3.1 Filling the Hopper

- Open the hopper lid located on top of the stove.
- Pour wood pellets into the hopper, ensuring not to overfill. The hopper holds up to 40lbs of pellets.
- Close the hopper lid securely. The stove will not operate if the lid is not properly closed due to a safety mechanism.

3.2 Operating Modes

4.1 Cleaning the Fire Chamber and Ash Pot

- Ensure the stove is completely cool before cleaning.
- Open the main door and remove the ash pot.
- Dispose of ashes in a metal container with a tight-fitting lid.
- Clean the fire chamber and glass with a damp cloth or specialized stove cleaner.

5.3 Excessive Smoke or Soot

- **Venting:** Check for obstructions in the vent pipe. Ensure proper installation and sealing.
- **Air Intake:** Verify that the air intake is not blocked.
- **Pellet Quality:** Poor quality pellets can lead to more smoke and soot.
