1. WELCOME

Thank you for choosing the Llano High Speed Ionic Hair Dryer. This advanced hair dryer is engineered with a powerful 1500W brushless motor and innovative ionic technology to provide ultra-fast drying, reduce frizz, and protect your hair from heat damage. Its lightweight and foldable design makes it ideal for both home and travel use. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the appliance to ensure safe and optimal performance.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, especially when children are present, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- Read the instruction manual for safety instructions.

3.1 Hair Dryer Features

The Llano High Speed Ionic Hair Dryer features a sleek, ergonomic design with advanced internal components for superior performance.

- **High-Speed Brushless Motor:** 1400W motor with 110,000 RPM for ultra-fast drying.
- **Neutralizing Ion Technology:** Releases 200 million positive and negative ions to reduce static and frizz.
- **Smart Heat Sensor:** Monitors heat 1000 times/sec to prevent hair damage.
- **Foldable Design:** Compact and lightweight (362g) for easy storage and travel.
- **Quiet Operation:** Operates at a low noise level of 58dB.

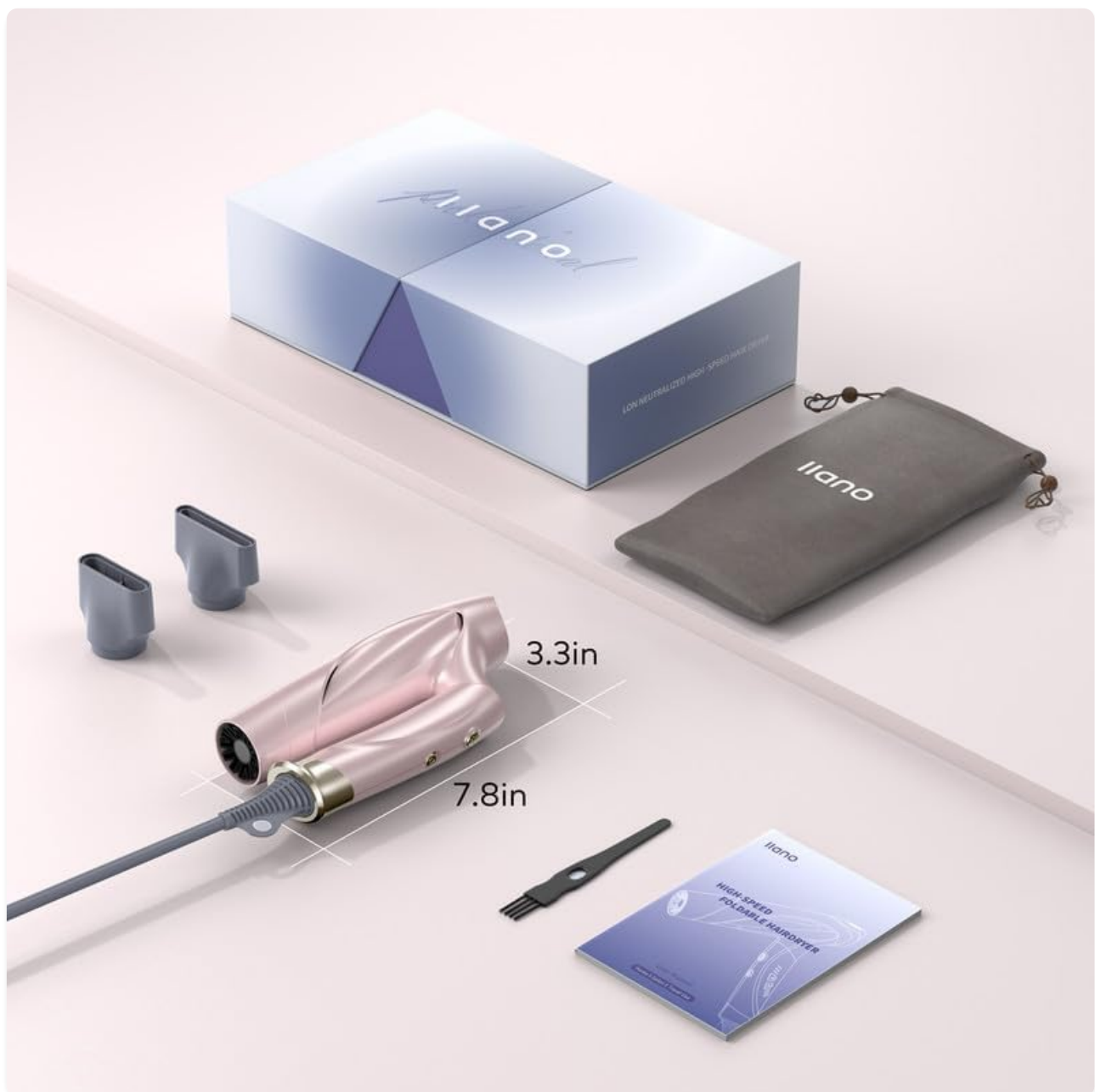


Figure 3.3: Package Contents. This image shows all items included in the product box: the hair dryer, two nozzles, a storage bag, a dusting brush, and the instruction manual.

4. GETTING STARTED

4.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain the packaging for future storage or transport if needed.

4.2 Connecting to Power

Ensure your power outlet is 120 volts, as required by the hair dryer. Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet. The cord features an ALCI (Appliance Leakage Current Interrupter) safety plug for enhanced protection against electric shock.

5. OPERATING YOUR HAIR DRYER

5.1 Power On/Off

Locate the ON/OFF switch on the handle. Press it to turn the hair dryer on or off. There may be a slight delay of a few seconds for the motor to start or stop.

5.2 Adjusting Settings

The hair dryer offers 12 combinations of speed and heat settings to suit various hair types and styling needs.

- **Wind Speed:** Use the speed button to cycle through 3 settings: Low, Medium, and High.
- **Heat Modes:** Use the heat button to cycle through 4 settings: Natural Air Temp, Low (122°F), Medium (158°F), and High (212°F).
- **Hot and Cold Cycle:** Press the dedicated button for a 3-second automatic hot and cold air cycle, which helps to set your hairstyle.

5.3 Using Attachments

The hair dryer comes with two magnetic concentrator nozzles. These attachments can be easily attached or detached from the front of the hair dryer.

- **Concentrator Nozzles:** Ideal for precise styling, straightening smooth hair, creating defined curls, or adding volume.
