1. INTRODUCTION

- SmartKey Technology for easy re-keying and advanced break-in protection.
- Easy installation requiring only a screwdriver, supported by the BILT App for 3D video and voice guidance.

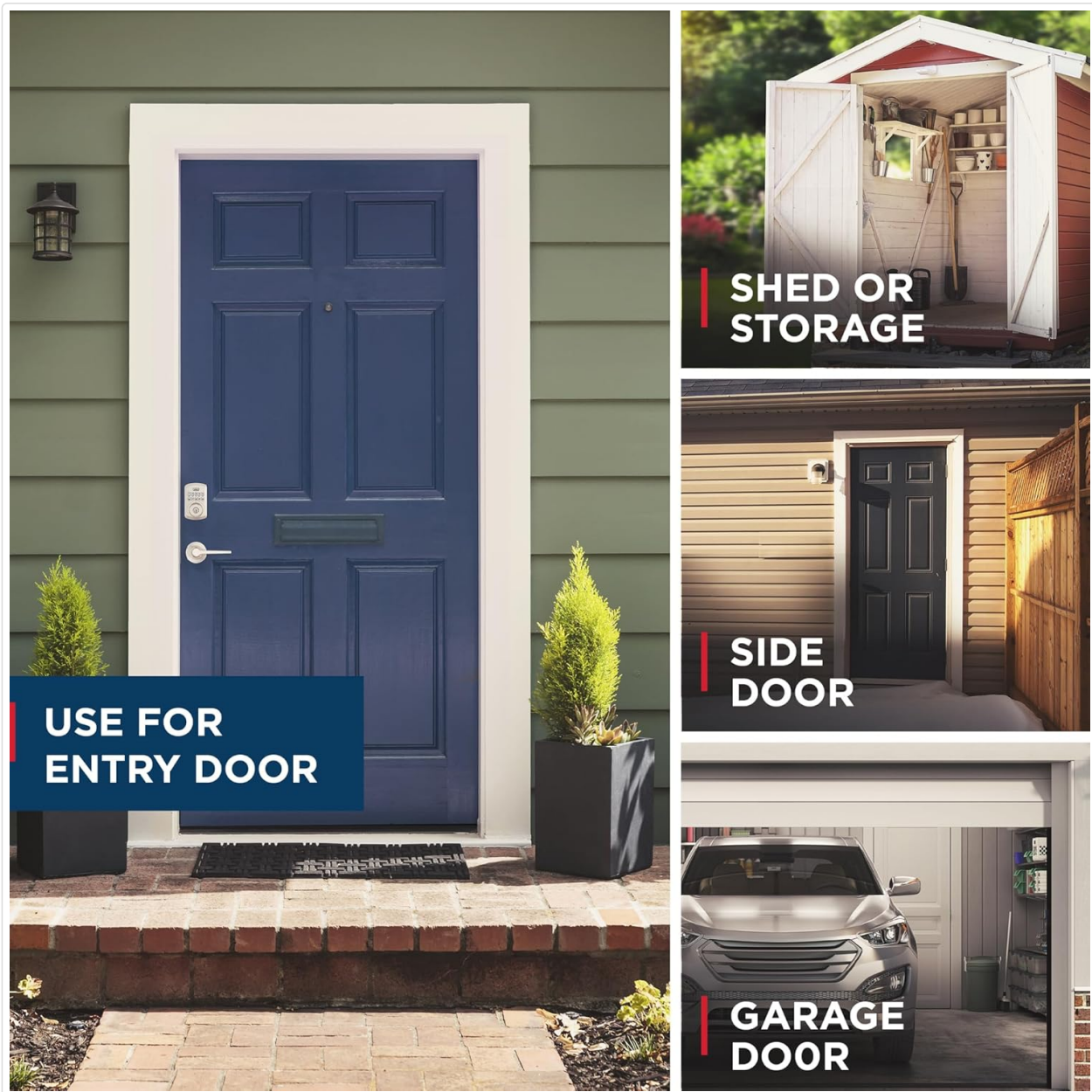


Figure 2.2: Versatile Applications of Powerbolt 3

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Weiser Powerbolt 3 is designed for simple installation, requiring only a screwdriver. For detailed, step-by-step 3D video and voice-guided instructions, it is highly recommended to use the BILT App.

