# Carpuride Steering Wheel Control (SWC) Instruction Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Carpuride Steering Wheel Control (SWC) accessory. This device is designed to enhance your driving experience by providing convenient control over your compatible Carpuride 701Pro/901Pro system directly from your steering wheel. Please read this manual carefully before use to ensure proper installation and operation.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

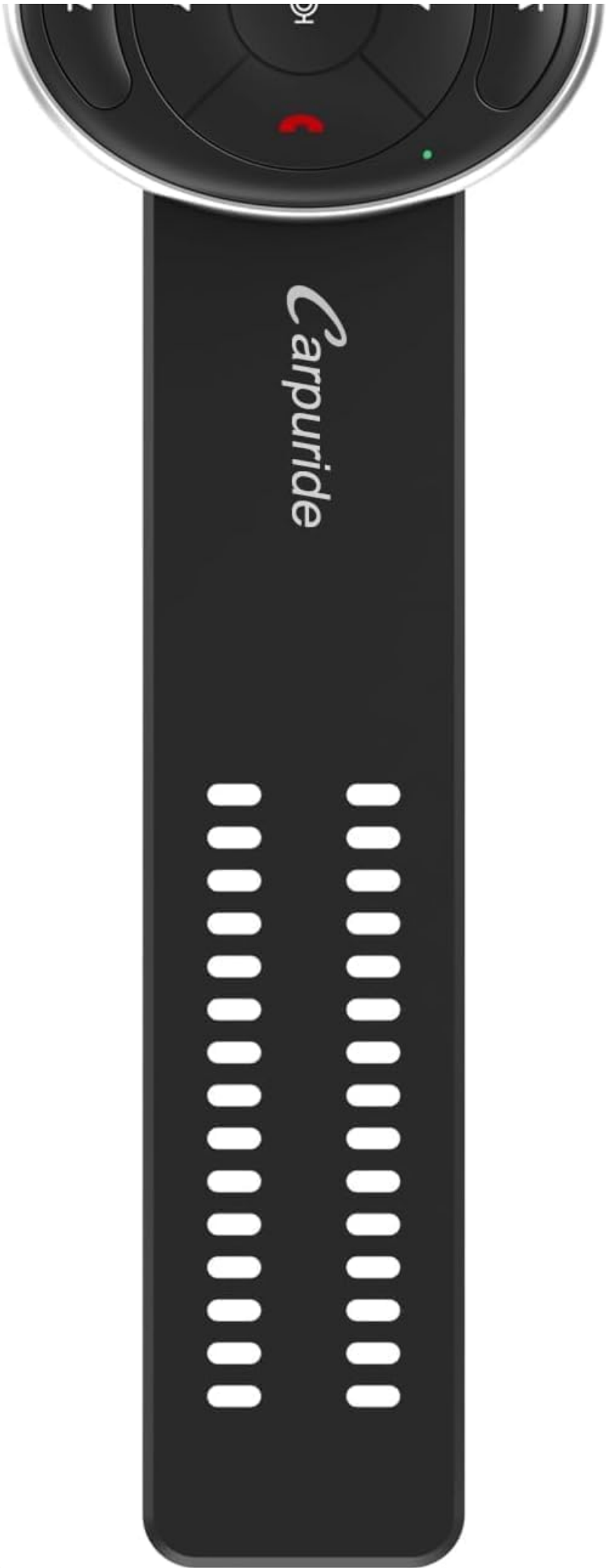
The Carpuride SWC is a compact, infrared-controlled device that allows you to manage various functions of your Carpuride display unit without taking your hands off the steering wheel. It features essential buttons for media control and call management.

## 3. SETUP

---

### 3.1 Attaching the SWC to Your Steering Wheel

1. Identify a suitable position on your steering wheel that allows for easy access to the SWC buttons without obstructing your grip or view of the dashboard.
2. Thread the attachment strap around the steering wheel at the chosen position.
3. Securely fasten the strap through the buckle or designated slots on the SWC unit. Ensure it is tight enough to prevent movement during driving but not so tight as to damage the steering wheel or the unit.
4. Verify that the SWC unit is stable and does not interfere with the safe operation of your vehicle.

### 3.2 Pairing with Carpuride 701Pro/901Pro

The Carpuride SWC uses infrared (IR) technology to communicate with your compatible Carpuride display unit. No complex pairing process is typically required beyond ensuring line-of-sight and proper function of the IR receiver on your main unit.




- Ensure your Carpuride 701Pro or 901Pro unit is powered on.
- Point the SWC unit towards the IR receiver on your Carpuride display. The effective range is up to 10 meters, but direct line-of-sight is crucial for optimal performance.
- Test the functionality by pressing various buttons (e.g., volume up/down, play/pause) to confirm communication.
- If the unit does not respond, refer to the Troubleshooting section.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

The Carpuride SWC provides intuitive control over your Carpuride system. The buttons are designed for quick and easy access to common functions.

Button Icon/Description	Function
▶ / ⋮ (Play/Pause)	Plays or pauses current media playback.
◀◀ (Previous Track)	Skips to the beginning of the current track or to the previous track.
▶▶ (Next Track)	Skips to the next track.
+ (Volume Up)	Increases the audio volume.
- (Volume Down)	Decreases the audio volume.

Button Icon/Description	Function
 (Green Phone Icon)	Answers an incoming call or initiates a call (if supported by the main unit).
 (Red Phone Icon)	Ends an active call or rejects an incoming call.
 (Microphone Icon)	Activates voice assistant or mute microphone (functionality depends on main unit).

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Carpuride SWC, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the unit with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Do not use harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or solvents.
- **Battery:** The unit is not rechargeable and likely uses a replaceable coin-cell battery. If the unit stops responding, replace the battery. Refer to the battery compartment for type and replacement instructions (typically on the back or side).
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the SWC in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Avoid Impact:** Protect the unit from drops and strong impacts, which can damage internal components or the IR emitter.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your Carpuride SWC, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
SWC does not respond to button presses.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ <b>Battery Depleted:</b> The battery may be low or dead. Replace the battery (refer to Maintenance section).</li> <li>◦ <b>No Line-of-Sight:</b> Ensure the SWC is pointed directly at the IR receiver on your Carpuride display unit. Obstructions can block the signal.</li> <li>◦ <b>Out of Range:</b> The maximum effective range is 10 meters. Ensure you are within this distance.</li> <li>◦ <b>Incorrect Main Unit:</b> Confirm your Carpuride display unit (701Pro/901Pro) is compatible with this SWC.</li> </ul>
Buttons respond intermittently.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ <b>Weak Battery:</b> Replace the battery.</li> <li>◦ <b>Partial Obstruction:</b> Ensure nothing is partially blocking the IR signal path.</li> <li>◦ <b>Interference:</b> While less common for IR, strong direct sunlight or other IR sources might cause minor interference.</li> </ul>
SWC is physically loose on the steering wheel.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ <b>Strap Not Tight:</b> Re-tighten the attachment strap securely around the steering wheel.</li> <li>◦ <b>Incorrect Mounting:</b> Ensure the strap is correctly threaded and fastened.</li> </ul>
