It features a 2.8-inch display, 10W charging support, and offers extended battery backup. SETUP

1. Inserting SIM Card and Battery

1. Carefully remove the back cover of the phone.
2. Insert your SIM card(s) into the designated slot(s) with the gold contacts facing down.
3. Insert the battery into the battery compartment, ensuring the contacts align correctly.
4. Replace the back cover until it clicks securely into place.

2. Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge the device. Connect the USB cable to the phone's charging port and the power adapter, then plug the adapter into a wall outlet. The battery indicator on the screen will show charging progress.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power On/Off

- To power on, press and hold the Power/End Call button until the screen lights up.
- To power off, press and hold the Power/End Call button, then select "Power off" from the options.

Making Calls

- Enter the phone number using the keypad.
- Press the Call button (green icon) to initiate the call.
- To end a call, press the Power/End Call button (red icon).

Using as a Power Bank

The itel Power 900 can charge other devices. Connect the charging cable of the device you wish to charge to the USB Type-A output port on the itel Power 900. Charging will begin automatically.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the phone's surface. Avoid liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid exposing the phone to extreme temperatures. Do not attempt to remove or replace the built-in battery yourself.
- **Storage:** If storing the phone for an extended period, ensure it is partially charged (around 50%) and stored in a cool, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Phone does not power on	Low battery; Battery not inserted correctly	Charge the phone for at least 30 minutes; Re-insert the battery ensuring proper alignment.
Cannot make or receive calls	No network signal; SIM card not inserted correctly; SIM card expired/inactive	Move to an area with better network coverage; Re-insert SIM card; Contact your service provider.
Other devices not charging from phone	Low phone battery; Incorrect cable; Device not compatible	Ensure phone has sufficient charge; Use the correct USB cable; Check device compatibility.
Poor audio quality	Speaker/microphone blocked; Low network signal	Clean speaker/microphone openings; Move to an area with better signal.
