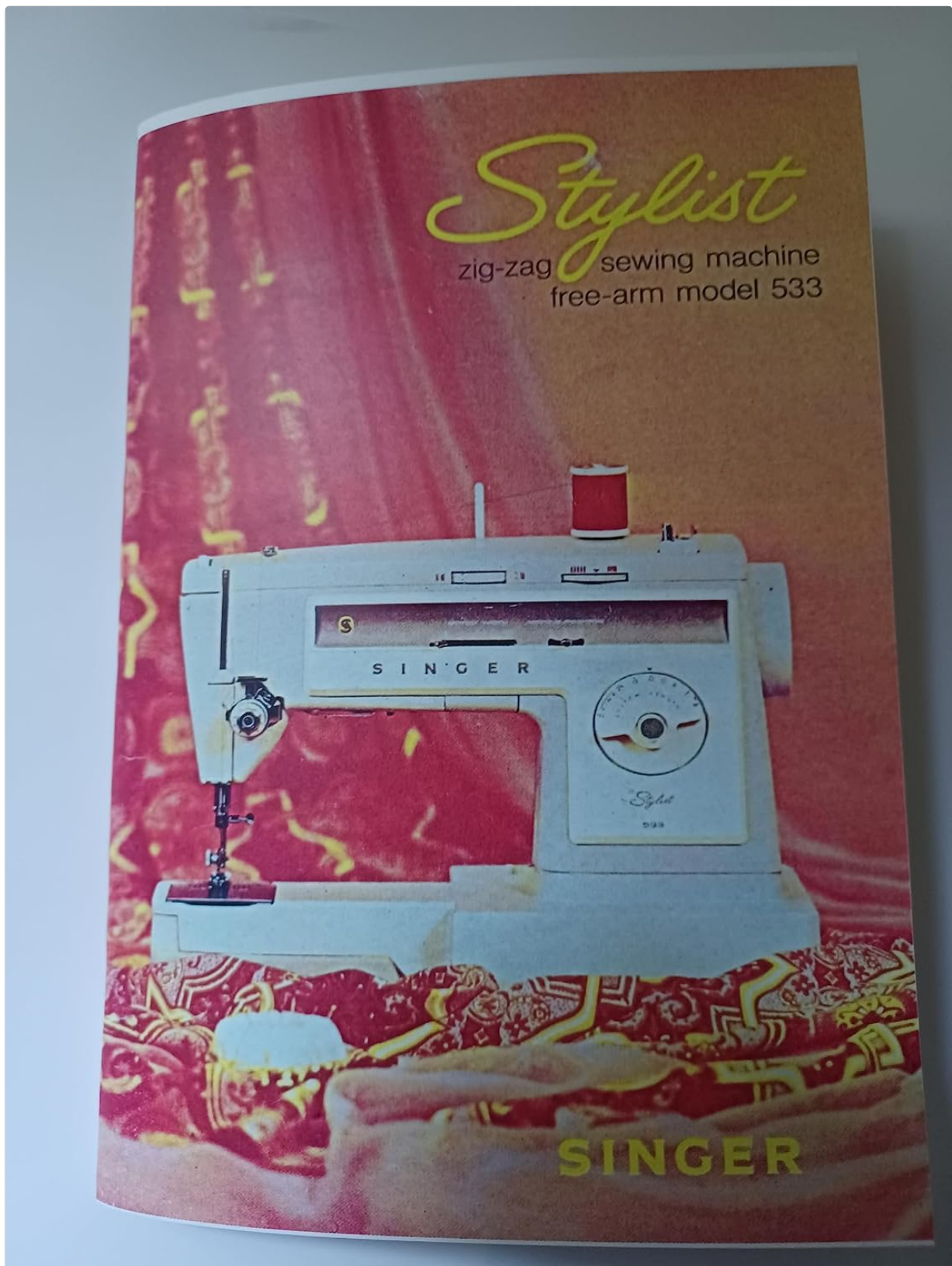

## GETTING STARTED AND SETUP

### Preliminary Steps

- **Ensuring Needle Integrity:** Always check that the needle is not bent or blunt. A damaged needle can cause skipped stitches and affect stitch quality.

