Instruction Manual

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This manual provides instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Yaheetech Nightstand with Charging Station. Please read these instructions carefully before assembly and use to ensure proper function and longevity of your product.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure all components are present and undamaged before assembly. Do not use if any parts are missing or broken.
- Assemble on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
- Do not overtighten screws during assembly to avoid damaging the material.
- Keep small parts away from children during assembly.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacities for the tabletop, drawer, and shelf.
- Only use the charging station with compatible devices and within specified electrical ratings.
- Keep liquids away from the charging station to prevent electrical hazards.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please verify that all parts listed below are included in your package:

- Nightstand components (MDF boards, solid rubberwood legs)
- Drawer components
- Integrated charging station (2 AC outlets, 2 USB ports, 1 switch)
- 6.5-foot power cord with hook & loop strap

- Assembly hardware (screws, dowels, etc.)
- Assembly tools (if provided)
- Instruction manual

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly is required for this product. Follow the included illustrated instructions carefully. It is recommended to have two people for assembly.

General Assembly Steps:

1. **Unpack and Identify Parts:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Lay them out on a clean, soft surface. Compare all parts and hardware against the provided parts list in the separate assembly guide to ensure nothing is missing.
2. **Assemble the Frame:** Attach the legs to the side panels and then connect the top and bottom panels to form the main frame of the nightstand. Ensure all connections are secure but do not overtighten.
3. **Install the Drawer Slides:** Secure the drawer slides to the interior of the nightstand frame according to the instructions.
4. **Assemble the Drawer:** Construct the drawer box using the provided panels and hardware. Install the drawer knob.
5. **Insert the Drawer:** Carefully slide the assembled drawer into the installed drawer slides.
6. **Install the Charging Station:** Place the charging station into the designated cutout on the top surface of the nightstand. Ensure it is flush and secure.
7. **Connect Power Cord:** Route the power cord as desired, utilizing the included hook and loop strap for cable management.



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the Charging Station:

- 1. Plug In:** Connect the nightstand's 6.5-foot power cord to a standard 125V AC wall outlet.
- 2. Activate Power:** Flip the switch on the integrated charging station to the 'ON' position. An indicator light may illuminate.
- 3. Connect Devices:**
 - For AC powered devices, plug them into the two 125V/12A AC outlets.
 - For USB powered devices, plug them into the two 5V/2A USB ports.
- 4. Charging:** Your devices should now begin charging. Monitor device charging status as per device manufacturer guidelines.
- 5. Power Off:** When not in use, flip the switch on the charging station to the 'OFF' position to conserve energy and for safety.

Using the Drawer and Shelf:

- Drawer:** The drawer is suitable for storing small, private items. Do not overload the drawer; its maximum capacity is 4.4 lbs.
- Open Shelf:** The lower open shelf can be used to display decorative objects, store books, magazines, or other items. Do not exceed the shelf's maximum capacity of 22 lbs.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning:

- Wipe the nightstand surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- The nightstand features a water-resistant painting. Promptly wipe up any spills to prevent water damage.

General Care:

- Periodically check all screws and connections to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary.
- Avoid placing hot items directly on the surface. Use coasters or protective pads.
- Keep the nightstand away from direct sunlight and excessive humidity to prevent warping or fading.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Charging Station Issues:

- **No Power to Outlets/USB Ports:**
 - Ensure the nightstand's power cord is securely plugged into a functional wall outlet.
 - Check if the power switch on the charging station is in the 'ON' position.
 - Verify the wall outlet is receiving power by testing with another device.
 - If the charging station has a reset button (often combined with the power switch), try pressing it.
- **Slow Charging:**

- Ensure your device's charging cable is not damaged and is fully inserted.
- Some devices require specific charging protocols; the 5V/2A USB ports provide standard charging.
- Avoid charging too many high-power devices simultaneously if it causes a noticeable drop in performance.

Structural Issues:

- **Wobbly Nightstand:**

- Check all assembly screws and tighten any that are loose.
- Ensure the nightstand is placed on a level surface.

- **Drawer Sticks or Does Not Close Smoothly:**

- Ensure the drawer slides are properly aligned and free of obstructions.
- Check that the drawer is not overloaded.
- Verify the drawer was assembled correctly and is not warped.
