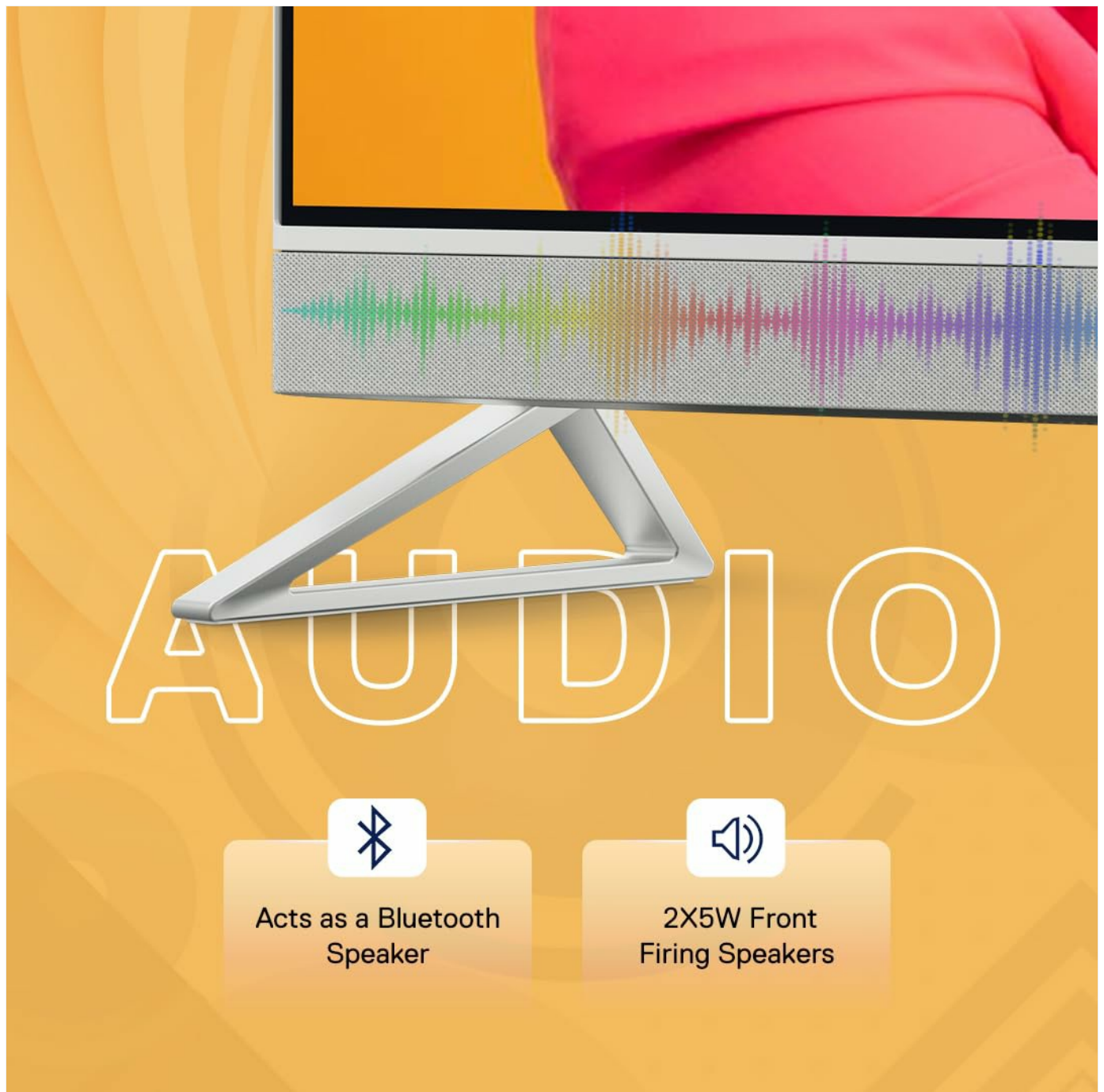

4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to set up your Dell Inspiron 7710 All-in-One PC:

1. **Unpack the System:** Carefully remove the All-in-One PC, keyboard, mouse, and power adapter from the packaging.
2. **Position the PC:** Place the All-in-One PC on a stable, flat surface with adequate ventilation.
3. **Connect Power:** Connect the AC adapter to the power-adapter port on the back of the PC, then plug the power cable into a wall outlet.
4. **Connect Keyboard and Mouse:** The Dell Pro Wireless Keyboard and Mouse are pre-paired. Insert the USB receiver (usually found in the mouse or keyboard battery compartment) into an available USB port on the PC. Ensure batteries are installed in the keyboard and mouse.
5. **Connect Network (Optional):** For a wired internet connection, connect an Ethernet cable from your router or modem to the RJ-45 port on the PC. For wireless, you will configure Wi-Fi during the initial Windows setup.
6. **Initial Boot:** Press the Power Button (refer to Section 3.5 for location) to turn on the PC. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the Windows 11 setup process.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Power On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press the Power Button (Item 1 in Section 3.5).
- **To Shut Down:** Click the Start button in Windows, then select Power > Shut down.
- **To Restart:** Click the Start button in Windows, then select Power > Restart.
- **To Sleep:** Click the Start button in Windows, then select Power > Sleep.

5.2. Using the Touchscreen

The 27-inch FHD display supports touch input. Use gestures similar to a tablet or smartphone for navigation, zooming,

and interaction with applications.

5.3. Adjusting the Display

- **Swivel Function:** Gently adjust the display panel left or right to achieve your desired viewing angle.
- **Monitor Mode Switch:** Use the Monitor Mode Switch (Item 2 in Section 3.5) to toggle between PC display mode and external input display mode (if an external device is connected to the HDMI-in port).

5.4. Using the Pop-up Camera

The integrated FHD camera is designed to pop up for use and retract for privacy. Gently press the top of the camera module to extend or retract it. Adjust the tilt for optimal framing during video calls.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance helps ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your PC.

- **Cleaning the Display:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth specifically designed for electronics. Dampen the cloth slightly with water or a non-abrasive screen cleaner. Do not spray liquid directly onto the screen.
- **Cleaning the Chassis:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the exterior of the PC. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by a dry cloth.
- **Software Updates:** Regularly check for and install Windows updates, driver updates from Dell's support website, and application updates to ensure security and performance.
- **Data Backup:** Periodically back up your important files to an external hard drive or cloud storage to prevent data loss.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure that the ventilation slots on the PC are not obstructed to prevent overheating.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section provides solutions to common issues you might encounter.

Problem	Possible Solution
PC does not power on.	• Ensure the power cable is securely connected to the PC and the wall outlet. • Verify the wall outlet is functional by plugging in another device. • Check the AC adapter for any damage.
No display on screen.	• Ensure the PC is powered on. • Press the Monitor Mode Switch (Item 2 in Section 3.5) to ensure it's in PC display mode. • Adjust display brightness settings.
Wireless keyboard/mouse not working.	• Check if the USB receiver is securely plugged into a USB port. • Replace batteries in the keyboard and mouse. • Ensure the keyboard/mouse power switch is ON.

Problem	Possible Solution
No audio output.	• Check volume levels in Windows and on any external speakers. • Ensure correct audio output device is selected in Windows sound settings. • Verify speaker cables (if external) are properly connected.