## Threading Your Sewing Machine

Proper threading is crucial for consistent stitch formation. Follow these steps carefully:

1. Raise the hand wheel towards you to lift the needle to its highest position and raise the presser foot.
2. Place the spool of thread on the spool pin and guide the thread through all designated threading points.
3. Thread the needle from front to back, ensuring the thread passes through the eye of the needle smoothly.
4. For bobbin threading, turn the hand wheel towards you while holding the needle thread. This will bring up the bobbin thread.

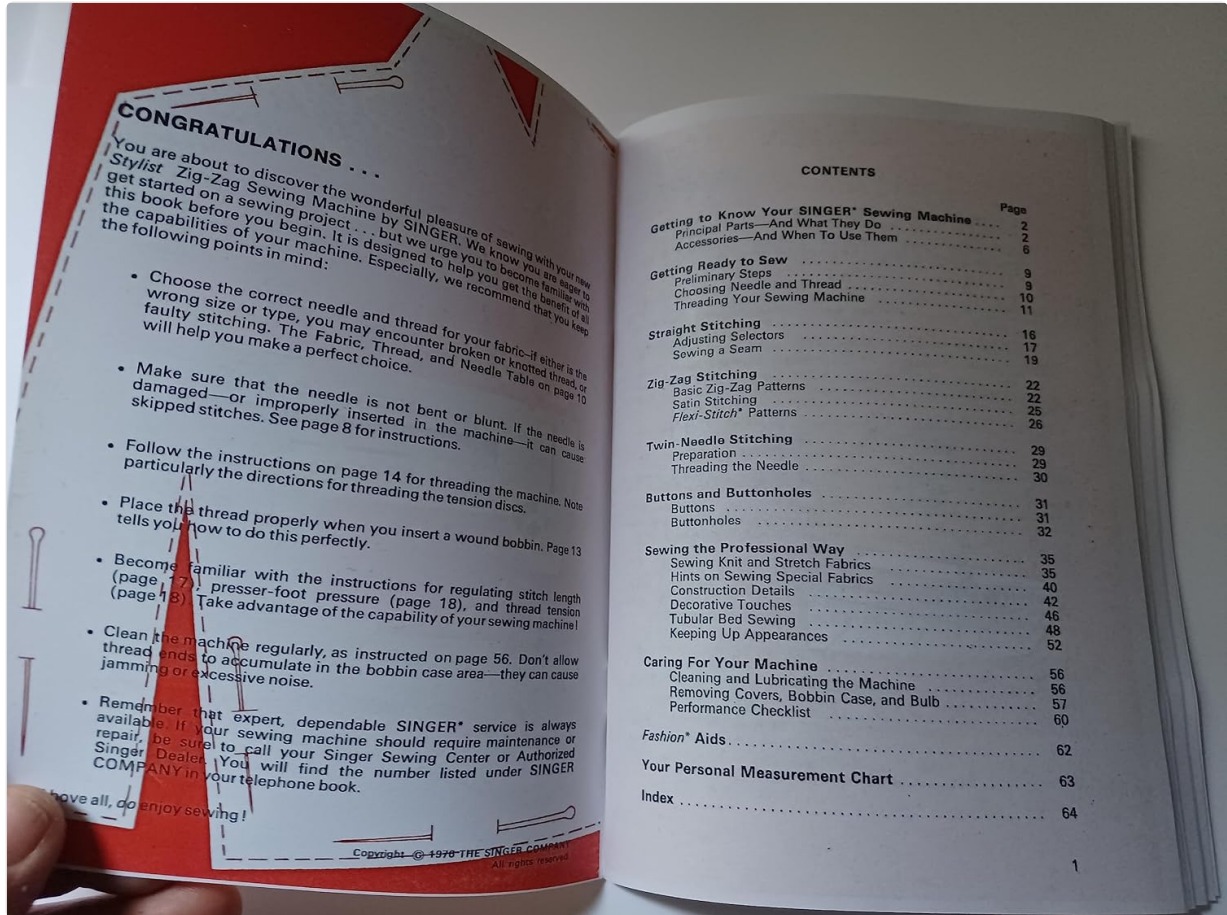


Image: A page from the manual illustrating various Flexi-Stitch patterns and providing instructions for adjusting stitch placement and needle-thread tension.