4.1 Door Preparation

Ensure your door meets the following specifications:

- **Cross Bore Hole Diameter:** 1-1/2 inches or 2-1/8 inches
- **Door Thickness:** 1-3/8 inches to 1-3/4 inches standard
- **Adjustable Latch Backset:** 2-3/8 inches to 2-3/4 inches

4.2 Installation Steps (General Overview)

1. Install the latch into the door edge.
2. Install the exterior keypad assembly.
3. Install the mounting plate.
4. Install the interior assembly.
5. Install the strike plate on the door frame.
6. Insert 4 AA batteries (not included) into the interior assembly.
7. Perform the door handing process to calibrate the lock to your door.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Keyless Entry

To unlock the door using the keypad:

1. Enter your 4-8 digit user code.
2. The deadbolt will retract, and the door can be opened.

5.2 One-Touch Motorized Locking

To lock the door from the exterior, simply press the Lock button (the 'Weiser' button) on the keypad. The deadbolt will extend automatically. From the interior, turn the thumb-turn to lock the door.

5.3 Low Light Code Entry

The keypad features bright LED lights that illuminate the buttons, making it easy to enter your user code at night or in low-light conditions. Simply tap the keypad to activate the lights.

The Powerbolt 3 allows for easy management of access codes. You can program up to 25 unique user codes for regular access and 5 one-time user codes for temporary access.

