1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Logitech MK955 Signature Slim Wireless Keyboard and Mouse Combo provides a versatile and efficient input solution for multiple devices. This combo includes the K950 Signature Slim Keyboard and the M750L Signature Plus Mouse, designed for comfortable and quiet operation across various operating systems.

2. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Battery Installation

The keyboard and mouse are battery-powered. Ensure batteries are correctly installed before first use. The Logi Bolt USB receiver is typically found inside the mouse's battery compartment or within the product packaging.

2.2 Connecting Your Devices

The MK955 combo offers two primary connection methods: Bluetooth and the Logi Bolt USB receiver.

1. Using the Logi Bolt USB Receiver:

- · Locate the Logi Bolt USB receiver.
- Plug the receiver into an available USB port on your computer.
- Turn on the keyboard and mouse. They should automatically connect to the receiver.

2. Using Bluetooth:

- Turn on the keyboard and mouse.
- On the keyboard, press and hold one of the Easy-Switch keys (1, 2, or 3) until the LED indicator blinks rapidly, indicating pairing mode.
- On your computer or device, navigate to Bluetooth settings and select "Logitech K950" or "Logitech M750L" from the list of available devices to pair.
- Repeat for the other device if necessary.

2.3 Installing Logi Options+ App

For enhanced customization and productivity features, download and install the Logi Options+ App from the official Logitech website. This application allows you to personalize keys, buttons, and shortcuts for both the keyboard and mouse.



3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Multi-Device Switching

The K950 keyboard and M750L mouse can be paired with up to three different devices. Use the Easy-Switch buttons (1, 2, 3) on the keyboard and the corresponding button on the mouse to seamlessly switch between connected computers, tablets, or smartphones.




Image: A user efficiently working across a desktop computer and a laptop using the Logitech MK955 combo, demonstrating multi-device capability.

3.2 Keyboard Features

- **Quiet Typing:** The keyboard is designed for a quiet typing experience, minimizing noise in shared workspaces.
- **Customizable Keys:** Utilize the Logi Options+ App to assign custom functions and shortcuts to various keys.
- **Multi-OS Layout:** The keyboard supports Mac, Windows, and Chrome OS layouts, with dedicated keys for each.
- Tilt Legs: Adjust the keyboard angle for ergonomic comfort using the integrated tilt legs (+4°).




Image: A close-up of hands typing on the Logitech K950 keyboard, highlighting its slim profile and quiet keys.

3.3 Mouse Features

- Silent Clicking: The M750L mouse features SilentTouch technology for significantly reduced click noise.
- SmartWheel: The scroll wheel allows for precise line-by-line scrolling or rapid, free-spinning scrolling for long documents.
- Contoured Shape: Designed for larger hands, the ergonomic shape provides comfortable use over extended periods.
- Customizable Buttons: Program side buttons and other controls using the Logi Options+ App.




Image: A hand operating the Logitech M750L mouse, focusing on the SmartWheel and ergonomic design.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Battery Life and Replacement

The K950 keyboard offers up to 36 months of battery life, while the M750L mouse provides up to 24 months, depending on usage. When batteries are low, replace them with new AAA batteries for the keyboard and AA batteries for the mouse (check device for specific battery type if different from included).

4.2 Cleaning Instructions

- Disconnect the devices from your computer before cleaning.
- Use a soft, lint-free cloth lightly dampened with water or an approved electronics cleaner.
- Avoid harsh chemicals, abrasive materials, or excessive moisture.
- For the keyboard, use compressed air to remove debris from between keys.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

5.1 Connectivity Issues

- No Connection: Ensure batteries are charged and correctly installed. Verify the Logi Bolt USB receiver
 is securely plugged in, or that Bluetooth is enabled on your device and the keyboard/mouse are in pairing
 mode.
- Intermittent Connection: Move the keyboard and mouse closer to the receiver or Bluetooth-enabled device. Avoid placing large metal objects between the devices and the receiver/computer.
- **Bluetooth Wake-up:** When connected via Bluetooth, the keyboard and mouse may not wake your computer from sleep. You might need to use your computer's power button or an existing wired input device to wake it.
- BIOS Access: Bluetooth connections typically do not function during system boot-up. If you need to access BIOS/UEFI settings, a wired keyboard is usually required. The Logi Bolt receiver may offer better compatibility for pre-OS functions.

5.2 Logi Options+ App Functionality

- Custom Keys Not Working: After waking your computer from sleep, custom key assignments from the Logi Options+ App may take a few moments to become active. If they remain unresponsive, try manually launching the Logi Options+ App.
- **App Not Detecting Devices:** Ensure the Logi Options+ App is up to date. Re-pair your devices if they are not detected by the software.
