INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Bonavita Enthusiast 8-Cup Drip Coffee Brewer. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and care of your coffee machine. Please read all instructions carefully before first use and retain this manual for future reference.

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and/or injury to persons, including the following:

- Read all instructions.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against fire, electric shock, and injury to persons, do not immerse cord, plugs, or appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions, or has been damaged in any manner. Return appliance to the nearest authorized service facility for examination, repair, or adjustment.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may result in fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.

- Scalding may occur if the lid is removed during the brewing cycle.
- This appliance is for household use only.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Bonavita Enthusiast coffee brewer is designed to deliver optimal coffee extraction. Familiarize yourself with its components:

- **Removable Water Tank:** For easy filling and cleaning. Features clear fill lines.
- **Filter Basket:** Holds the coffee grounds and filter.
- **Showerhead:** Designed for even water distribution over coffee grounds.
- **Thermal Carafe:** Double-walled stainless steel carafe to keep coffee hot.
- **Control Panel:** Features Power, Brew, Bloom, and Descal buttons.
- **Pause & Serve Mechanism:** Allows for pouring a cup during brewing.

SETUP AND FIRST USE

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all packaging materials and components.
2. **Clean Components:** Wash the thermal carafe, filter basket, and removable water tank with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry.
3. **Position:** Place the brewer on a flat, stable, heat-resistant surface.
4. **Initial Rinse Cycle:**
 - Fill the removable water tank with fresh water up to the 8-cup mark.
 - Place an empty paper filter (cone-shaped, size #4 recommended) into the filter basket.
 - Ensure the filter basket is properly secured in its position.
 - Place the thermal carafe with its lid securely under the filter basket. Ensure the carafe lid's protrusion engages the pause & serve mechanism.

- Press the Power button, then press the Brew button to start a cycle with only water.
- Discard the water after the cycle is complete. This cleans the internal components and removes any manufacturing residues.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Brewing Coffee

1. **Prepare Water:** Remove the water tank and fill it with fresh, cold water to your desired level (up to 8 cups). Reattach the tank securely.
2. **Prepare Filter and Grounds:**
 - Place a paper filter (cone-shaped, size #4) into the filter basket.
 - Add your desired amount of medium-ground coffee. A general guideline is 10 grams of coffee per cup (e.g., 80 grams for 8 cups). Adjust to taste.
 - Secure the filter basket in its designated slot.
3. **Position Carafe:** Place the thermal carafe with its lid securely under the filter basket. Ensure the carafe lid's protrusion engages the pause & serve mechanism.
4. **Select Brew Mode:**
 - Press the **Power** button.
 - For a standard brew, press the **Brew** button.
 - For enhanced flavor extraction (pre-infusion), press the **Bloom** button. This mode pre-wets the coffee grounds before brewing.
5. **Brewing Cycle:** The brewer will begin the cycle. The optimal brewing temperature is maintained between 194°F–205°F (90°C–96°C).
6. **Serving:** Once brewing is complete, the brewer will beep. Carefully remove the carafe and serve. The thermal carafe will keep coffee hot for several hours.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Daily Cleaning

- Always unplug the brewer before cleaning.
- Wash the thermal carafe, filter basket, and removable water tank with warm, soapy water after each use. Rinse thoroughly.
- Wipe the exterior of the brewer with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads.
- Do not immerse the main unit in water or any other liquid.

Descaling

Mineral deposits (scale) from water can build up in your brewer over time, affecting performance and coffee taste. Descale your brewer regularly, depending on water hardness and frequency of use (e.g., every 1-3 months).

1. **Prepare Descaling Solution:** Mix a descaling solution (e.g., white vinegar and water in a 1:2 ratio, or a commercial descaling agent) according to the product's instructions.
2. **Fill Water Tank:** Pour the descaling solution into the removable water tank up to the 8-cup mark.
3. **Start Descal Cycle:** Place the empty thermal carafe with its lid under the filter basket. Press the **Power** button, then press the **Descal** button.
4. **Rinse Cycles:** After the descaling cycle is complete, discard the solution. Run two full cycles with fresh, clean water to thoroughly rinse the brewer.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Brewer does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outage.	Ensure the brewer is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check circuit breaker.
Coffee is not brewing.	Water tank empty; carafe not properly seated; filter basket not secured.	Fill water tank. Ensure carafe lid engages the pause & serve mechanism. Secure filter basket.
Coffee overflows from filter basket.	Too much coffee grounds; coffee ground too fine; carafe not properly seated.	Reduce coffee grounds. Use medium grind. Ensure carafe lid engages the pause & serve mechanism.
Coffee tastes weak or bitter.	Incorrect coffee-to-water ratio; water temperature issues; brewer needs descaling.	Adjust coffee amount. Descal the brewer. Ensure fresh, cold water is used.
Water leaks from the unit.	Water tank not seated correctly; internal component issue.	Ensure the removable water tank is fully and correctly seated. If problem persists, contact customer support.
