SETUP

1. Charging the Speaker

Before first use, fully charge the speaker. Connect the provided USB-C charging cable to the speaker's DC 5V port and the other end to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer USB port. The charging indicator light will show charging status and turn off when fully charged. A full charge provides approximately 4 hours of playtime.

2. Powering On/Off

Press and hold the power button (usually marked with a circle or power symbol) for a few seconds to turn the speaker ON or OFF. A sound prompt will indicate the power status.

3. Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the speaker is powered ON and in Bluetooth pairing mode. A blue LED light will flash rapidly, indicating it's ready to pair.
2. On your device (smartphone, tablet, etc.), go to the Bluetooth settings.
3. Search for "The Voice Legend" in the list of available devices.
4. Select "The Voice Legend" to connect. Once connected, the blue LED light will stop flashing and remain solid, and you will hear a confirmation sound.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Music Playback (Bluetooth Mode)

- Once paired, open your music app on your device and start playing.
- Use the + and - buttons on the speaker to adjust volume. *Press and hold for volume control.*
- Short press the + button to skip to the next track.
- Short press the - button to go to the previous track.
- Press the Play/Pause button (often marked with a play/pause symbol) to pause or resume playback.

2. FM Radio Mode

- Press the Mode button (often marked "M") to switch to FM Radio mode.
- The speaker will automatically scan and save available radio stations.
- Use the + and - buttons to navigate between saved stations.
- For better reception, try repositioning the speaker.

3. USB / Micro SD Playback

- Insert a USB drive or Micro SD card (with pre-loaded MP3 audio files) into the respective slot.
- The speaker will automatically detect the media and begin playback.
- Use the playback controls (volume, next/previous track, play/pause) as in Bluetooth mode.

4. Hands-Free Calling

- When a call comes in while connected via Bluetooth, the music will pause.
- Press the Play/Pause button to answer an incoming call.
- Press the Play/Pause button again to end the call.
- Press and hold the Play/Pause button to reject an incoming call.

5. LED Light Control

The speaker features a dynamic LED light show. Press the dedicated light button (if available, or refer to specific button functions in the included manual) to cycle through different light modes or turn the lights off. There are typically 4 different color modes.

6. True Wireless Stereo (TWS) Pairing

To achieve a true stereo sound experience, you can pair two The Voice Legend speakers together:

- Ensure both speakers are powered ON and not connected to any Bluetooth device.
- On one speaker (this will be your primary speaker), press and hold the TWS pairing button (refer to the included manual for exact button location, often a dedicated button or a long press on a multi-function button).
- The primary speaker will search for the secondary speaker. Once connected, you will hear a confirmation sound.
- Now, connect your device to the primary speaker via Bluetooth as described in the "Bluetooth Pairing" section. Audio will play in stereo through both speakers.

MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning:** Wipe the speaker with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Storage:** Store the speaker in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the speaker regularly, even if not in use for extended periods.
- Water Resistance:** While waterproof, avoid submerging the speaker in water for prolonged periods. Ensure charging ports are dry before charging.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Speaker does not turn ON.	Low battery.	Charge the speaker fully.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cannot pair with Bluetooth device.	Speaker not in pairing mode; device Bluetooth off; too far from speaker.	Ensure speaker is flashing blue LED. Turn device Bluetooth off/on. Move device closer (within 30 ft).
No sound or distorted sound.	Volume too low; speaker not connected; audio source issue.	Increase speaker and device volume. Re-pair Bluetooth. Check audio source.
FM Radio static/poor reception.	Weak signal.	Reposition the speaker to find a stronger signal.
Cannot play from USB/Micro SD.	Incorrect file format; card/drive not inserted correctly.	Ensure files are MP3. Reinsert card/drive.