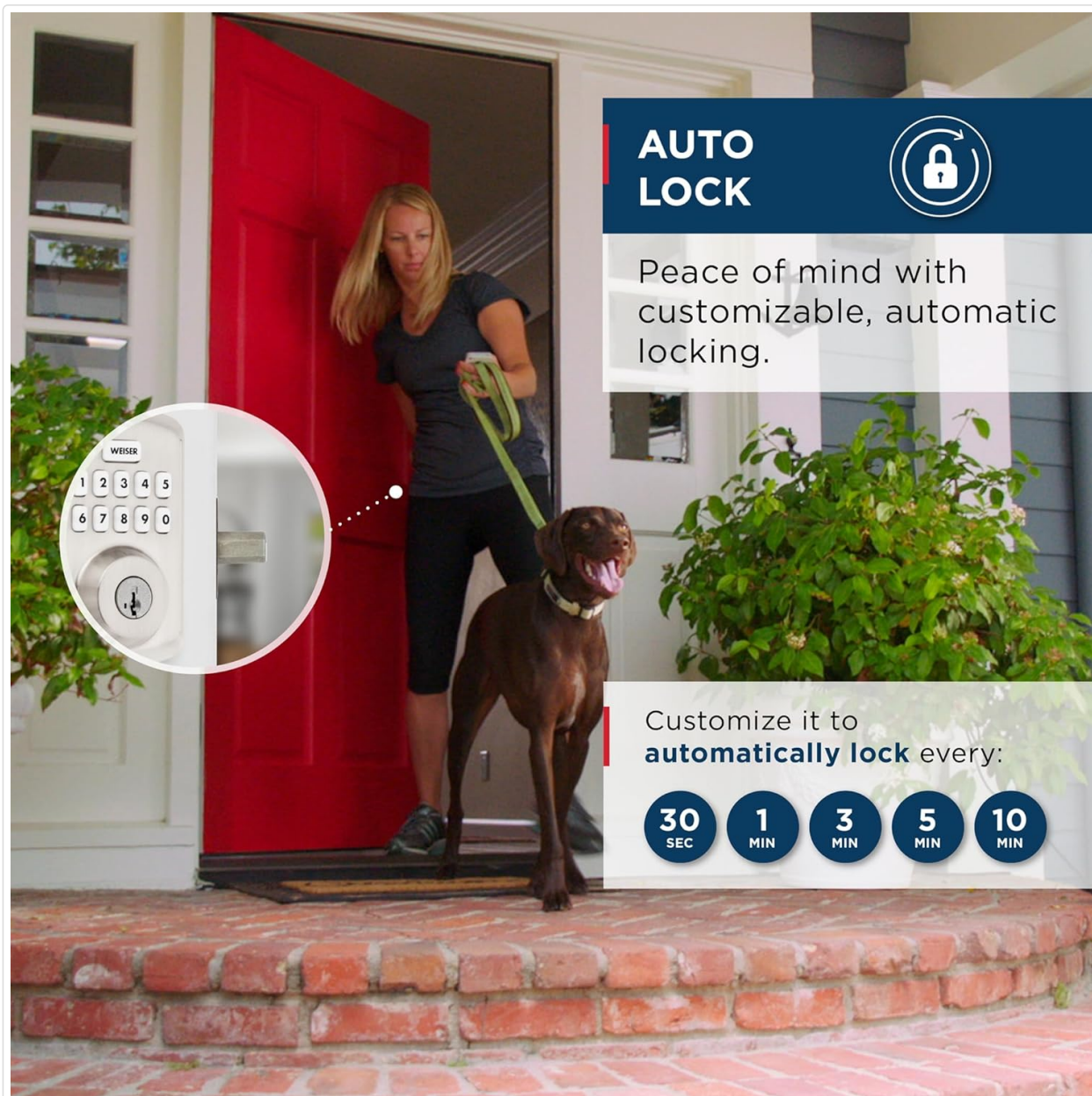


Figure 6.1: Easy Code Management

7.3 SmartKey Technology

Weiser's SmartKey Security™ provides advanced protection against common break-in techniques and allows you to re-key your lock yourself in seconds. This means you can easily re-key the lock to any Kwikset (KW1) key, making lost or unreturned keys obsolete.

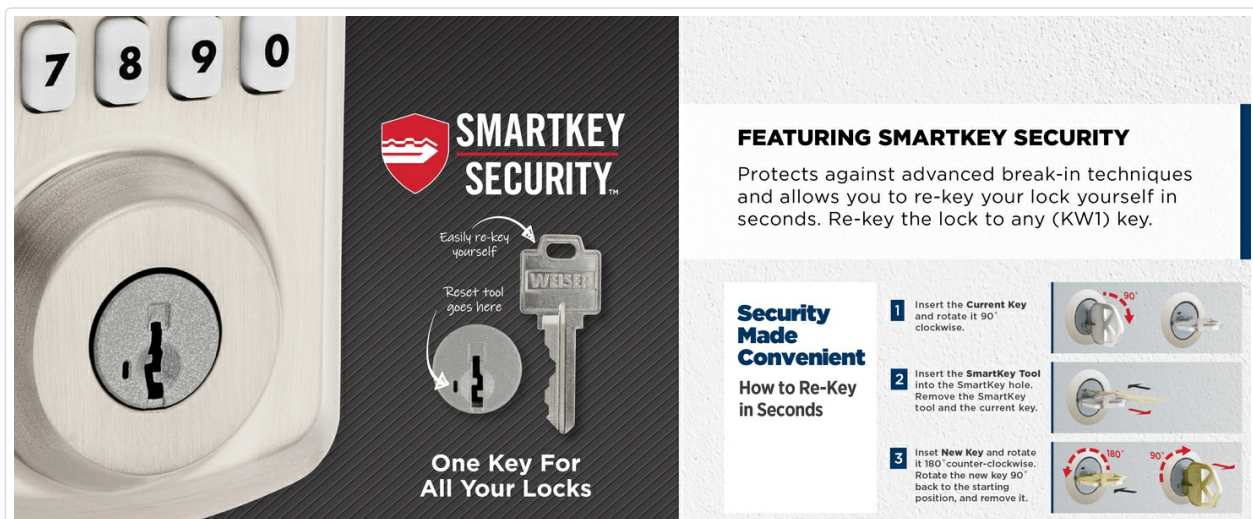


Figure 7.4: How to Re-Key in Seconds

7.4 Intrusion Alert

If three consecutive incorrect user code attempts are made, the lock will sound an alarm and disable the keypad for 1 minute to prevent tampering. This feature enhances security by deterring unauthorized access attempts.