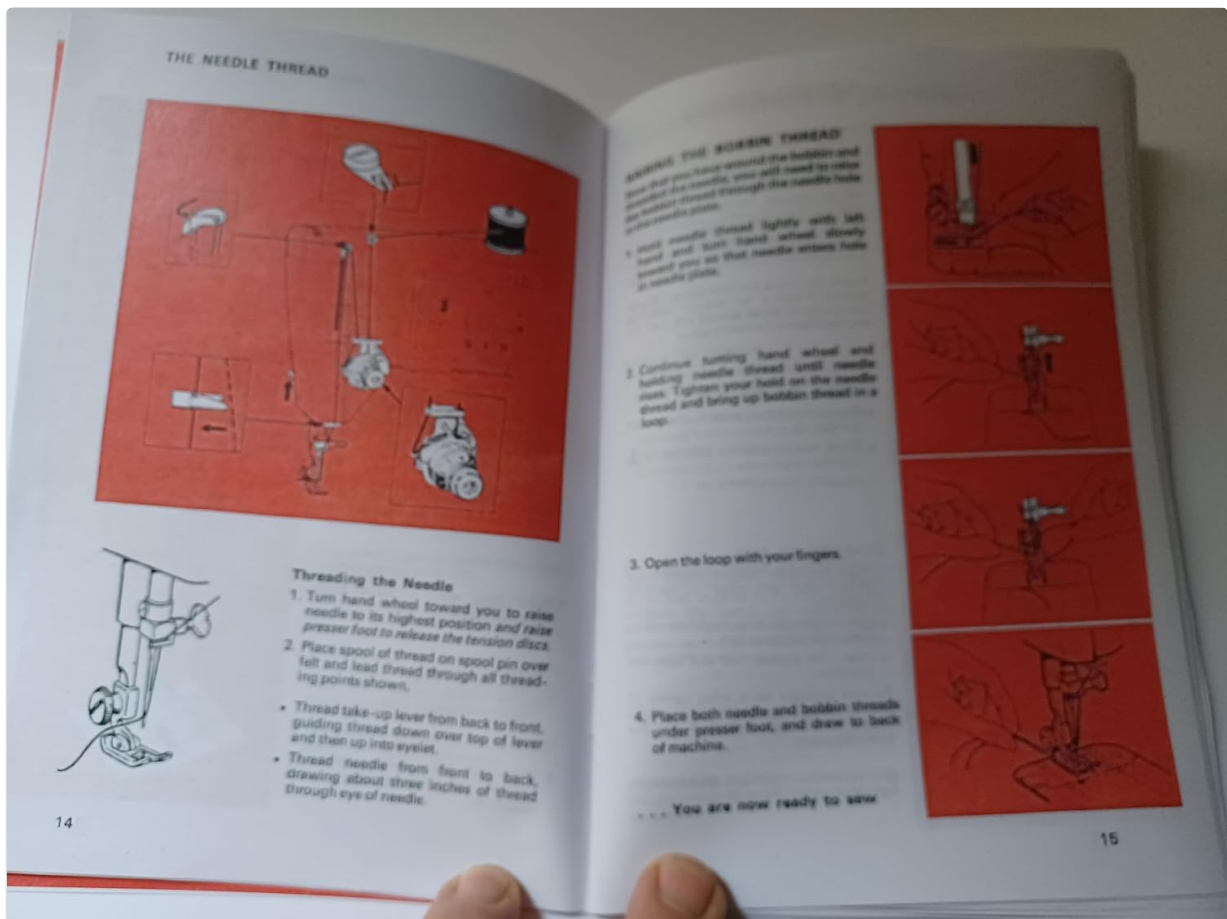


Image: A page from the manual showing diagrams and instructions for creating buttonholes, including marking, stitch width adjustment, and bar tacking.

