1. INTRODUCTION

3. SETUP

3.1 Battery Installation

3.2 Initial Pairing (for Wi-Fi Connectivity)

If the remote control will not be used for an extended period, remove the batteries to prevent leakage and potential damage to the device.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your remote control, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Remote is unresponsive.	Dead or incorrectly installed batteries.	Replace batteries with new ones, ensuring correct polarity.
Remote does not control the TV.	Not paired correctly (for Wi-Fi models) or line of sight obstructed (for IR functions).	Re-pair the remote control with the TV. Ensure no objects block the signal path.
Some buttons do not work.	Button stuck or internal fault.	Gently press the button multiple times. If the issue persists, consider replacing the remote.