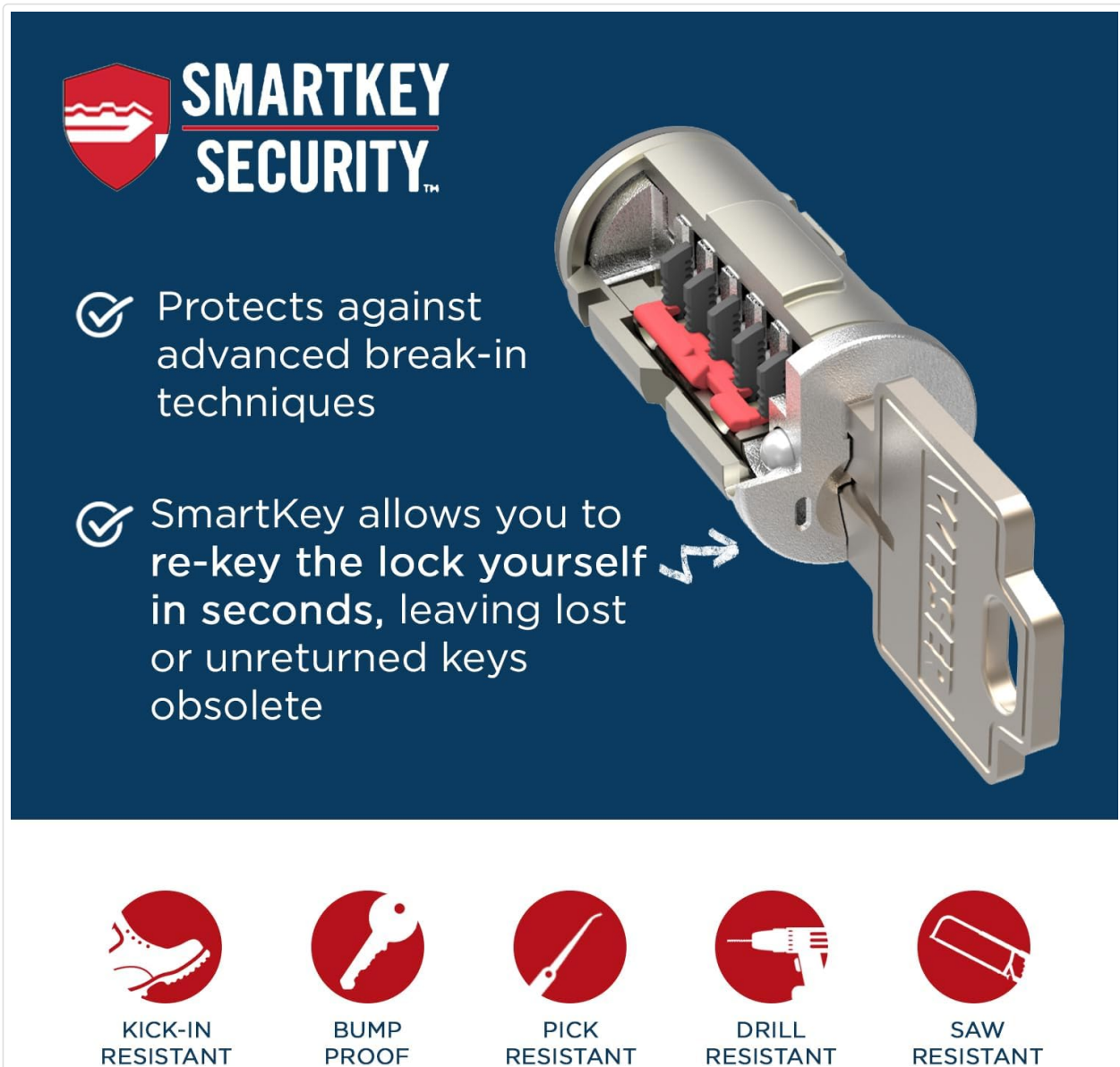


Figure 7.5: Intrusion Alert System

8. MAINTENANCE

The Weiser Powerbolt 3 is designed for low maintenance. The lock operates on 4 AA alkaline batteries (not included) and provides approximately 12 months of battery life under normal usage. When batteries are low, the lock will provide an audible and visual indicator. Replace all four batteries simultaneously when prompted.

To clean the lock, use a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents, as they may damage the finish.

9. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Weiser Powerbolt 3, please refer to the following common troubleshooting tips:

- **Lock not responding:** Check battery levels and replace if necessary. Ensure the battery pack is correctly seated.
- **Keypad not lighting up:** Tap the keypad to activate the backlight. If it still doesn't light up, check batteries.
- **Lock not locking/unlocking:** Ensure the door is properly closed and aligned with the strike plate. Re-perform the door handing process if the lock was recently installed or if the door alignment has changed.
- **User code not working:** Verify the user code is correct. Ensure the lock is not in Vacation Mode or disabled due to multiple incorrect entries (Intrusion Alert).
- **Lock beeps continuously:** This may indicate low battery. Replace batteries immediately.




