INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for assembling, operating, and maintaining your Sluban Power Bricks-RC Mk4 Tank, model M38-B1022. This 937-piece building set combines the fun of construction with the excitement of remote control functionality. Please read this manual thoroughly before beginning assembly or operation to ensure proper use and enjoyment.

SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Not suitable for children under 3 years due to small parts which may present a choking hazard.

- Always supervise children during assembly and play.
- Keep small parts away from infants and young children.
- Do not ingest any parts.
- Dispose of packaging materials responsibly.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before starting assembly.

- 937 pieces of building blocks
- 1 x Battery Box (48L x 32W x 30.5H mm)
- 3 x Micro Motors (40L x 24W x 27.5H mm)
- 1 x Remote Control
- Full-color instruction manual

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the included full-color instruction manual step-by-step to assemble your Sluban Power Bricks-RC Mk4 Tank. Organize your blocks by color and shape to facilitate the building process.

1. Unpack all components and verify against the package contents list.
2. Refer to the detailed, full-color instruction booklet provided in the box.
3. Begin assembly by following the sequential steps outlined in the manual.
4. Ensure all connections are secure to prevent parts from detaching during play.
5. Pay close attention to the integration of the power system components (battery box and micro motors) as indicated in the instructions.

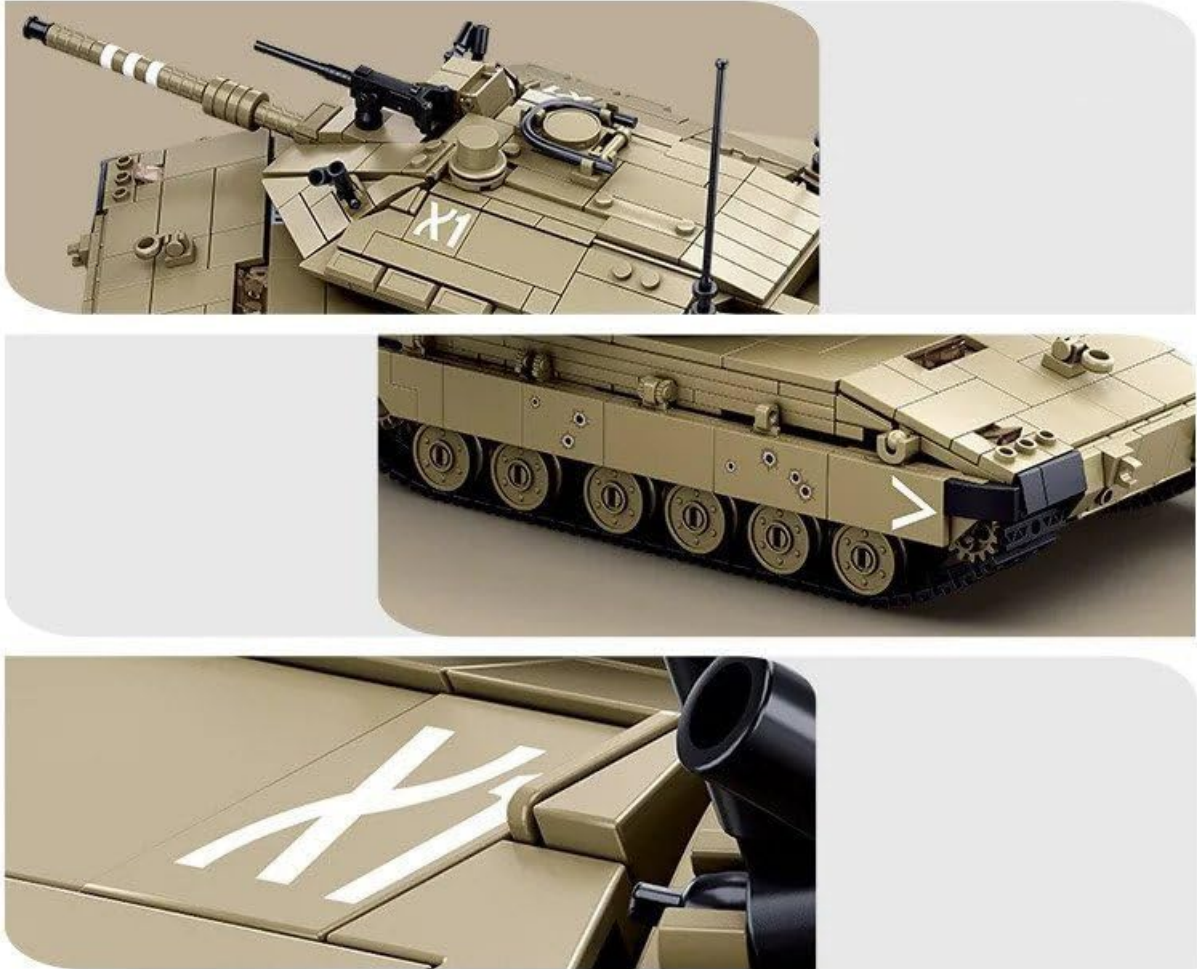


Image: Close-up views of the Sluban Power Bricks-RC Mk4 Tank, highlighting the intricate details of its construction and various sections.

