INTRODUCTION

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always ensure the appliance is placed on a stable, level surface.
- Do not operate the unit if the power cord is damaged.
- Keep the appliance away from water or other liquids to prevent electric shock.
- Regularly check the water storage tank and empty it in a timely manner to prevent overflow.
- After using the towel warmer, disconnect the power supply.
- Perform simple cleaning as instructed in the maintenance section.
- Keep the door slightly open after use to allow for ventilation and drying.
- This appliance is CE certified for safety.

PRODUCT COMPONENTS

The Winado 8L Hot Towel Warmer Cabinet is designed for durability and ease of use. Key components include:

- **High-Quality ABS Outer Shell:** Provides a sturdy and protective exterior.
- **Aluminum Inner Liner:** Ensures rust resistance and enhanced thermal conductivity for efficient heating.
- **Stainless Steel Rack:** A durable internal rack for holding towels, designed for easy cleaning and removal.
- **Removable Drip Tray:** Located at the bottom to collect any condensation or water, preventing spills.
- **Independent ON/OFF Switches:** Separate controls for power and UV sanitization (if applicable to your model).
- **Ergonomic Handle:** For easy opening and closing of the cabinet door.

SETUP

The Winado 8L Hot Towel Warmer Cabinet requires minimal setup:

1. Unpack the towel warmer and remove all packaging materials.
2. Place the unit on a stable, heat-resistant, and level surface. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the unit.

3. Insert the stainless steel rack into the cabinet.
4. Ensure the removable drip tray is correctly positioned at the bottom of the unit.
5. Plug the 110V power cord into a suitable electrical outlet. The unit is now ready for operation. No assembly is required.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to effectively warm your towels:

1. **Prepare Towels:** Soak towels in cold water.
2. **Wring Out Excess Water:** Thoroughly wring out towels to prevent excessive dampness and dripping inside the warmer.
3. **Roll and Place:** Roll up the prepared towels and place them neatly onto the stainless steel rack inside the cabinet. The 8L capacity can accommodate approximately 10-15 regular-sized face towels, depending on their thickness.
4. **Close Door:** Gently close the cabinet door.
5. **Power On:** Press the ON/OFF button, typically located on the upper right corner of the unit. The indicator light will illuminate.
6. **Heating:** The towels will begin to heat. The unit is designed to warm towels within approximately 20 minutes without complicated temperature adjustments.
7. **Remove Towels:** Use tongs or heat-resistant gloves to safely remove warm towels.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and hygiene of your towel warmer:

- **Daily Cleaning:** After each use, turn off and unplug the unit. Allow it to cool completely.
- **Empty Drip Tray:** Regularly remove and empty the drip tray to prevent water accumulation and potential odors. Wash the tray with mild soap and water, then dry thoroughly.
- **Clean Interior:** Wipe the interior surfaces and the stainless steel rack with a damp cloth. For stubborn stains, use a mild, non-abrasive cleaner. Ensure all surfaces are dry before closing the door or storing.
- **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive pads.
- **Ventilation:** Keep the door slightly ajar when not in use to allow for air circulation and prevent moisture buildup.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Winado Hot Towel Warmer, please refer to the following common solutions:

- **Unit Not Heating:**

- Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet.
- Check if the ON/OFF switch is in the 'ON' position and the indicator light is illuminated.
- Verify that the power outlet itself is functional by plugging in another appliance.

- **Towels Not Warm Enough:**

- Allow sufficient time (up to 20 minutes) for the unit to reach optimal temperature.
- Ensure the cabinet door is fully closed during operation.
- Avoid overfilling the cabinet; ensure towels are not packed too tightly to allow for proper heat circulation.

- **Unusual Odor:**

- A new appliance may emit a slight odor during initial use; this should dissipate.
- Ensure towels are clean and free of detergents or fabric softeners that might produce odors when heated.
- Clean the interior and drip tray thoroughly as per the maintenance instructions.

- **Excessive Moisture/Dripping:**

- Ensure towels are properly wrung out before placing them in the warmer.
- Regularly empty the drip tray.
