INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Honeywell Home HE240D2001/U Whole Home Humidifier. This system is designed to integrate with your forced-air furnace to distribute moisture throughout your home, enhancing comfort and protecting wood furnishings.

- Water Safety: Ensure all water connections are secure to prevent leaks. Turn off the water supply before servicing the unit.
- **Installation:** This humidifier must be installed by a qualified HVAC technician in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. Improper installation can lead to operational issues or damage.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The HE240D Whole Home Humidifier is designed for mounting on either the warm air supply or return air duct of forced-air furnaces. Professional installation is highly recommended to ensure proper function and safety.

Pre-Installation Requirements

- Access to a floor drain for the humidifier's drain line.
- Full access to air ducts for mounting and connections.
- Appropriate tools for cutting ductwork, plumbing, and electrical connections.

Installation Steps Overview

This is a general overview. Refer to the detailed instructions provided with the unit for specific steps.

- 1. **Mount the Humidifier:** Securely attach the humidifier unit to the selected furnace ductwork using the provided mounting hardware.
- Connect Water Supply: Connect the humidifier to a cold water supply line. Ensure all connections are watertight.
- 3. **Connect Drain Line:** Route the drain line from the humidifier to a suitable floor drain, ensuring a continuous downward slope for proper drainage.
- 4. Wire the Humidistat and Humidifier: Connect the digital humidistat and the humidifier unit to the furnace control board according to the wiring diagram. This typically involves low-voltage wiring.
- 5. Test Operation: Restore power and water, then test the humidifier's operation using the humidistat.





OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The included digital humidistat with an outdoor sensor controls the humidifier's operation, allowing for automatic humidity regulation.

Setting Desired Humidity

- Use the up and down arrow buttons on the humidistat to adjust your desired humidity level.
- The humidistat will display the current indoor humidity and your set point.
- The unit will automatically turn on and off to maintain the preset humidity level, taking into account outdoor temperature to prevent window condensation.
- Ensure the humidistat is set to 'Auto' or 'On' for automatic operation.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your humidifier. Always disconnect power and water supply before performing maintenance.

Humidifier Pad Replacement

- Seasonal humidifier pad replacement is required, typically once per heating season.
- Refer to your humidistat or unit for indicators that the pad needs replacement.
- To replace, turn off power and water, open the humidifier cover, remove the old pad, and insert a new genuine Honeywell Home replacement pad.
- Ensure the new pad is correctly oriented and seated.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your humidifier, consult the following troubleshooting guide:

• No Humidity Output:

Check if the furnace fan is running. Verify the water supply valve is open. Ensure the humidistat is set to a humidity level higher than the current indoor humidity. Inspect the humidifier pad for clogs or incorrect installation. Check electrical connections for power to the unit and humidistat.

· Water Leaks:

Turn off the water supply immediately. Inspect all water connections (supply line, drain line) for tightness. Check the drain line for kinks or obstructions. Ensure the humidifier pad is not overwhelmed by water flow; if adjustable, reduce the flow.

• Humidistat Issues (Unresponsive/Errors):

Verify the humidistat has power and its wiring connections are secure. If the display is blank, check the power source. Consult the humidistat's specific user guide for error codes and their meanings.

• Unit Not Turning On:

Confirm that the furnace is operating and calling for heat or fan. Check the humidistat setting; it must be

calling for humidity. Verify all electrical connections are secure and receiving power. Ensure the solenoid valve is functioning correctly (if applicable).
