IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all instructions carefully before using the Wavytalk 1 Inch Ceramic Curling Wand. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Burn Hazard:** The curling wand heats up to high temperatures. Always use the included heat-resistant glove and avoid direct contact with the hot barrel.
- Do not use near water or while bathing/showering.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Unplug the appliance immediately after use and before cleaning.
- Do not operate with a damaged cord or plug.
- Do not wrap the power cord around the appliance.
- Ensure the appliance is completely cool before storing.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Wavytalk 1 Inch Ceramic Curling Wand is designed for creating classic, bouncy curls and waves. Its advanced features ensure efficient and safe styling.

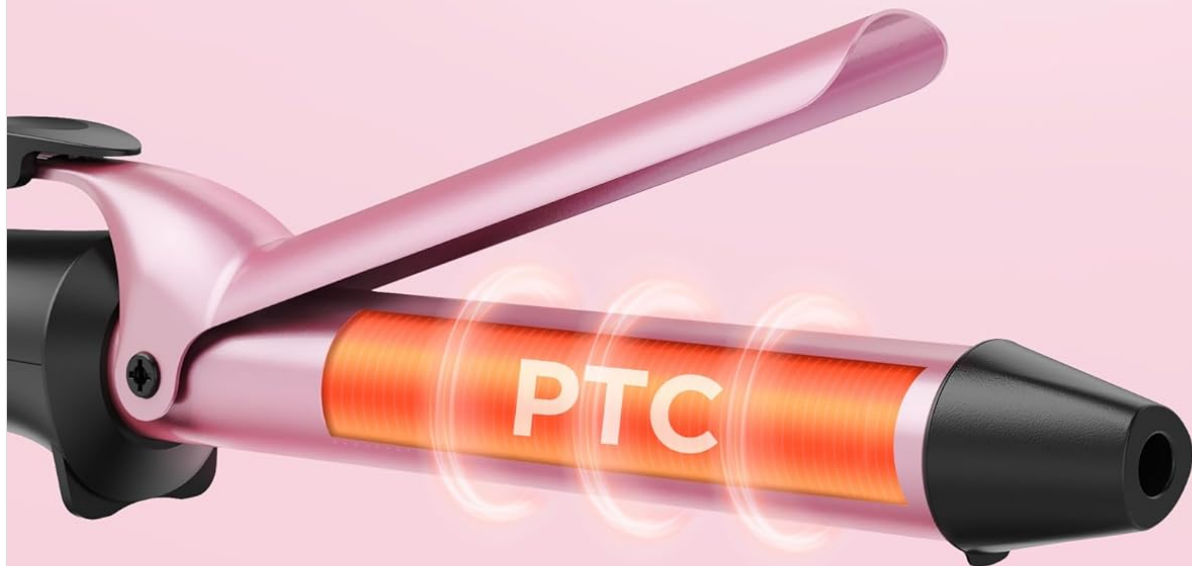
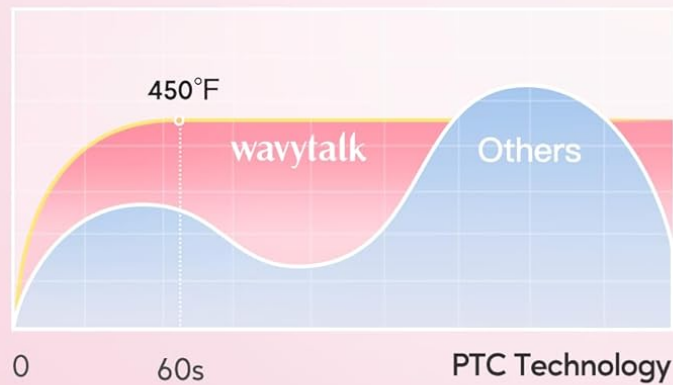


Image: The Wavytalk 1 Inch Ceramic Curling Wand, showcasing its rose pink barrel and black handle with control buttons.

SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the curling wand and all accessories from the packaging.
2. **Inspect:** Check the appliance for any visible damage. Do not use if damaged.
3. **Placement:** Place the curling wand on a heat-resistant surface, away from flammable materials.
4. **Plug In:** Insert the power plug into a suitable electrical outlet (120-240 V AC).

Suitable for all hair types

Range from 300°F to 450°F

420°F-450°F

for thick or wavy hair

360°F-390°F

for normal textured hair

300°F-330°F

for delicate colored hair

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power On/Off and Temperature Adjustment:

1. **Power On:** Press and hold the power button until the digital display illuminates.
2. **Set Temperature:** Use the '+' and '-' buttons to select your desired temperature between 300°F and 450°F. The display will show the current temperature as it heats up.
3. **Heat-up Time:** The wand will reach 390°F in approximately 60 seconds. Wait until the desired temperature is stable before use.
4. **Power Off:** Press and hold the power button until the display turns off.

Curling Your Hair:

1. Ensure your hair is clean, dry, and detangled.
2. Wear the included heat-resistant glove on the hand you will use to guide your hair.
3. Section your hair into manageable strands.
4. Open the clamp and place a section of hair between the clamp and the barrel, starting a few inches from the root.
5. Close the clamp and slowly rotate the wand to wrap the hair around the barrel, moving towards the tip.
Alternatively, for a wand-style curl, wrap the hair around the barrel without using the clamp, holding the ends with the gloved hand.
6. Hold for 5-8 seconds (adjust based on hair type and desired curl intensity).

7. Release the clamp and gently slide the wand out of the curl.
8. Allow curls to cool completely before styling or brushing to set the style.

