INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the proper use and care of your Zerodis 40mm Coffee Tamper. Designed for use with 40mm portafilters, this stainless steel tamper assists in achieving consistent espresso extraction.

PRODUCT FEATURES

- **Material:** Food-grade stainless steel for durability and hygiene.

SETUP

The Zerodis 40mm Coffee Tamper requires no assembly. Before first use, it is recommended to clean the tamper thoroughly.

1. Unpack the coffee tamper from its packaging.
2. Wash the tamper with warm water and a mild dish soap.
3. Rinse thoroughly to remove all soap residue.
4. Dry completely with a soft cloth before storage or use.

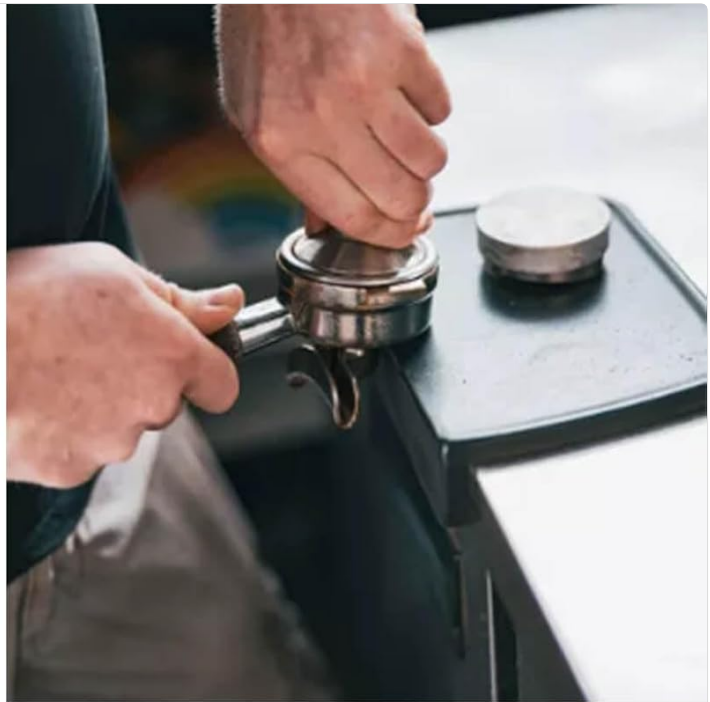
OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Proper tamping is crucial for consistent espresso extraction. Follow these steps for optimal results:

1. **Grind Coffee:** Grind fresh coffee beans to an appropriate fineness for espresso.
2. **Dose Portafilter:** Fill your 40mm portafilter basket with the desired amount of ground coffee. Ensure the coffee bed is level before tamping.
3. **Position Tamper:** Place the flat base of the Zerodis tamper squarely on top of the ground coffee in the portafilter.
4. **Apply Pressure:** Apply firm, even downward pressure on the tamper handle. The goal is to compress the coffee grounds into a dense, uniform puck. Avoid twisting the tamper during this process.
5. **Check Level:** After tamping, the coffee puck should be level and smooth. If not, gently re-tamp or adjust your technique.
6. **Clean Edges:** Wipe away any loose coffee grounds from the rim of the portafilter before inserting it into the espresso machine.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

To ensure the longevity and performance of your Zerodis Coffee Tamper, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Daily Cleaning:** After each use, wipe the tamper with a clean, damp cloth to remove any coffee residue.
- **Deep Cleaning:** Periodically wash the tamper with warm, soapy water and rinse thoroughly.
- **Drying:** Always dry the tamper completely after washing to prevent water spots and maintain its finish.
- **Storage:** Store the tamper in a dry place to prevent moisture exposure.
- **Avoid Abrasives:** Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads, as these can scratch the stainless steel surface.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your tamping process, consider the following:

- **Uneven Puck:** Ensure you are applying even pressure across the tamper's surface. Check that the portafilter is on a flat, stable surface during tamping.
- **Coffee Sticking to Tamper:** This can occur if the coffee grounds are too fine or if there is excessive moisture. Ensure the tamper is dry before use.
- **Difficulty Applying Pressure:** Verify that the tamper size (40mm) matches your portafilter basket.
