INTRODUCTION

The seat also offers 15 headrest positions, 9 recline positions, and an easy-to-remove, machine-washable cover made from naturally flame-retardant fabric.

· Child Weight and Height Limits:

- Rear-Facing: 5-50 lbs, up to 49 inches.
- Forward-Facing (5-point harness): 22-65 lbs, up to 49 inches.
- Booster Mode: 40-120 lbs, 44-63 inches.
- Vehicle Compatibility: Always check your vehicle owner's manual for car seat installation guidelines and compatible seating positions.
- Harness Adjustment: Ensure the harness straps are snug against your child's body, with no slack. The chest clip should be at armpit level.
- Recline Angle: Use the easy-read level indicators to ensure the correct recline angle for your child's age and car seat mode.
- Accident Replacement: Car seats should be replaced after a moderate to severe crash, even if there is no visible damage. Consult Britax for specific guidelines.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Britax One4Life car seat features ClickTight installation for secure and straightforward setup.

General Installation Steps (ClickTight):

- 1. **Open the Seat:** Locate the ClickTight release button (often red) and press it to open the car seat's front panel, revealing the belt path.
- 2. **Route the Seat Belt:** Thread the vehicle's lap and shoulder belt through the designated belt path. Ensure the belt is not twisted.
- 3. Buckle the Seat Belt: Connect the vehicle's seat belt buckle.
- 4. Remove Slack: Pull firmly on the shoulder belt to remove all slack from the lap portion of the belt.
- 5. **Close the Seat:** Press the car seat's front panel down firmly until it clicks into place. This action automatically tensions and locks the seat belt.
- 6. **Check for Movement:** Grasp the car seat at the belt path and attempt to move it side-to-side and front-to-back. It should not move more than one inch.

Mode-Specific Installation:

• Rear-Facing Mode (Infant/Toddler):

For infants and toddlers within the specified weight and height limits. Ensure the recline angle indicator is within the appropriate range for rear-facing use. The car seat should be installed using the vehicle's seat belt with ClickTight, or LATCH connectors if preferred and within weight limits. Always use the tether in rear-facing mode if your vehicle allows for rear-facing tethering.

• Forward-Facing Mode (5-Point Harness):

For children who meet the minimum weight and height requirements for forward-facing. Install using the vehicle's seat belt with ClickTight. Always attach and tighten the top tether strap to the vehicle's designated tether anchor point. The top tether significantly reduces head excursion in a crash.

Booster Mode (High-Back):

For older children who have outgrown the 5-point harness but are not yet tall enough for the vehicle's seat belt alone. The 5-point harness is removed for this mode. The child is secured using the vehicle's lap and shoulder belt, routed through the car seat's belt guides. The car seat itself may or may not be secured with LATCH in booster mode, depending on the vehicle and specific instructions.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Harness and Headrest Adjustment:

The One4Life features a no-rethread harness and 15-position headrest that adjust simultaneously. To adjust, locate the harness adjustment handle (typically at the top of the headrest or behind the seat) and squeeze it while sliding the headrest up or down. Ensure the harness straps are at or just below the child's shoulders for rear-facing, and at or just above the child's shoulders for forward-facing.

Recline Adjustment:

The car seat offers 9 recline positions. To adjust, locate the recline handle (usually at the front or side of the base) and squeeze it while tilting the seat to the desired position. Always refer to the recline indicator to ensure the angle is appropriate for the car seat mode and your child's age/weight.

Cup Holders:

The car seat includes two removable cup holders. These can be easily detached for cleaning or if space is limited in the vehicle.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Cover:

The Britax One4Life car seat features an easy-to-remove, machine-washable cover. Refer to the care label on the fabric for specific washing instructions. Generally, machine wash with cold water on a delicate cycle with mild detergent. Tumble dry on low heat or hang to dry. Do not use bleach.

Cleaning the Harness and Buckle:

Wipe the harness straps with a damp cloth. Do not machine wash or submerge harness straps in water, as this can weaken the webbing. For the buckle, flush it with warm water if it becomes sticky or has debris. Do not use soaps or lubricants.

Cleaning the Shell:

Wipe the plastic and metal parts of the car seat shell with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

TROUBLESHOOTING

• Car Seat is Loose After Installation:

Ensure the ClickTight panel is fully closed and clicked into place. Re-route the vehicle seat belt, ensuring all slack is removed before closing the panel. Check your vehicle's seat belt locking mechanism (ALR or ELR) and ensure it is engaged. For LATCH installation, ensure connectors are fully engaged and the strap is tightened.

• Harness is Difficult to Tighten/Loosen:

Check for any twists in the harness straps behind the car seat. Ensure the harness adjuster strap is not caught on any part of the car seat shell. If the buckle is sticky, follow the cleaning instructions for the buckle.

· Child's Head Slumps in Rear-Facing:

Verify the recline angle using the level indicator. For newborns and infants, a more reclined position is necessary to prevent head slump and maintain an open airway. Adjust the recline as needed within the allowed range.

• Cannot Adjust Headrest/Harness:

Ensure the harness adjustment handle is fully squeezed. Check for any obstructions or debris that might be preventing smooth movement. If the issue persists, consult the full user manual or Britax customer support.
