

Replacement Remote Control for Alpine Car Stereo Receivers

User Manual: Replacement Wireless Remote Control

For Alpine TDM-7544, UTE-72BT, UTE-62BT, IXA-W407BT, CDE-101EM, CDE-101E, CDE-101R, CDE-101RM, CDE-102BT, CDE-102RI Car Stereo Receiver Systems

1. INTRODUCTION

This document provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your new replacement wireless remote control. This remote is designed as a direct infrared replacement for specific Alpine car stereo receiver systems. Please ensure your original remote or car stereo model is listed as compatible before use.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The replacement remote control offers a convenient way to manage your Alpine car stereo system from a distance. It features an ergonomic design and standard button layout for intuitive control.

2.1 Key Features

- Direct infrared replacement for compatible Alpine car stereo models.
- No setup or programming required; ready to use after battery installation.
- Ergonomic design for comfortable handling.
- Standard button layout for common audio functions.

2.2 Remote Control Layout

3. SETUP

3.1 Battery Installation

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the remote control.
2. Slide the battery compartment cover downwards or in the direction indicated by an arrow to open it. Refer to **Figure 2** for visual guidance.
3. Insert two (2) AAA batteries, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align correctly with the markings inside the compartment.
4. Replace the battery compartment cover by sliding it back into place until it clicks securely. Refer to **Figure 3** for visual guidance.

Note: This remote control does not require any programming or code setup. It is an infrared replacement designed to work immediately with compatible Alpine car stereo systems once batteries are installed.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Point the remote control directly at the infrared receiver on your Alpine car stereo system. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the stereo.

4.1 Basic Functions

Button	Function
POWER	Turns the car stereo system on or off.
SOURCE	Cycles through available audio sources (e.g., Radio, CD, USB, Bluetooth).
BAND	Changes radio bands (e.g., FM1, FM2, AM).

Button	Function
VOLUME ▼ / ▲	Decreases (▼) or increases (▲) the audio volume.
◀◀ (Previous Track/Tune Down)	Skips to the previous track/file or tunes down radio frequency.
▶▶ (Next Track/Tune Up)	Skips to the next track/file or tunes up radio frequency.
▶ / ■ ■ (Play/Pause)	Plays or pauses the current audio playback.
A.PROC.	Activates or cycles through audio processing modes (e.g., Bass Engine, EQ presets). Refer to your car stereo's manual for specific functions.
MUTE	Mutes or unmutes the audio output.

Note: Specific button functionalities may vary slightly depending on your Alpine car stereo model. Refer to your car stereo's original user manual for detailed information on its remote control functions.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning

To clean the remote control, gently wipe it with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or chemical sprays, as these can damage the surface or internal components.

5.2 Battery Replacement

Replace the batteries when the remote control's response becomes sluggish or stops working. Always replace both AAA batteries at the same time with new ones. Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries.

5.3 Storage

Store the remote control in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity. If the remote will not be used for an extended period, it is recommended to remove the batteries to prevent leakage.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
Remote control is not working.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Batteries: Check if batteries are inserted correctly with correct polarity (+/-). Replace old or dead batteries with new AAA batteries. ◦ Line of Sight: Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the car stereo's infrared receiver. Point the remote directly at the stereo. ◦ Compatibility: Verify that your car stereo model is listed as compatible with this replacement remote. This remote is designed for specific Alpine models. If your model is not listed, it may not be compatible.
Buttons are unresponsive or sticky.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Dirt/Debris: Clean the remote control surface. ◦ Battery Level: Low batteries can cause inconsistent performance. Replace batteries.

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
Remote works intermittently.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Battery Connection: Ensure batteries are seated firmly in the compartment. ◦ Interference: Minimize strong light sources (e.g., direct sunlight) that might interfere with the infrared signal. ◦ Distance: Ensure you are within the effective operating range of the remote.

Important: This remote is a direct replacement. If your original remote looked different, or your car stereo model is not explicitly listed as compatible, this replacement remote may not function correctly. Always compare the appearance of this remote with your original remote before purchase and use.