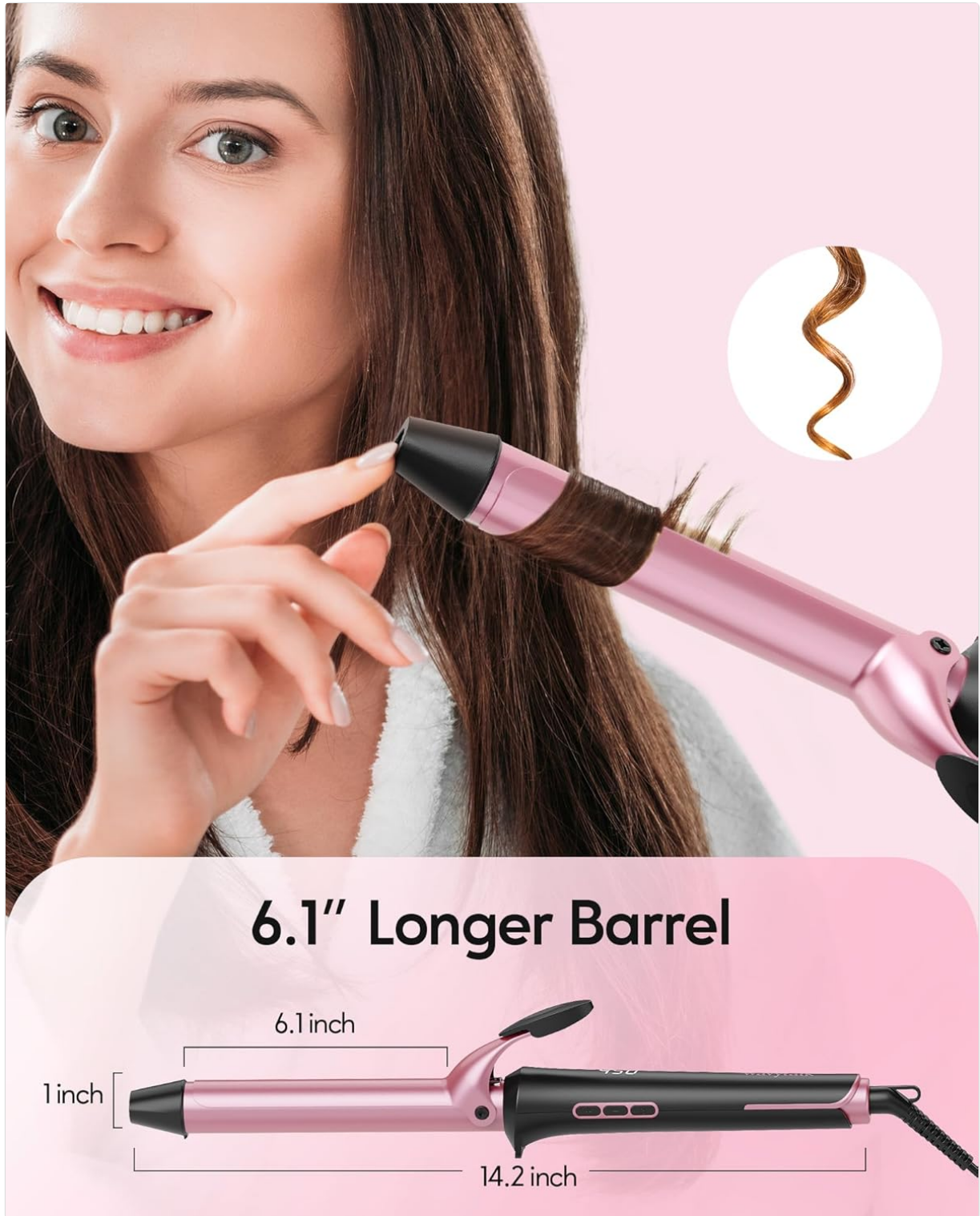


Image: A woman demonstrating the use of the Wavytalk curling wand to create curls.

Recommended Temperature Settings:

Hair Type	Temperature Range
Delicate/Colored Hair	300°F - 330°F
Normal Textured Hair	360°F - 390°F
Thick/Wavy Hair	420°F - 450°F

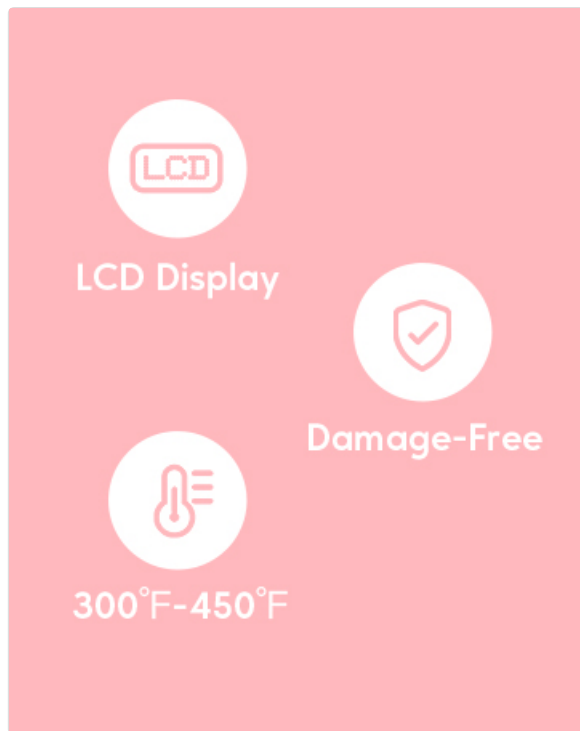


Image: Visual guide for recommended temperature settings based on hair type.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Ensure the appliance is unplugged and completely cool before cleaning. Wipe the barrel and handle with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse in water.
- **Storage:** Store the curling wand in a cool, dry place. Do not wrap the cord tightly around the appliance, as this can cause damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not turn on.	Not plugged in correctly, power outlet issue.	Ensure the plug is fully inserted. Test the outlet with another appliance.
Not heating up.	Power button not held long enough, internal fault.	Press and hold the power button until the display shows temperature. If issue persists, contact customer support.
Curls do not hold.	Incorrect temperature setting, hair not fully dry, not holding long enough.	Increase temperature for thicker hair. Ensure hair is completely dry. Hold hair on the barrel for a longer duration. Allow curls to cool before disturbing.
