## 1. INTRODUCTION

## 2. KEY FEATURES

## 3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

---

For detailed installation instructions, please refer to the separate Installation Guide provided with your appliance. Proper installation is crucial for optimal performance and safety. Ensure the dishwasher is level and securely connected to water and power supplies.

Before first use, remove all packing materials and internal accessories. It is recommended to run an empty cycle with dishwasher detergent to clean the interior.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 4.1. Loading the Dishwasher

Proper loading ensures effective cleaning and drying. Arrange dishes to allow water spray to reach all surfaces. Avoid overcrowding.

- **Lower Rack:** Ideal for plates, bowls, pots, and pans. Ensure larger items do not block the spray arms.
- **Upper Rack:** Suitable for glasses, cups, and smaller bowls. The upper rack is adjustable to accommodate taller items.
- **Cutlery Basket:** Place forks and spoons with handles down, and knives with handles up for safety.

## 4.2. Adding Detergent and Rinse Aid

Use only automatic dishwasher detergent. Fill the main wash dispenser according to the detergent manufacturer's recommendations and the soil level of your dishes. Fill the rinse aid dispenser to the indicated level; it will automatically dispense during the rinse cycle to improve drying and prevent water spots.

## 4.3. Selecting a Cycle and Options

The control panel is located on the top edge of the door. Select your desired wash cycle and any additional options before closing the door and pressing Start.

- **Cycles:** Auto, Heavy, Normal, Turbo, Machine Clean.
- **Options:** Flex Zone, High Temp, Extra Dry, Night Dry, Delay Start.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

### 5.1. Cleaning the Interior

Regularly clean the interior of your dishwasher to prevent odors and maintain performance. Wipe down the stainless steel tub and door gasket with a damp cloth. For stubborn stains, use a dishwasher cleaner.

### 5.2. Filter Maintenance

The dishwasher features a filter system that should be cleaned periodically. Remove the lower rack, twist and remove the filter assembly, rinse it under running water to remove food particles, and then reassemble.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your dishwasher, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Dishes not clean:** Ensure proper loading, check detergent levels, clean filters, and verify water temperature.
- **Water not draining:** Check for clogs in the drain hose or filter.
- **Dishwasher not starting:** Ensure the door is fully closed and latched, check power supply, and verify that a cycle has been selected.
- **Excessive noise:** Ensure dishes are not interfering with spray arms, and check for foreign objects in the pump area.
- **Error codes:** Consult the full owner's manual for specific error code meanings and solutions.