BATTERY INSTALLATION

The Sluban Power Bricks-RC Mk4 Tank requires batteries for its remote control functions.

- **For the Battery Box:** Insert 2 x 1.5V "AAA" batteries (not included) into the battery box. Ensure correct polarity (+/-).
- **For the Remote Control:** Insert the required batteries (typically 2 x 1.5V "AAA" batteries, refer to the remote control's specific compartment for confirmation) into the remote control unit. Ensure correct polarity (+/-).
- Close the battery compartments securely.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Remove batteries if the product is not used for an extended period.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once assembled and batteries are installed, you can operate your RC Mk4 Tank.

1. **Power On:** Turn on the power switch on the tank's battery box and on the remote control.

2. **Pairing:** The tank and remote control should automatically pair. If not, refer to the specific pairing instructions in the included manual.
3. **Movement:** Use the joysticks or directional buttons on the remote control to move the tank forward, backward, left, and right. The tank features moving tracks for realistic motion.
4. **Turret Rotation:** The tank's turret can rotate 360 degrees. Use the designated controls on the remote to rotate the turret.
5. **Detailed Control:** Experiment with the remote control to understand all movement and function capabilities.

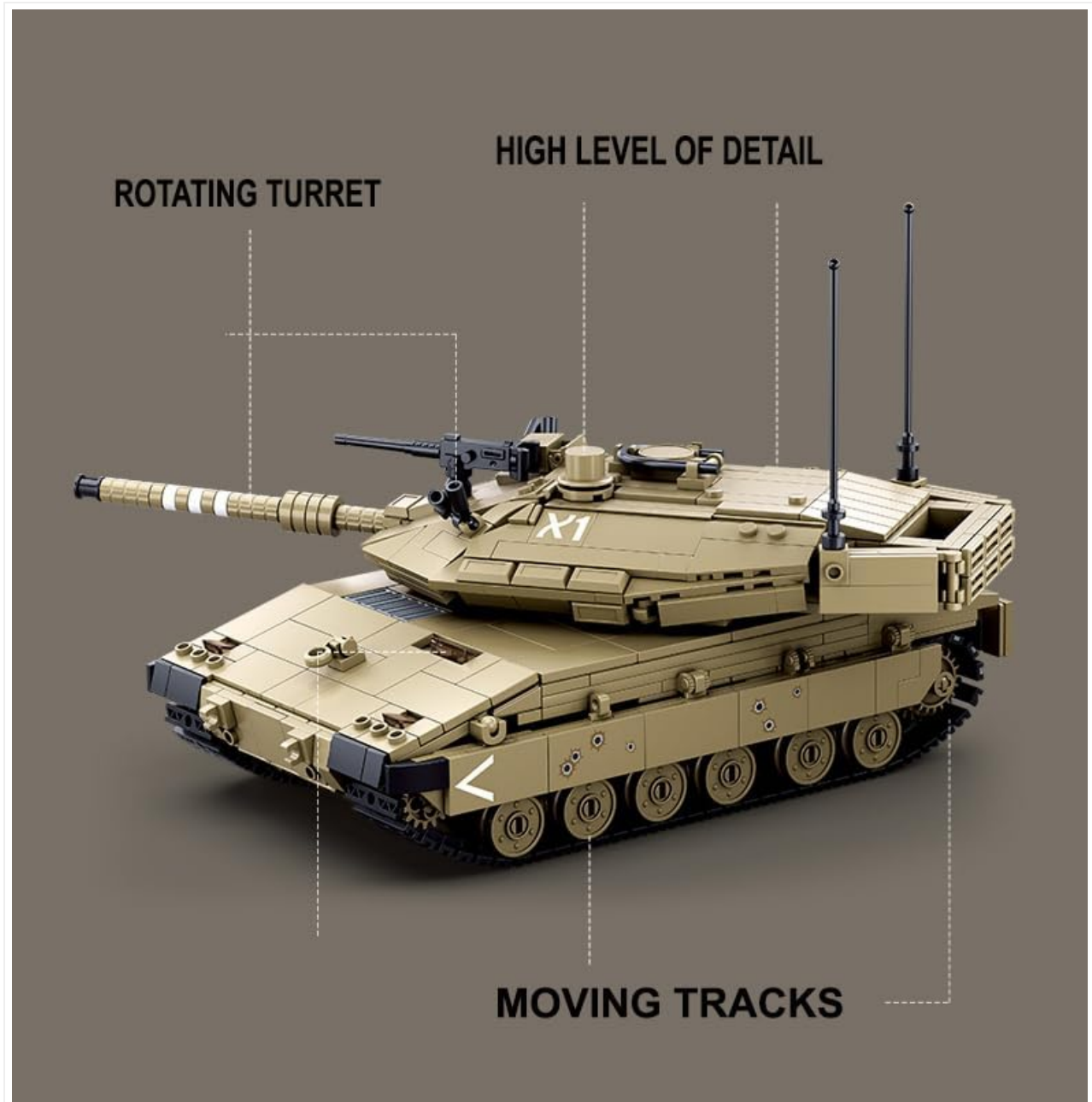

