1. INTRODUCTION

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Incorrect Analog Readings	Incorrect wiring, sensor fault, or incorrect configuration.	Verify wiring against diagram. Test sensor. Check module configuration settings.
Communication Error	Network issue or module fault.	Check network cables and connections. Verify network configuration.
