3. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Logitech M185 Wireless Mouse:

1. **Insert Battery:** Open the battery compartment on the underside of the mouse. Insert one AA battery, ensuring correct polarity.
2. **Locate USB Receiver:** The small USB receiver is typically stored inside the battery compartment for convenience during transport. Carefully remove it.
3. **Connect USB Receiver:** Plug the USB receiver into an available USB port on your computer.
4. **Power On Mouse:** Locate the On/Off switch on the underside of the mouse and slide it to the 'On' position.
5. **Automatic Connection:** Your mouse should automatically connect to your computer. If not, try moving the mouse or restarting your computer.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Logitech M185 Wireless Mouse is designed for intuitive and comfortable use:

- **Movement:** Move the mouse across a flat surface to control the cursor on your screen. The optical sensor provides precise tracking.
- **Left Click:** Press the left button to select items, open files, or activate functions.
- **Right Click:** Press the right button to open context menus or access additional options.
- **Scroll Wheel:** Roll the scroll wheel up or down to navigate through documents and web pages. The wheel can also be pressed for middle-click functionality in some applications.
- **Ergonomics:** The contoured shape of the mouse fits naturally in your hand, providing comfort during prolonged use.

5. MAINTENANCE

- **Battery Replacement:** When the mouse performance degrades or the indicator light (if present) signals low battery, replace the AA battery. Open the battery compartment, remove the old battery, and insert a new one with correct polarity.
- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a mild cleaning solution to clean the exterior of the mouse. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials. For the optical sensor, use a dry cotton swab to gently remove any dust or debris.
- **Storage:** When not in use, especially during travel, you can store the USB receiver inside the mouse's battery compartment to prevent loss. Turn off the mouse using the On/Off switch to conserve battery life.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Logitech M185 Wireless Mouse, try the following solutions:

- **Mouse Not Responding:**
 - Ensure the mouse is turned on.
 - Check if the USB receiver is securely plugged into a working USB port on your computer. Try a different USB port.
 - Replace the battery with a fresh AA battery.
 - Move the mouse closer to the USB receiver to ensure it's within the wireless range (up to 10 meters).
- **Erratic Cursor Movement:**
 - Clean the optical sensor on the underside of the mouse.
 - Ensure you are using the mouse on a suitable surface. Highly reflective or transparent surfaces may cause issues. A mouse pad is recommended.
- **Buttons or Scroll Wheel Not Working:**
 - Ensure the mouse is powered on and connected.
 - Try restarting your computer.
 - If possible, test the mouse on another computer to determine if the issue is with the mouse or the computer's settings.
