every 6-8 months, depending on usage).
 - a. Turn off and unplug the air purifier.
 - b. Open the filter cover and remove the old HEPA and Activated Carbon filters.
 - c. Dispose of the old filters responsibly.
 - d. Insert new genuine LEVOIT replacement filters, ensuring correct orientation.
 - e. Close the filter cover.
 - f. Press and hold the **Filter Reset Button** (if available, or consult specific model manual) for 3 seconds to reset the filter life indicator.

4.2 Exterior Cleaning

- Wipe the exterior of the air purifier with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to this section for common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Air purifier does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outage; filter packaging not removed.	Ensure power cord is securely plugged in. Check circuit breaker. Remove all filter packaging.
Airflow is significantly reduced.	Clogged pre-filter; dirty HEPA/Activated Carbon filters.	Clean the washable pre-filter. Replace the HEPA and Activated Carbon filters.
Unusual noise.	Object stuck in fan; filters not installed correctly.	Turn off and unplug. Check for obstructions. Reinstall filters securely.
Air quality indicator always shows poor.	Sensor is dirty; high pollution levels.	Clean the air quality sensor (refer to specific model manual for location). Ensure proper ventilation.