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the tank and remote control with a dry, soft cloth. Do not use water or cleaning solutions, as this may damage electronic components.
- **Storage:** Store the tank and its components in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** Remove batteries from both the tank and remote control if the product will not be used for an extended period to prevent leakage.
- **Part Replacement:** In case of lost or damaged parts, refer to the manufacturer's website or contact customer support for potential replacement options.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Tank does not move or respond to remote.	Batteries are dead or incorrectly installed. Power switch is off. Tank and remote are not paired.	Replace batteries in both tank and remote, ensuring correct polarity. Turn on both power switches. Refer to pairing instructions in the main manual.
Tank moves slowly or erratically.	Low battery power. Obstruction in tracks or gears.	Replace batteries. Check tracks and gears for any debris and remove carefully.
Turret does not rotate.	Turret mechanism is jammed. Motor connection issue.	Gently check for any blocks obstructing the turret's rotation. Verify that the motor connected to the turret is properly installed and connected to the battery box.

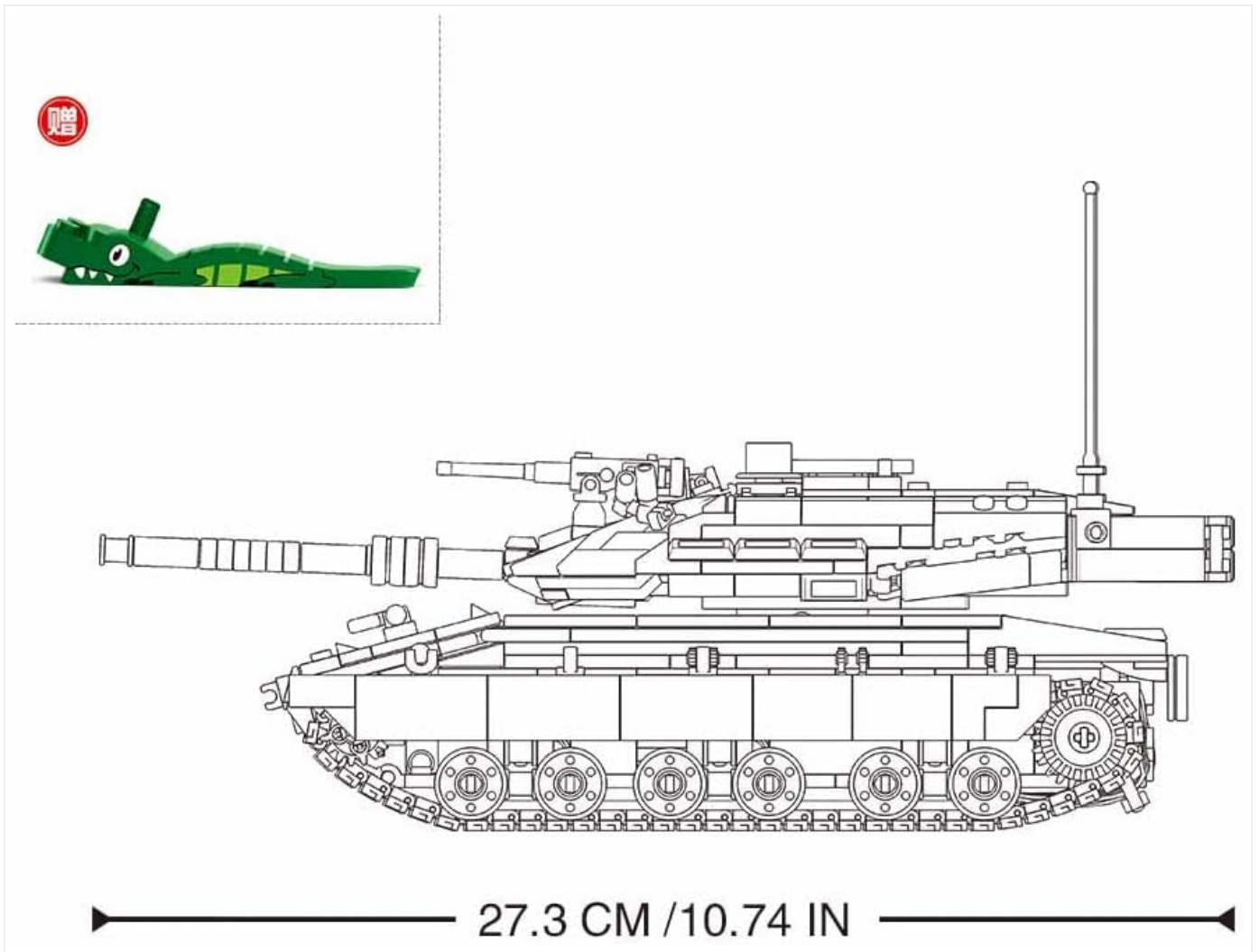


Image: A side profile diagram of the Sluban Power Bricks-RC Mk4 Tank, indicating its total length of 27.3 cm (10.74 inches).