- To attach, simply align the nozzle with the magnetic outlet and it will snap into place.
- To detach, gently pull the nozzle away from the hair dryer.

5.4 Hair Drying Techniques

Follow these steps for fast and beautiful hair:



Figure 5.4: How to Get Fast and Beautiful Hair. This visual guide provides five steps for effective hair drying, from towel-drying to final styling.

1. After washing your hair, wipe the wet hair with a towel and then comb it through with a comb.
2. Adjust the heat and wind according to your hairstyle, and blow dry in the order of root-middle-end of the hair.
3. When the hair is 70% dry, use the hot and cold cycle button to blow along the hair from the root to the end of the hair.
4. When the hair is 80% dry, you can use it with the attachment to design your hair style according to your own preferences.
5. Finally, blow dry from the root to the end, from the inside to the outside of the end, and you will have beautiful and shiny hair!

6. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning the Filter

The Llano hair dryer features an auto-clean function to maintain optimal performance. This function reverses the motor to blow out dust and debris from the filter.

- To activate the auto-clean function, press and hold the speed and heat buttons simultaneously for 2 seconds while the dryer is on.
- For deeper cleaning, use the provided dusting brush to gently remove any stubborn lint or hair from the air inlet.

6.2 Storage

The hair dryer's foldable design allows for convenient storage.

- To fold, gently rotate the handle until it locks into the compact position.
- Store the hair dryer and its accessories in the provided storage bag to protect them from dust and damage.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

If you encounter any issues with your Llano High Speed Ionic Hair Dryer, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Hair dryer does not turn on.	No power supply; ALCI plug tripped; damaged cord/plug.	Check power outlet. Reset ALCI plug (press the reset button). Inspect cord and plug for damage. If damaged, do not use and contact customer support.
Weak airflow.	Air inlet/filter blocked by dust or hair.	Activate auto-clean function. Clean the air inlet with the provided dusting brush.
Unusual noise or vibration.	Internal obstruction or motor issue.	Turn off and unplug the dryer. Check for any visible obstructions. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
Hair dryer overheats and shuts off.	Overuse; blocked air vents; internal thermal protection activated.	Unplug the dryer and allow it to cool down for at least 10-15 minutes. Clean the air inlet/filter. Ensure proper ventilation during use.




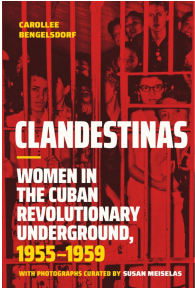