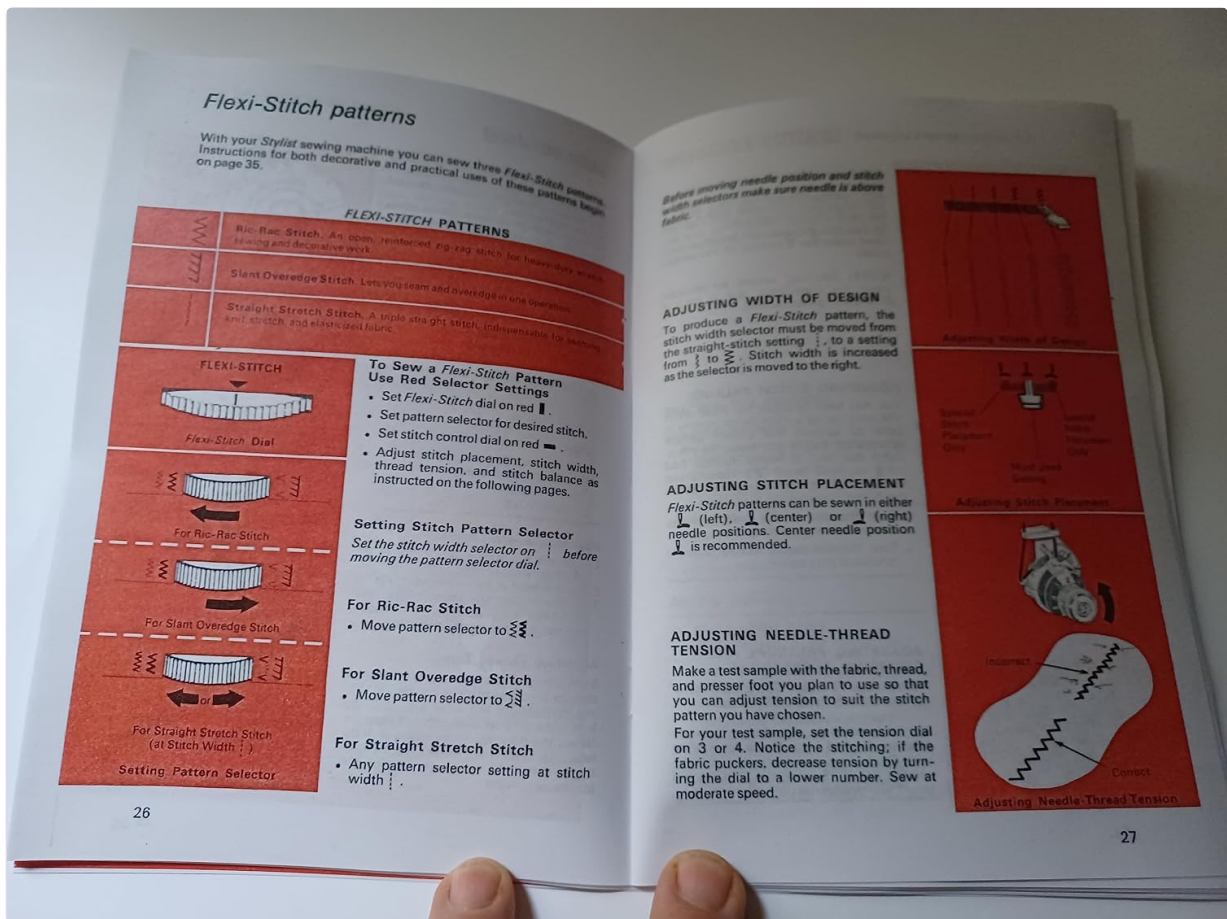


Image: A page from the manual illustrating the use of the tubular bed for sewing and examples of sewing projects like hats, bags, and dolls' clothes.

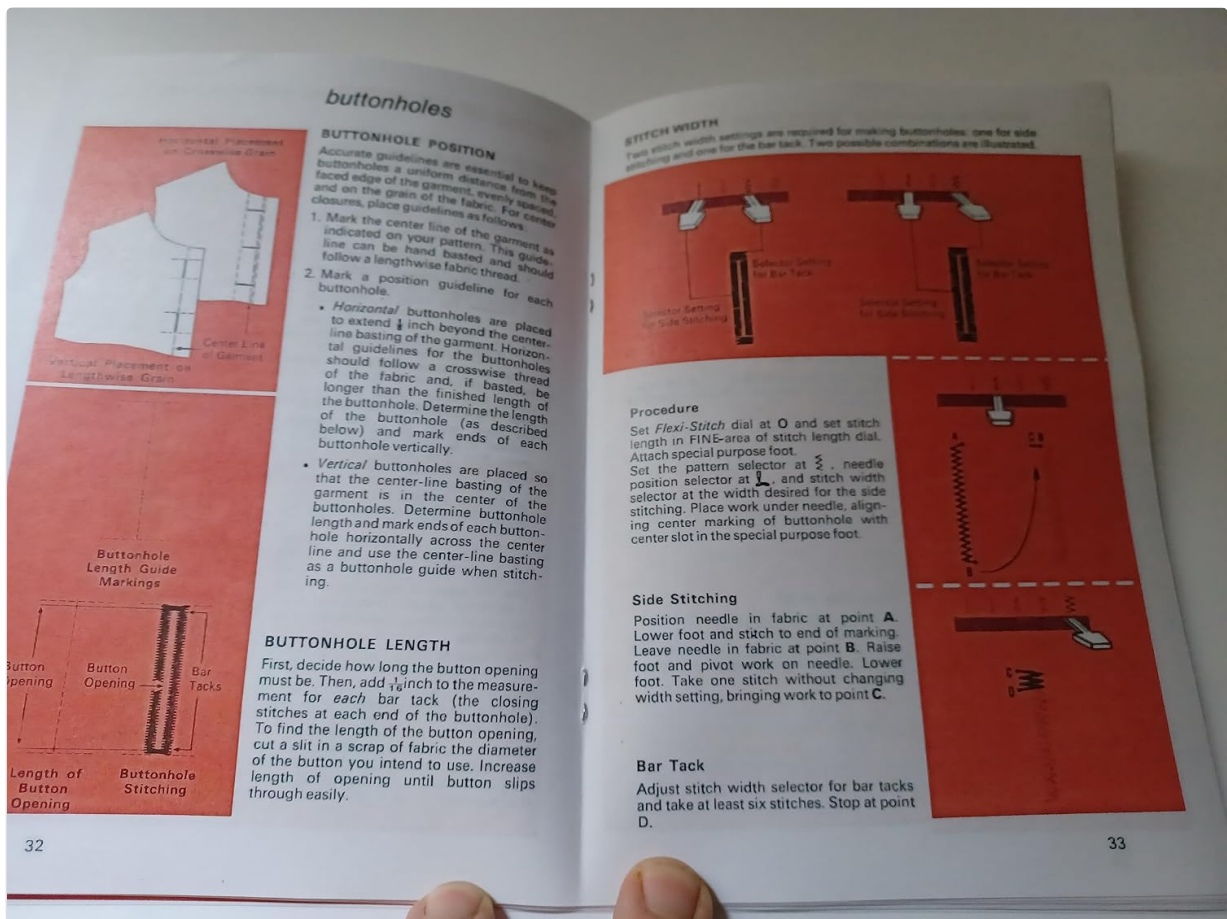
